Utensil Assembly

Materials Needed:

- 10-12 plastic forks
- 10-12 plastic spoons
- 10-12 plastic napkins
- 10-12 plastic straws
- Plastic Shoebox Container for Storage

OPTIONAL: 10-12 plastic baggies to put each assembled set.

Student Set Up:


Place all the supplies into the plastic shoebox container, mix, and place it in front of the student. Student will collect one fork, spoon, and straw and wrap it in the napkin. It is then placed in the 'finished' container. Student is finished when all the items are assembled.

Objective:

Student will be able to discriminate between items based on attributes and assemble them by following multistep directions.











Gather cans, plastics, and paper. Set up 3 containers and sort the materials. Count how many items you have in each bin. Bring items to your recycling bin.















