


ARRIVE LHASA

Jokhang Temple

Considered the holiest temple in Tibet, home to the revered statue of Jowo Rinpoche. Pilgrims from across Tibet walk the Kora around the temple.

LHASA – MONASTERY TOUR

Sera Monastery

Drepung Monastery

One of the largest monasteries in the world, offering insight into monastic life and excellent views of the valley below.

- **Kumbum Stupa** : A multi-tiered chorten with exquisite murals and chapels.
- **Palcho Monastery** : Known for its fusion of all three major sects of Tibetan

Buddhism.

- **Old Gyantse Town Walk** : Discover the charm of Gyantse's traditional Tibetan settlement.

Continue onward to Shigatse.

SHIGATSE – SAGA (455 KM / 7-8 HRS DRIVE)

Tashilhunpo Monastery

Seat of the Panchen Lama and an important spiritual centre housing the massive statue of **Maitreya Buddha**.

Explore the local Tibetan market and later drive towards Saga, passing quaint villages, plateaus, and distant mountain ranges.

- Magnificent distant views of Mt. Naimonanyi (7,694 m)

After the show, take some time to stroll around Wangfujing Street, one of the most famous shopping areas in Beijing.

BEIJING CITY HIGHLIGHTS

After **breakfast** at the hotel. Begin your **city tour** with a visit to **Tiananmen Square**, one of the largest public squares in the world. This iconic site is surrounded by important landmarks, including the Gate of Heavenly Peace and Mao Zedong Memorial Hall. Next, visit the **Forbidden City**, the largest ancient palace in the world. Once the home of China's emperors, the Forbidden City is a sprawling complex of courtyards, temples, and halls, all with rich historical and cultural significance. After the Forbidden City, head to the **Temple of Heaven**, a stunning example of ancient Chinese architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This sacred complex was used by emperors for annual ceremonies to pray for good harvests. In the afternoon, explore **Houhai Lake** and the nearby **Hutong Alley**. This area gives you a glimpse into old Beijing life, with narrow lanes, traditional courtyard homes, and vibrant lakeside cafes.

GREAT WALL OF CHINA & NATIONAL OLYMPIC PARK

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, travel to the **Great Wall of China**. Depending on your preference and physical condition, you will visit either the Mutianyu or Badaling section with round trip cable car facility. **Lunch** at Local restaurant. Post-lunch, visit the **Summer Palace**, an imperial garden that showcases China's classical landscape architecture.

In the late afternoon, visit the **National Olympic Park**, built for the 2008 Beijing Olympics. Here, you'll have the chance to take photos of the **Bird's Nest Stadium (National Stadium - Outside)** and the **Water Cube (National Aquatics Center - Outside)**, two of the most iconic Olympic structures.
