

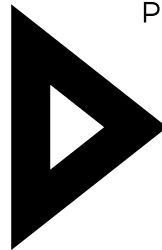

**Children are more likely to experience ACEs**

- ✓ IF THEY LIVE IN URBAN AREAS
- ✓ IF THEY ARE GROWING UP IN POVERTY
- ✓ IF THEY ARE AFRICAN-AMERICAN

- Children are also negatively impacted by adverse community environments, like poverty, struggling schools, systemic racism, community violence, or lack of housing or economic opportunities.



KIDS WITH 3 OR MORE ACEs  
ARE 2.5 TIMES MORE LIKELY  
TO FAIL A GRADE



KIDS WITH 6 OR MORE ACEs  
HAVE A LIFE EXPECTANCY OF  
TWENTY YEARS LESS THAN  
THEIR PEERS
