- Public Works/Water Report-Curtis Nowley of public works been going above and beyond for the city helping out after hours, Door company mat replaced with the city purchasing our own mats for much cheaper expenses. Water lost report fire hydrant ran to long and empty tanks out by mistake, lost 540,000 gallons lost and 15,000 gallons total lost 21.83%, fixed varies leak throughout the city, new signs placed in the city, the water pump station starting to go out looking to get quotes on that fix, introduce the maintenance team and park & rec crew
