



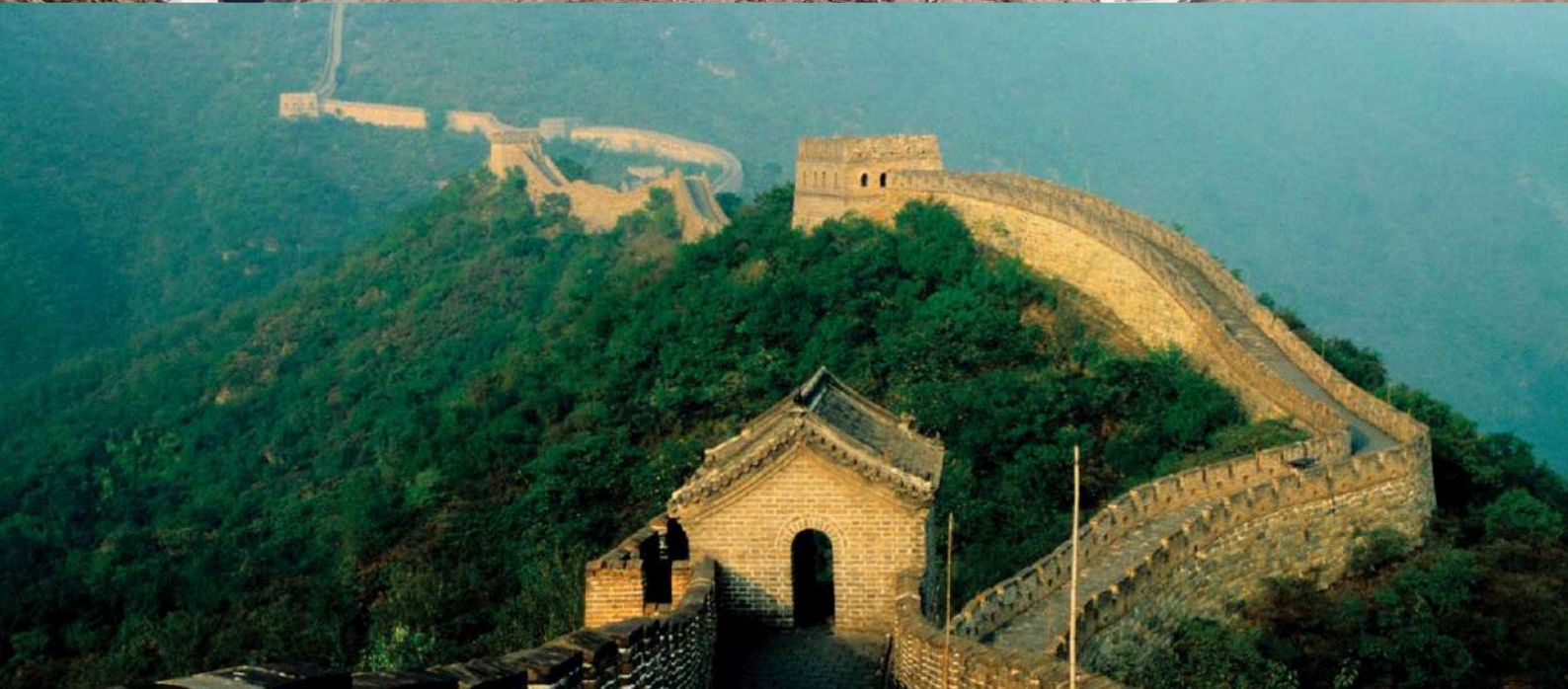

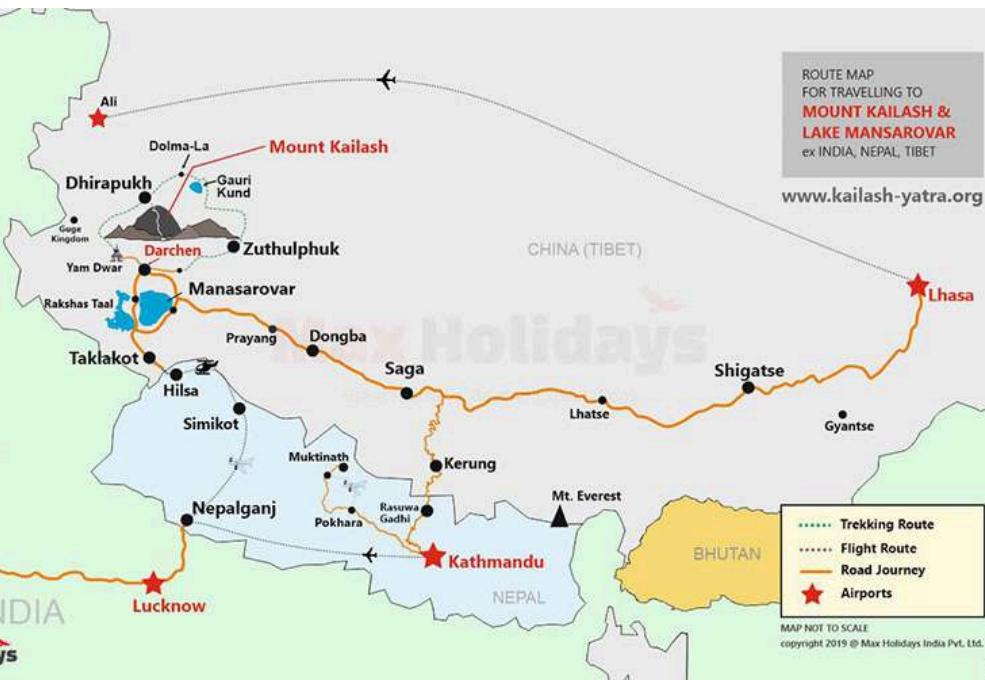

In Gyantse, visit: • **Kumbum Stupa** : A multi-tiered chorten with exquisite murals and chapels.

• **Palcho Monastery** : Known for its fusion of all three major sects of Tibetan Buddhism.

• **Old Gyantse Town Walk** : Discover the charm of Gyantse's traditional Tibetan settlement.

Continue onward to Shigatse.

DAY 01

BEIJING CITY HIGHLIGHTS

After **breakfast** at the hotel.

Begin your **city tour** with a visit to **Tiananmen Square**, one of the largest public squares in the world. This iconic site is surrounded by important landmarks, including the Gate of Heavenly Peace and Mao Zedong Memorial Hall.


Next, visit the **Forbidden City**, the largest ancient palace in the world. Once the home of China's emperors, the Forbidden City is a sprawling complex of courtyards, temples, and halls, all with rich historical and cultural significance.

After the Forbidden City, head to the **Temple of Heaven**, a stunning example of ancient Chinese architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This sacred complex was used by emperors for annual ceremonies to pray for good harvests.

In the afternoon, explore **Houhai Lake** and the nearby **Hutong Alley**. This area gives you a glimpse into old Beijing life, with narrow lanes, traditional courtyard homes, and vibrant lakeside cafes.
