

House Bill 638

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Macon-Bibb County Community Enhancement Authority,  
2 approved April 11, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 5270), as amended, so as to change the membership  
3 of such authority; to provide for related matters; to provide for effective dates; to repeal  
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating the Macon-Bibb County Community Enhancement Authority, approved  
8 April 11, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 5270), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (b)  
9 of Section 3 as follows:

10 "(b)(1) The members of the authority serving as of January 1, 2019, or their successors,  
11 shall cease to serve as members of the authority effective June 30, 2019.

12 (2) Effective July 1, 2019, the authority shall be governed by a board of trustees  
13 consisting of a chairperson and four members. The current chairperson shall serve until  
14 June 30, 2020. The chairperson shall appoint two members who shall be subject to  
15 approval by majority vote of the Macon-Bibb County legislative delegation in the  
16 Georgia General Assembly, which legislative delegation shall be composed of all  
17 Representatives and Senators in the Georgia General Assembly whose districts are  
18 wholly or partially located in Macon-Bibb County. One member shall be appointed by  
19 the governing authority of Macon-Bibb County. One member shall be a member of the  
20 governing authority of Macon-Bibb County, appointed by said governing authority.  
21 Members of the authority shall serve terms of two years."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 This Act shall become effective for purposes of appointment of new members of the  
24 Macon-Bibb County Community Enhancement Authority upon approval by the Governor

25 or upon becoming law without such approval. For all other purposes, this Act shall become  
26 effective on July 1, 2019.

27 **SECTION 3.**

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
