

RIVERDALE POLICE PISTOL TEAM  
**SUMMARY of RANGE RULES**

- Range hours are 9 AM to 10 PM Monday – Saturday, and 10 AM to 10 PM Sunday. (Exceptions are posted on the ready room calendar, and/or on the web – Riverdalepistol.org)
- All Shooters (including any guests) must sign the log in the Ready Room for the shooting port(s) being used before entering the Range Area.
- Maximum of two (2) family members and/or guests with you at the range at any one time.
- YOU – the RPPT club member – are responsible for the actions of your guest(s)!
- **Guest fee for the day is \$30.00.**
- There is No handling of firearms permitted anywhere, but the Firing Line!
- Alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed on premises – NO Exceptions!
- This range – like all shooting ranges – utilizes lead bullets and primers. Run the exhaust/intake fans in the Range Area for maximum protection.
- Ear and Eye protection is mandatory at all times within the Range Area.
- There is No eating, drinking, or smoking permitted in the Range Area.
- Please light and/or vent only the side that you are shooting on.
- A firearm banned by NJ law Cannot be brought to, or used at, the RPPT range – No Exceptions!
- There is No shooting of Black-Powder firearms allowed.
- There is No shooting of ‘Magnum’ or “Hot calibers” (e.g. 454 Casule, 45-70, over 1250 fps).
- Long Arms (rifles) are allowed only under the following conditions:
  - .22 caliber; and Carbines firing pistol ammunition less than 1250 fps;
  - ‘Magnum’ caliber rifles are permitted only when using ‘Special’ ammunition, or loads using Lead bullets that are less than 1250 fps.
- Use only Paper targets, except during special events (such as IDPA, ISPC, GSSF matches and practices, or when directly supervised by RPPT Range Safety Officers).
- Shooting while the target carrier is in motion is Not allowed, unless supervised by a Certified Instructor.
- Quick draw and/or holster work is Not allowed, except during authorized and supervised police qualifications, IPSC matches, and/or RPPT sponsored events.
- During matches, a Safe Table will be made available to work on guns while supervised by a RPPT certified Range Safety Officer. Live ammunition is Never permitted at a Safe Table!
- Clean up after shooting – sweep up your trash, brass, and target remnants.
- The Red and White pails in the range area are for spent/fired brass casings. Do Not place Live and/or Malfunctioned ammunition in those cans – there are Red “Dud” containers for them.
