# What's this story about?

Mum and Biff go to the market to buy Floppy a new basket. They leave Floppy while they go to the toilet. Floppy chases a cat through the market, causing mayhem. But when Mum and Biff come back, Floppy is back where they left him, so they think he has been very good!

# Talk together

Talk about what dogs normally do when they see cats.

# Read the story



- Cook at the picture of Floppy and the cat on the cover and help the child to read 'Chase' in the title. Ask, "What do you think the story might be about?"
- W Read the story together.
- Page 1, ask the child to say the sounds in the word 'basket': b-a-s-k-e-t. Do the same with 'market' on page 2.
- Page 5, ask, "What is Biff telling Floppy to do? Do you think he will obey her?"
- Page 9, help the child to work out 'oranges' from the picture and by using the first letter sound. Do the same with 'plates' (page 10) and 'clothes' (page 12).
- Page 16, ask, "Do you think Mum and Biff should have realised Floppy had been running about? Why?"





### Play a game

#### Short words

To help the child to spell short words.

- Open the book and choose a word with two or three letters, e.g. on page 4, choose from 'Mum', 'and', 'to', 'the'. Ask the child to spell the word, then check it in the book.
- Have two or three turns each.

#### Other ideas

You can use these ideas straight away, or on another day.

- Choose a word and see how many times the child can find it in the book, e.g. 'went' (four) 'over' (three) and 'said' (four).
- Use the pictures to play 'I spy', e.g. page 9: "I spy something beginning with 'I'" (lemon).


