## STUDENTS EDUCATIONAL TOUR 2025 (SOUTH INDIA)

### TOUR PROGRAMME

#### DAY - 1 & 2 (14-01-2025 to 15-01-2025) JAGITYAL - ERNAKULAM

Leave the Jagityal and proceed to Hyderabad Deccan Nampally Railway Station by 11:00am, proceed to COCHIN by HYD- KTYM Spl. Exp. (07065) at 12:00pm and arrival at ERNAKULAM Town at 2:20pm and proceed to Hotel.

Kerala historically known as Keralam, is an Indian state in South India on the Malabar coast. It was formed on 1 November 1956 following the States Reorganisation Act by combining Malayalam-speaking regions. Spread over 38,863 km<sup>2</sup> (15,005 sq mi), it is bordered by Karnataka to the north and northeast, Tamil Nadu to the east and south, and the Lakshadweep Sea to the west. With 33,387,677 inhabitants as per the 2011 Census, Kerala is the thirteenth-largest state by population and is divided into 14 districts with the capital being Thiruvananthapuram. Malayalam is the most widely spoken language and is also the official language of the state

The region has been a prominent spice exporter since 3000 BCE. The Chera Dynasty was the first prominent kingdom based in Kerala, though it frequently struggled against attacks by the neighbouring Cholas and Pandyas. In the 15th century, the spice trade attracted Portuguese traders to Kerala, and paved the way for the European colonisation of India. After independence, Travancore and Cochin joined the Republic of India and Travancore-Cochin was given the status of a state in 1949. In 1956, Kerala state was formed by merging Malabar district, Travancore-Cochin (excluding four southern taluks), and the taluk of Kasargod, South Kanara.

#### OVER NIGHT STAY AT COCHIN HOTEL

#### DAY - 3 (16-01-2025) MUNNAR

After Breakfast leave the Hotel and proceed to Munnar Sightseeing.

#### MUNNAR

Munnar is a town and hill station located in the Idukki district of the southwestern Indian state of Kerala. Munnar is situated at around 1,600 metres (5,200 ft) above mean sea level, in the Western Ghats range of mountains.

MUNNAR ATTRACTIONS: MATTUPETTY DAM, ECHO POINT, FLOWER GARDEN, SPICE PLANTATIONS, KUNDALA LAKE, WATER FALLS ETC.



#### MATTUPETTY DAM (Madupetty Dam)

Near Munnar in Idukki District, is a storage Concrete Gravity dam built in the mountains of Kerala, India to conserve water for hydroelectricity. It has been a vital source of power, yielding along with other such dams, huge revenue to the states. The large amount of perennially available water allows wild animals and birds to flourish. However salinity caused by irrigation and water-logging are of concern to environmentalists.

## ECHO POINT

This scenic place gets its name from the natural echo phenomenon here. Echo Point, situated on the way to Top Station from Munnar is a stop over for tourists visiting Top Station - the highest point in Munnar and the rare Neelakurinji (*Strobilanthus*) blooms here.

## DAY - 4 (17-01-2025) TEKKADY

After Breakfast checkout the Hotel and proceed to **TEKKADY**

### TEKKADY

The very sound of the word Thekkady conjures up images of elephants, unending chains of hills and spice scented plantations. The Periyar forests of Thekkady is one of the finest wildlife reserves in India. Spread across the entire district are picturesque plantations and hill towns that hold great opportunities for treks and mountain walks.

TEKKADY ATTRACTIONS: **PERIYAR WILDLIFE SANTUARY**, **ELEPHANT RIDE (Self Exp.)** ETC.



Wealth of Periyar Forests over 1965 flowering plants including 171 grass species 143 species of orchids. The only south Indian conifer, scientifically known as *Podocarpus wallichianus*, grows in the forests of Periyar Tiger Reserve. Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary / Periyar Tiger Reserve The lively jungle Herds of elephants moving towards a lake against the backdrop of picturesque mountain ranges with thick greenery - if you come across such a photograph in Kerala, it will most probably be one of the Periyar Valley.

