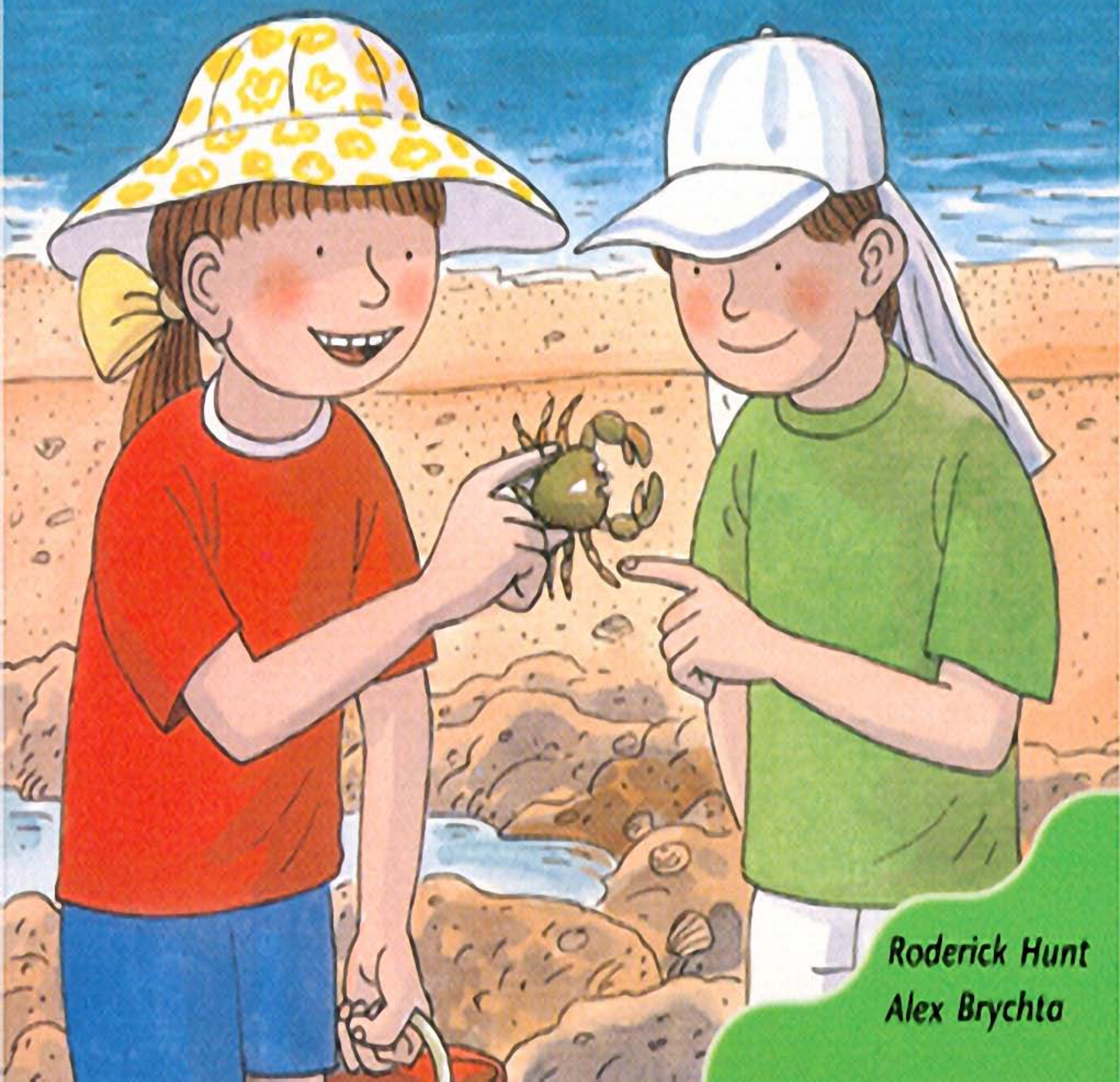

