

ORDINANCE NO. 312

An Ordinance establishing a police department in and for the Borough of Forest City, and repealing a prior ordinance.

The Borough of Forest City hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. A Police Department is hereby established in and for the Borough of Forest City. The Chief of Police shall be the chief executive of the Police Department. He shall, under the direction of the Mayor, be in charge of the police force and have supervision over its members, in the exercise of their powers, duties and authority.

Section 2. Subordinate to the Chief of Police in the Police Department the office of Assistant Chief of Police is hereby established, with authority to serve as acting chief of police at any time when the Chief of Police is absent from the Borough or incapacitated. In addition there shall be as many part-time, extra police as the Council may from time to time appoint.

Section 3. Nothing herein shall affect the authority of the Mayor to appoint special policemen during emergencies.

Section 4. Ordinance 46, approved July 2, 1896, and entitled: "An Ordinance establishing a police in the Borough of Forest City, is hereby repealed.
