

Hello and thank you for giving me the opportunity to teach you the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude for owning and using a pistol safely. You will be part of Class # 11-21 on 13-NOV-2021. It will take place at The Homestead Training Center ("HTC") - 11700 SW 304th St, Homestead, FL 33033. Scroll to bottom of document to see map to HTC and actual classrooms.

I've attached the course outline. Please review it thoroughly and call me well in advance of the class if you have any questions about the outline or anything contained in this email. My number is 305-582-6991.

The course is designed to teach you how to own and use a pistol safely. This is an approved course as defined by the State of Florida that serves as the training qualification for a concealed weapon license.

- Cost: \$95.00 (check, cash, Venmo, or Cash App)
  - My course is more expensive than what you will see on GroupOn, but you get what you
    pay for.
  - Most GroupOn or gun show courses run only two hours with and proficiency is demonstrated by showing you can fire a single round. These courses also tend to have very large class sizes as well.
  - My course runs eight (8) hours, covers the subject matter in depth, and has qualification requirement that consists of firing 20 rounds into a specified target (see attached course outline). I also keep the class size to under 10.
    - I will provide the gun and enough ammunition for both practice and qualification. You can use your own gun if you wish, but you must provide your own ammunition.
  - My course includes an optional (no extra cost) range portion covering specific drills using your own gun, ammunition, and equipment. A limited number of loaner guns are available, but you have to cover the cost of ammunition. Call me ahead of time to coordinate – 305-582-6991.

  - Citizenship Certificate is only available to US citizens and Permanent Residents.
     Nonresidents can take the course, but not earn the certification.

- o I recommend you use Waze. Also, view the location on Google maps from your home computer, so you can be oriented and estimate travel time.
- See attached maps of HTC. One gives you a visual once you exit the Turnpike (Exit 9a), the other shows you were to the class rooms are located on the compound.

## Logistics

- Date: 25-SEP-2021(Saturday)
- o Time: 8:30AM to 5:30PM
- Food: I will provide coffee and light breakfast food. Please bring your own lunch. There
  are no places close to the compound and we want to make the most use of the day.
- Water: Bring plenty or a suitable water container. I will have some gallon jugs you can use to top off.
- o Bathrooms are available throughout the compound.
- Clothing:
  - Weather dependent. I recommend you have hat or other head cover
  - Bring a light jacket if you get cold. Classrooms might get chilly
  - Close toe shoes no open toe or sandals
  - NO V-NECKS, TANK TOPS, OR CUTOFF SLEEVE SHIRTS.
  - Long pants recommended
- Gear
  - Eye protection
    - Non glass prescription glasses are ok. Also, you can go on Amazon and search: Shooting eye protection.
  - Ear protection
    - I recommend electronic ear muffs. They are worth the investment. They range in price. I use Howard Leight, but there are other good brands out there. Check on Amazon. You can also get standard shooting muffs or shooting ear plugs. Call me if you have any questions 305-582-6991
  - Firearm and ammunition (ammo)
    - I will provide both for qualification purposes.
    - You can bring your own firearm and ammo and use it to qualify if you wish.
      - PLEASE LEAVE BOTH IN YOUR VEHICLE UNTIL I GIVE THE OK.
         THERE IS NO LIVE AMMO PERMITED IN THE CLASSROOM.
    - Bring your preferred holster if you have one or a suitable gun case.
      - **O ALL FIREARMS MUST BE KEPT IN A SUITABLE CASE**
    - For those of you who do not have your own gun and want to participate in the optional range portion of the course, I have a limited number of loaner guns that I can provide (call me to reserve and discuss the ammo situation - 305-582-6991

## NOTE ON AMMO

Ammo has become very scarce and expensive in the last year,
 especially typical self-defense calibers (9MM, 40, 45, 38spl). I suggest

that you start shopping for ammo now and bring at least 100 rounds of whatever you will be shooting.
