COVENANT REMINDERS (THE SHORT LIST)

We get it. Covenants can be long and confusing. Here are the rules that matter most:

- Fences, sheds, and exterior changes? Get written HOA approval first (submit an ACR).
- No boats, RVs, or trailers parked for more than 30 days per year.
- Lawn not mowed?
 You'll have 7 days after a notice to fix it.
- Trash, snow, noise? You have 1 day to resolve.
- Home businesses (like salons, tutoring, or Etsy shops) are allowed, auto repair is not.
- Annual dues are mandatory and late payments accrue 12% interest.

BYLAWS REMINDERS

- Annual Meeting
 happens once a year.
 Major decisions (like
 budget or amendments)
 are voted on here.
- You're automatically a member of the HOA if you own a home in Sunrise.
- Each household gets one vote in HOA matters, regardless of how many people live there.
- The HOA Board sets
 rules and budgets and
 can levy fines for
 violations.
- Fines can be up to \$100 per incident, plus 12% annual interest if unpaid.
- You can amend the bylaws or covenants with a 60% (bylaw) or two-thirds (covenant) owner vote.