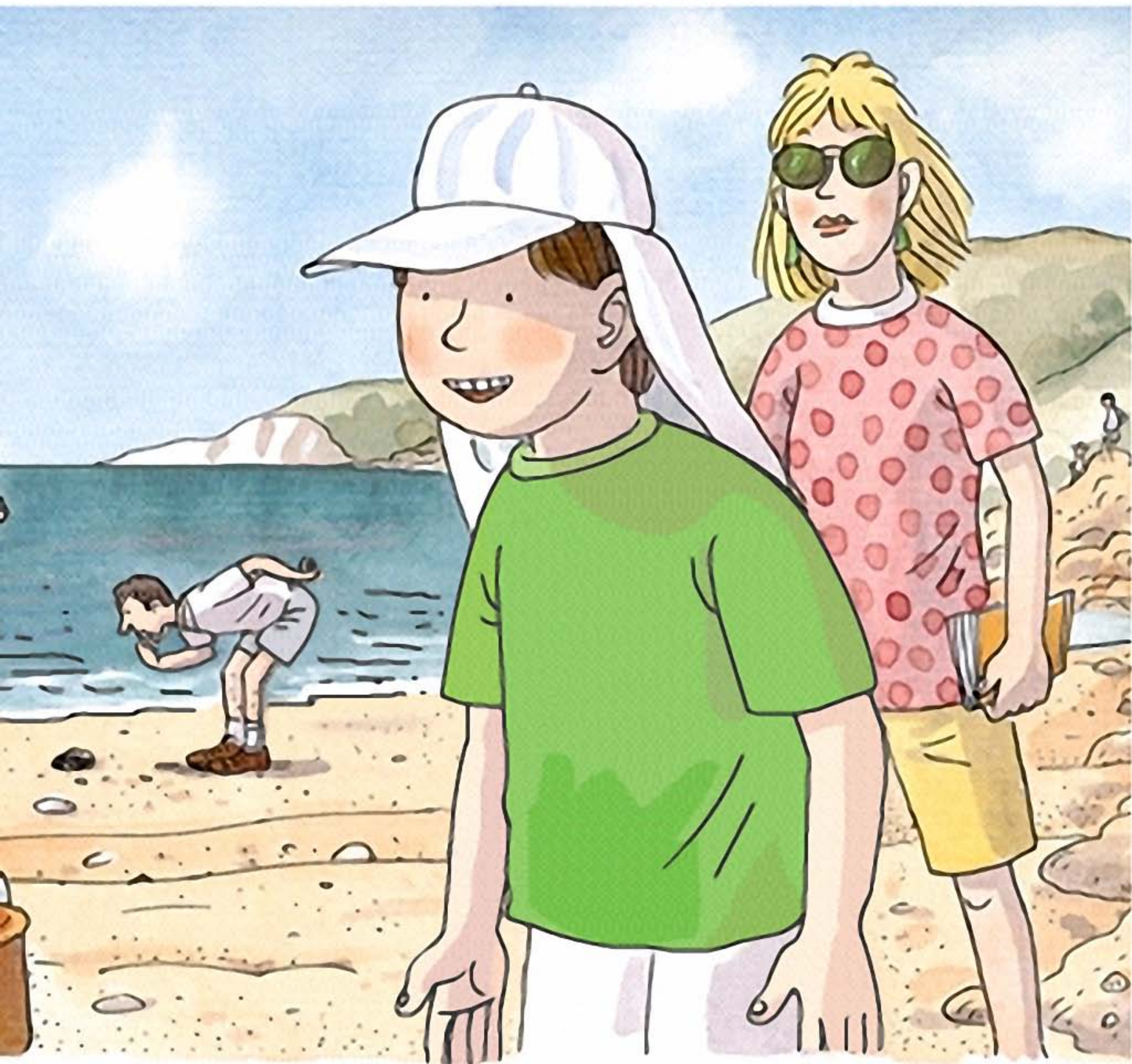
**“Look at this,” said Biff.**

hand.





