Each work is an abstract representation of everyday moments—drawn from the past, from dreams, from fiction, or a mixture of all three.

The works are created unconsciously—both in process and in their underlying ideas (intention, context). The creation process is improvisational.

This approach allows for a natural, free expression of each specific moment and invites the viewer to interpret the visual context in a deeply personal way.
