

FOREST CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE #519

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 498- REGULATING TRAFFIC AND PARKING IN THE BOROUGH OF FOREST CITY, SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE III - PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTION 2. Parking Prohibited at all times in certain locations. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

Severability:

If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance so long as it remains workable minus the invalid portion.

PURPOSE:

To ensure the safe egress of Fire & Emergency vehicles from Railroad Street to Main Street via South Street, No Parking shall be permitted on either side of South Street from Main Street to Higgins Street and Higgins Street to Railroad Street (Both sides).

FURTHER be it ordained that:

(a.) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine in the amount as set forth in the PA Vehicle Code.
