## What's this story about?

## Talk together

Talk about things children play on in the park or playground.

### Read the story





- Look at the cover and read the title. Ask, "What do you think will happen in the story?"
- Help children work out new words by sounding out the phonemes or breaking them into two parts, e.g. on page 1, break 'everyone' into 'every' and 'one'.
- Check that they recognise the change in wording from 'went to' to 'went on'.
- Talk about why Floppy went to sleep at the end.






Everyone went to the park.



Chip went on the slide.






Biff went on the horse.

## Play a game

#### Think of a rhyme

#### To help with spelling.

- Choose a word from the story e.g. 'slide'. Say, "Slide rhymes with hide."
- Let them choose a word and say what rhymes with it, e.g. "Park rhymes with dark."
- Have two or three turns each.

#### Other ideas

You can use these ideas straight away, or on another day.

- Look at the 'NO DOGS' sign. Talk about other signs children might see in the environment and what they mean. Look in a copy of The Highway Code and talk about all the signs.
- Talk about why dogs are not allowed in playgrounds.
