

- with 46,000 miles. \$2500.00 to be delivered. Alderman Nowley made the motion that \$4500.00 would be the minimum, but not to exceed \$6500.00. Alderman Kennon second the motion; passed by unanimous vote. **Water fund:** \$1,123,098.41; down \$14,559.60, due to pipe repairs.
- As of May 9th, the current balances are as follows: **Drug fund:** \$46,325.54, down \$1437.45. This was due to renovations done to the new police department. **General:** \$553,344.01. This was down \$21,578.00; must use Arbor Grant by September (\$4069.18-total left)
- Special budget meeting on May 29th. 2022 budget is complete. There is over \$31,000.00 in late fees for water in NexGen from over the last 5 years.
- Motion to read Employee Handbook policy changes made by Alderman Barnette; second by Alderman Allen; passed unanimously by the board.
- The city is on probation for not having necessary paperwork for Tennessee Board of Utility Regulation; must have 12 hours of training.
- Motion to read the revised water department fees made by Alderman Kennon; second by Alderman Nowley.
