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1. Purpose

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit a website.

They help websites function correctly, improve performance, remember your preferences and provide information about how visitors use the website.

Cookies do not normally identify you personally, although some cookies may be linked to personal information where permitted by law.

3. Why We Use Cookies

- Remember your preferences where applicable.
- Analyse website performance and visitor behaviour.
 - Improve the user experience.
 - Help diagnose technical issues.

We do not use cookies for unlawful purposes and will only use non-essential cookies with your consent where required.

4. Types of Cookies We May Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the website and cannot be switched off through our systems.

They are used to:

- Maintain website security.
- Enable page navigation.
- Remember cookie preferences.
- Support essential website functionality.

Because these cookies are necessary, they do not require consent under applicable legislation.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use our website.

Information collected may include:

- Number of visitors.
- Pages visited.
- Time spent on pages.
- Navigation patterns.
- General website performance.

Where required by law, these cookies will only be placed after you have given your consent.

Functional Cookies

Functional cookies remember choices you make, such as language or display preferences, to improve your browsing experience.

These cookies may also remember information you have entered into forms where appropriate.

Marketing Cookies

If Dexacon Ltd introduces advertising or marketing technologies in the future, marketing cookies may be used to measure campaign performance and deliver more relevant content.

These cookies will only be used where you have provided your consent.

5. Third-Party Cookies

Some features on our website may be provided by trusted third-party services, including:

- **Website analytics providers.**
 - **Interactive maps.**
 - **Video hosting services.**
 - **Social media platforms.**
- **Website hosting providers.**

These organisations may place their own cookies in accordance with their own privacy and cookie policies.
