

# FOREST CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE #517

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 498- REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PARKING IN THE BOROUGH OF FOREST CITY, SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE II - PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION #5 (a.) STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED.

SECTION 5. IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

(a.) The following intersections are established as stop intersections and official stop signs shall be erected (or are ratified if previously erected) in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street (the through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction or directions indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or stop street, in the direction indicated in each case, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code and shall not proceed into or across the second-named or through street until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

<i>Add the following to create a Three-Way stop:</i>		
(43-a) Railroad Street	Higgins Street	East


This amendment adds a stop sign to Railroad Street that intersects Higgins Street (Article II, Section 20.) creating a three-way stop at this intersection.


FURTHER be it ordained that:

(b.) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine in the amount as set forth in the PA Vehicle Code.
