The voice of our bayside communities: San Leon | Bacliff | Baytown | Dickinson | Texas City | Kemah | League City | Seabrook

#### Was it 120 dead cats or was it 50? Does the number matter?

Who really knows? It is a bad situation either way. How do you end up with 50 or 120 dead cats in and around your home? I was told that the neighbors called Galveston County authorities many times, but who knows what really happened?

What I know is a young lady named Kaylee, 23 years old, posted on Nextdoor for someone to foster two of her cats, Cheesecake, pictured here, and Oatmeal. She was preparing to move to Michigan and couldn't bring them along to her temporary home. Cheesecake was an older cat, while Oatmeal, a kitten, needed some special care due to health issues. Bobbie Medley, a rescuer, took in Oatmeal, and Julia Szebehely, also known as "Juliana Meyow," picked up Cheesecake.

Juliana always picked up cats, she never let anyone drop off cats at her house. She had been helping with cats in the area for years. She was known for picking up stray cats, getting them spayed or neutered, and returning them to their homes at no cost to the owners. People in the community trusted her.

Kaylee kept in contact with both Bobbie and Juliana, checking in on her cats regularly. But as time passed, Juliana's responses became less frequent. Eventually, Juliana told Kaylee she was in the hospital and assured her that a caretaker was looking after Cheesecake which turned out to be a lie.

When it came time for Kaylee to pick up Cheesecake in early September, Juliana gave her the runaround, making excuses about why she couldn't pick up the cat. At that point, Kaylee reached out to Bobbie, who still had Oatmeal, and told her what was going on with Juliana. Bobbie, who runs Forgotten Pet & Wildlife Rescue and has a license from the state of Texas to rescue and rehabilitate wildlife, was not someone to cross when it came to animals. She decided to get involved.

On September 7th, Bobbie contacted Juliana and told her they were coming to get Cheesecake. After a lot of back-and-forth, Juliana finally gave them the address where Cheesecake supposedly was. When they arrived, the situation was far worse than anyone could have imagined. Dead cats in various stages of decomposition were scattered across the overgrown property. To make things worse, Bobbie noticed a horse on the property that was extremely underweight. That's when Juliana told them to leave.

Bobbie called the authorities and waited. When no one came quickly, she called in a welfare check for Juliana, which triggered a series of events that exposed the horror of the situation. Juliana was taken away in an ambulance, and Grizzy Hood News was called to document what they found. As Grizzy and another person walked through the house and garage, they remarked on the sound of bones crunching beneath their feet. They also noticed that nearby cows were skinny and living in muddy conditions.

The video that surfaced was gut-wrenching — one of the worst cases of animal cruelty I've ever seen. How did no one know what was happening? Juliana had been active on both Nextdoor and Facebook, posting regularly. I even reached out to her back in January, asking who managed animal control for San Leon and Bacliff. She was very helpful and informative then.

In this case, it's clear people did report what was going on, but nothing was done. Many people have asked, "Why isn't she in jail?" I don't have the answer. Animal cruelty was made a felony during Donald Trump's presidency, yet somehow, justice hasn't been served in this case.

As for Cheesecake, her story isn't over — she's still missing. I would say "If you see something say something."



If there's one takeaway from this, it's this: Don't post on social media if you need to rehome your pet. You never know where your animal might end up. Will your dog become a bait dog in illegal pit bull fighting? Will your cat fall into the hands of someone with a mental illness? Before bringing a pet into your home, understand the responsibility. If you can't commit to caring for that animal for 15 years or more, maybe it's best not to adopt.

I visited her shelter recently, and she was caring for bottle-fed kittens, special needs cats, raccoons, and even squirrels some of them victims of Hurricane Beryl. 
### FISHING TIPS Don is on a first name basis with most of the local fish...
