

INTERNS WEAR MANY HATS



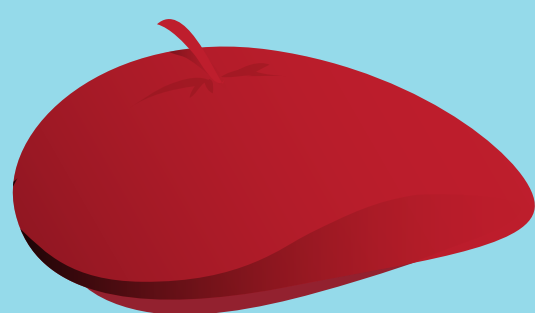

Sports are an integral part of youth programming at One Hope. Interns will have many opportunities to play and coach sports throughout the summer.



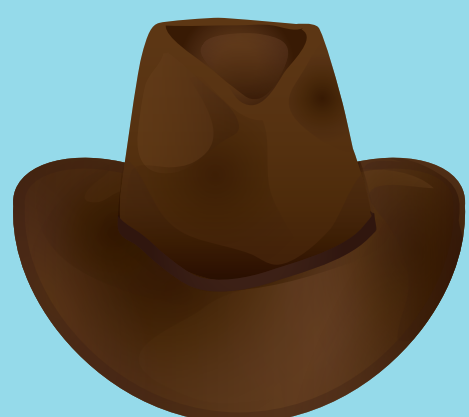
"Everybody wants a revolution, but no one wants to do the dishes." Skilled and unskilled manual labor and behind-the-scenes service are an important part of every intern's day.
