



Texas Coastal CattleWomen Memorial or Honor Scholarship for 2019 - 2020

History

Texas Coastal CattleWomen (TCCW) is a 501c3 local affiliate of Texas CattleWomen, Inc. (TCW) and American National CattleWomen (ANCW). Our purpose is to work for the betterment of the beef industry through promoting beef, education, and legislation. Our local organization welcomes members from any county in Texas to work with us in the serving of the following counties: Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, Waller, and Wharton.

Texas Coastal CattleWomen Memorial or Honor Scholarship is designed to honor or be in memory of a member, friend or loved one. Scholarships in the amount of \$500 or more are awarded to selected applicant(s) as funds are available annually.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicant (male or female):

1. Classification:
 - a. Graduating senior from a Texas high school.
 - i. Must be accepted in a Texas junior or four year publicly funded or Texas private college, or Texas university.
 - ii. Must have grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.
 - b. College or University Sophomore through Senior level student. (30 completed semester hours)
 - i. Must attend a Texas junior college or a four-year college publicly funded or Texas private college, or Texas university.
 - ii. Must have grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.
2. Residence:
 - a. Must be a United States citizen (US-born or naturalized) to be considered.
 - b. Must have graduated from a Texas High School or equivalent in one of the above-named counties.



- c. Must maintain a permanent address in one of the named counties. (via parent or guardian's address is acceptable)
3. Major (or their equivalent) in one of the following:
 - a. Agriculture
 - b. Consumer Science
 - c. Hotel & Restaurant Management
4. Enrolled Credit Hours:
 - a. Students must be enrolled and maintain twelve (12) semester hours minimum each semester.
5. Financial:
 - a. Must show financial need.
6. Student Qualities:
 - a. Must show evidence of leadership qualities and participation in associated student activities.
 - b. Must show evidence of being a well-balanced individual, considering physical, mental and social development with high moral standards.
 - c. Must show display the ability to relate and work well with others.
 - d. Must show an interest in and wiliness to support production and consumption of beef.
7. Additional Requirements:
 - a. Student must have participated in 4-H, FFA or consumer science for one or more years in high school.

Application Instructions

Applicant will email to Scholarship Committee at TCCWscholarship@gmail.com in .PDF or .JPEG format:

1. Type or print TCCW Application, completing all information requested.
2. Type personal essay (500 words or less) about yourself, your interest in and willingness to support the beef industry as well as your career goals.
3. Transcript:
 - a. If high school senior applicant - Official high school transcript.
 - b. If college applicant - Most recent college transcript reflecting hours, including GPA.
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation from non-related people, e.g., a responsible church, community, or school professional.



The applicant must provide the completed *Texas Coastal CattleWomen Scholarship Application* and all above items to be considered no later than **June 30th**. Late applications and supporting documents will not be accepted. No exceptions.

Applicant Acceptance

Applicant agrees if selected:

1. To acknowledge that TCCW scholarship payments, depending on the amount, may be made in two installments. If a second installment is to be made, it will be in the spring semester with proof of maintained eligibility and meeting the required TCCW deadlines.
2. To provide any changes to personal contact information, such as address, phone and email, to the Scholarship Committee at TCCWscholarship@gmail.com within seven (7) days of such occurrence. Failure to send could result in the forfeiting of the remaining scholarship balance.
3. To send proof of enrollment no later than September 15. Failure to send could result in the forfeiting of the remaining scholarship balance. Proof must be emailed to Scholarship Committee at TCCWscholarship@gmail.com in .PDF or .JPEG format.
4. To send an official transcript showing the minimum required hours was completed, showing a grade point of 2.5 was maintained, during the fall semester no later than January 20 to receive the money for the spring semester. Failure to send could result in the forfeiting of the remaining scholarship balance. Proof must be emailed to Scholarship Committee at TCCWscholarship@gmail.com in .PDF or .JPEG format.
5. To provide a photo in .JPEG or .TIFF format and authorize TCCW to publish this photo and his/her name and likeness, in TCCW's print, online and video-based marketing materials, as well as other publications, social media sites and fundraiser promotions.
6. To use scholarship money towards IRS deemed Qualified Education Expenses, else reimburse to TCCW. IRS deemed expenses are as follows:
 - a. Tuition and fees *required* for enrollment or attendance.
 - b. Fees, books, supplies and equipment *required* for course work.

Summary

Scholarship Applicants will be notified of his or her selection or rejection by July 15. TCCW Memorial and Honor Scholarships are offered as available. Both applicants who are selected and those not selected are encouraged to reapply annually.



Scholarship Applicants related to a member or members of the Texas Coastal CattleWomen Scholarship Committee are not eligible to apply for Texas Coastal CattleWomen Scholarships.
