"Why Your Advance Directive Could Fail"

TOP TEN REASONS FOR FAILURE

- 1. Copy of AD not provided to family or medical team
- 2. Others are unaware AD was ever completed or where it is
- 3. Surrogate unaware they were chosen
- 4. Surrogate unavailable when needed
- 5. **Surrogate is not qualified** to make the decisions, so staff will not follow them
- 6. Surrogate refuses to follow the directive
- 7. **Pt never had meaningful conversations** with the surrogate, family or doctor about their values and treatment goals
- 8. **Pt preferences changed** through the years, but they never updated their AD
- 9. **Family members disagree** on what is "best" care, so conflicts arise
- 10. **Ad is hard to interpret** because of vague, subjective or boilerplate terms like:

Heroic Measures -- Quality of Life -- No Hope of Recovery



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