### ALLEPPY BOATING

aspects of day-to-day life on land and water. A wide range of cruise options are available here - from small country boats to luxury houseboats and small speedboats to big passenger motorboats. Small boats are preferred for cruise through the canals.

**DAY - 6 (19-01-2025) TRIVANDRUM**

After Breakfast proceed to city local Sight Seeing Sree Padmanabhaswamy Temple, Museum, Zoo etc.,



Located inside the East Fort in Thiruvananthapuram, the capital city of the State of Kerala in India is the Sree Padmanabhaswamy temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu. This temple is a blend of the Kerala and Dravidian styles of architecture.

The history of Sree Padmanabhaswamy Temple dates back to 8th century. It is one of the 108 sacred Vishnu temples or Divya Desams in India. Divya Desams are the holiest abodes of the Lord Vishnu that are mentioned in the works of the Tamil Azhvars (saints). The presiding deity of this temple is Lord Vishnu, reclining on Anantha, the hooded Serpent.

After Lunch proceed to Kovalam Beach.

KOVALAM is an internationally renowned beach with three adjacent crescent beaches. It has been a favourite haunt of tourists, especially Europeans, since the 1930s. A massive rocky promontory on the beach has created a beautiful bay of calm waters ideal for sea bathing. The leisure options at this beach are plenty and diverse. Sunbathing, swimming, herbal body toning massages, special cultural programmes and catamaran cruising are some of them.

The tropical sun acts so fast that one can see the faint blush of coppery tan on the skin in a matter of minutes. Life on the beach begins late in the day and carries on well into the night. The beach complex includes a string of budget cottages, Ayurvedic health resorts, convention facilities, shopping zones, swimming pools, Yoga and Ayurvedic massage centres.

## DAY - 7 (20-01-2025) KANYAKUMARI

Early morning proceed to Kanyakumari.

KANYAKUMARI known as Cape Comorin, is a town in Kanyakumari District in the state of Tamil Nadu in India. The name comes from the Devi Kanya Kumari Temple in the region. It is the southernmost tip of peninsular India. Kanyakumari town is the southern tip of the Cardamom Hills, an extension of the Western Ghats range. The nearest town is Nagercoil, the administrative headquarters of Kanyakumari District, 22 km (14 mi) away. Kanyakumari has been a town since Sangam period and is a popular tourist destination.

Vivekananda Rock Memorial

Vivekananda Rock Memorial is a popular tourist monument in Vavathurai, Kanyakumari, India. The memorial stands on one of two rocks located about 500 meters east off mainland of Vavathurai, India's southernmost tip.

The Thiruvalluvar Statue is a 133 feet (40.6 m) tall stone sculpture of the Tamil poet and philosopher Tiruvalluvar, author of the Thirukkural. It is located atop a small island near the town of Kanyakumari on the southernmost Coromandel Coast, where two seas and an ocean meet; the Bay of Bengal, the Arabian Sea, and the Indian Ocean.

**KOCHI ATTRACTIONS:** St.Francis Church, Chinese Fishing net, Navy Museum, Shopping, etc.



St. Francis CSI Church, in Fort Kochi (aka. Fort Cochin), originally built in 1503, is the oldest European church in India and has great historical significance as a mute witness to the European colonial struggle in the subcontinent. The Portuguese explorer Vasco da Gama died in Kochi in 1524 when he was on his third visit to India. His body was originally buried in this church, but after fourteen years his remains were removed to Lisbon.

**After Dinner proceed to Eranakulam Railway Station (ERN) by 7:00pm, and proceed to Secunderabad Junction by KTYM - SC Spl Exp. (07066) at 7:30pm and arrival Secunderabad at 11:45pm, on (23-01-2025) and proceed to Jagityal**
