2016 January 7. View from Pequawket Trail over the Saco River to Mt Cutler. The front ledges rise over the village with homes along Maple Street near the river. The large culverts are the Hancock Brook outlet. The north slope of the mountain rises from the right side of the photo. Newer trails approach the mountain from this north side, starting on the Hiram Hill Road.

2015 August 4. View of Mt Cutler over Ingalls Pond from the side of Pequawket Trail in West Baldwin. This view shows the entire half-mile expanse of the Main Ridge, with the minor summit at 1160 ft appearing to be the highest point. The true summit (1232 ft) is the more distant peak in shadow at left. Hiram village is hidden in the valley at far right.







2016 May 17. View of Mt Cutler from Hancock Avenue with Hiram Village Cemetery. At far right, Historical Ridge has two main buildings: the Hiram Community Center and the Great Ossipee Museum of the Hiram Historical Society. The mountain is more than a half mile distant with most of Hiram Village between this view point and the front ledges that rise high above the Saco River and nearby homes.
