Ramp Plank Assembly - Ramp Part 2C

- 1. Using a jig, attach the brace to the underside of the 2x6 planks. Attach with 2 ¼" plated screws. Be sure to use the jig to keep the ramp assembly square.
- 2. Shave the bottom of the receiving end of the plank with an electric hand planer for a better fit.
- 3. Wrap the protective plastic sheet over the end of the 2x6 planks. This protects the aluminum from the corrosive treated lumber.
- 4. Slide the 2x6 plank assembly onto the 11" ramp bracket. Make sure there is approximately ¼" hanging off both sides of the bracket.
- 5. Using the holes in the bracket as a guide, drill 5/16" holes through each of the 2x6 wood planks.
- 6. Attach the 2x6 wood plank to the bracket using the carriage bolts & flange nuts included in the kit.
