Bobby Jenkins helps Randolph Public Schools get \$3018

Bobby Jenkins, former Superintendent of Randolph County Public School District, notified the school board and current superintendent that the schools were listed by the State of Georgia as having 7 accounts of unclaimed funds owed to them. The State only lists unclaimed funds accounts if they are worth at least \$50. Jenkins estimated that the schools were owed a minimum of \$350, making it worth the small effort to investigate. Jenkins provided the schools with the process for investigating these accounts so that they could proceed. As it turns out, the schools were owed \$3018 which they can reclaim at no cost to themselves.

Jenkins said, "I spent twelve years leading the Randolph County Public Schools and which I attended as a student growing up in Cuthbert. The schools are close to my heart and I was delighted to be able to provide them with the opportunity for some extra income that they did not expect. My interest is not only in the public schools. Now that I have come to understand the process for recovering unclaimed funds for the state, I will be looking for accounts for my neighbors and friends in Cuthbert."

Henry Cook, a longtime member of the school board, said: "Our schools, our children and their teachers need all the help that they can get, and this came out of the blue. We are all grateful that Mr. Jenkins found this extra funding for us."
