Sculpture trail has not had any movement with the historical society providing an idea for the sculpture. Juliann noted they discussed a miner or a lumberjack. Deb will let the sculpture designer know of our suggestions.

Mural project on Frugal Living Building no updates.

The current façade program is complete. A different program will be available. Katie will check on this.

The branding signage quote is \$100.00 per sign. The designer is Jeff George, Katie will speak to him about moving forward.

Junior Board discussion and Katie will meet with Forest City School Board to hopefully start this project. Possibly the junior board could do fundraising for our grant matches, something like a turkey trot, perhaps?

A Marcellus Shale Minin grant is currently open and due September 16 th . All agreed we have enough going on right now. Remember this for next year and apply then. Award ceremony info was provided.
