### **PARENT/VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT**

Parents are vital to the development of young athletes. When sitting in the stands or helping out as a volunteer, we must set a positive example. Parents and adults involved in youth sports should be models of good sportsmanship and lead by example on and off the playing field.

1. Support your coach, and refrain from excessive “sideline coaching” from practices and games.
2. Parents will not engage in unsportsmanship conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, officials, or any other attendee.
3. No drugs, alcohol, or smoking in the parking lot, at practices, and/or games.
4. Parents are responsible for their children before, during, and after practice and games.
5. I (and my guests) will demonstrate positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game.
6. There is a zero-tolerance policy for fighting and/or verbal threats to players, coaches, referees, parents and/or volunteers.
7. I will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at practice or games before, during, or after games. Parents can request an in-person or phone meeting with coaches at a mutually agreed time.
8. Playing time concerns are to be discussed a minimum of 48 hours after game(s) or at the coach's discretion of availability, not to exceed ten days.
9. The OC Trojans logo can not be used to sell, make, or profit from merchandise outside of the OC Trojans team store.

OC Trojans will not tolerate acts of harassment, intimidation, and bullying (including cyberbullying). To coaches, parents, volunteers, athletes, and affiliations/vendors/partnerships with the OC Trojans. Written, verbal, or physical acts, in addition to social media.

### **PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE**

You must adhere to all OC Trojans standards, policies, and procedures. Failure to do so may result in further disciplinary action up to and including removal from the OC Trojans program. Parents, relatives, and/or volunteers- Must comply with all OC Trojans football program rules and regulations. Any infraction of the above conduct will result in one of the following actions at the discretion of the OC Trojans Founder/President that could include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Verbal warning and a signed warning document.
- Suspension of parent/volunteer, relative, and/or player from practice(s) and game(s) and signed document. Suspension can vary from one week to indefinite.
- Termination from the OC Trojans program for parents and player(s). No Refunds for registration, fundraising, and team merch.