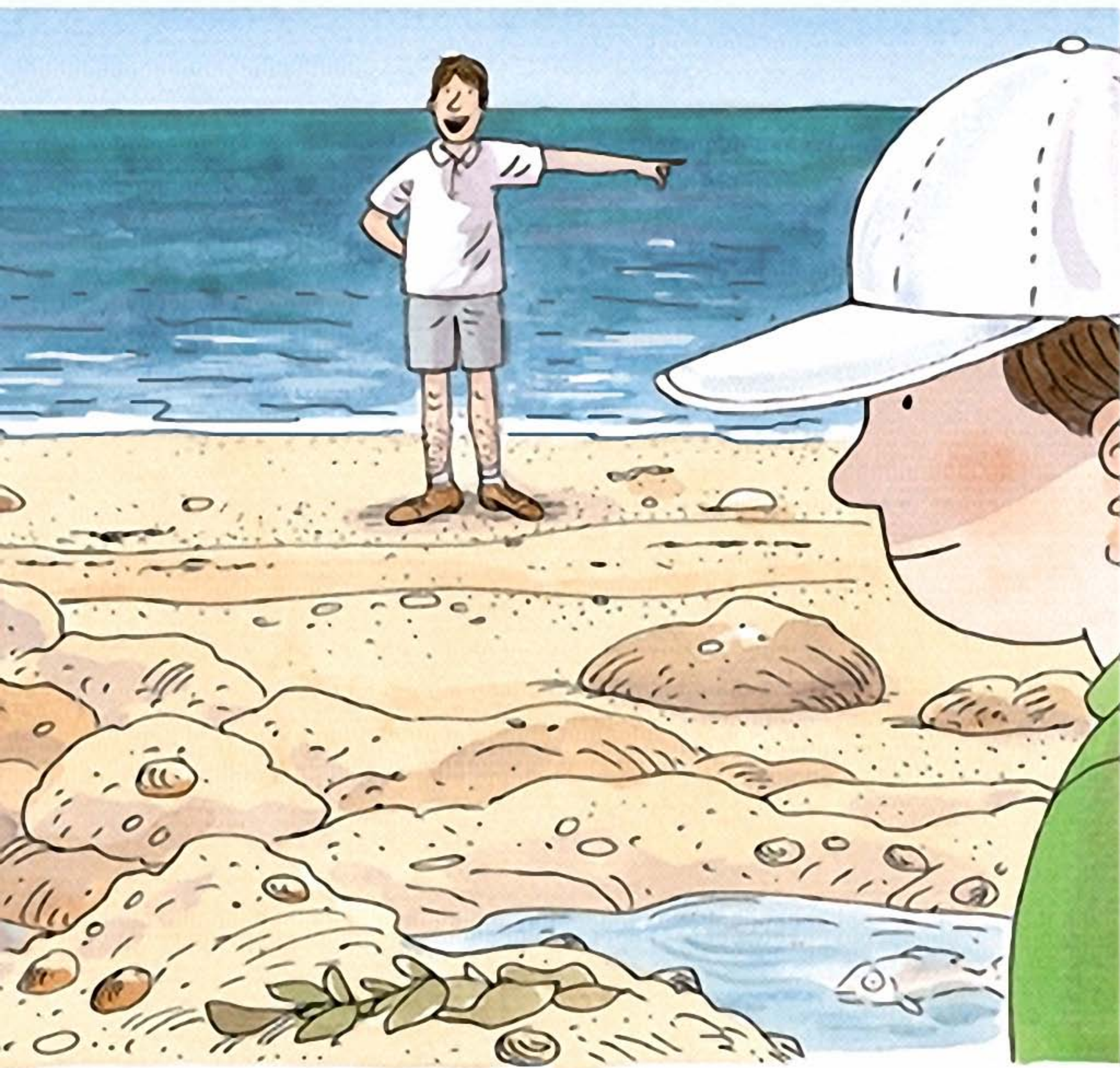
“Put it back,” said Chip.





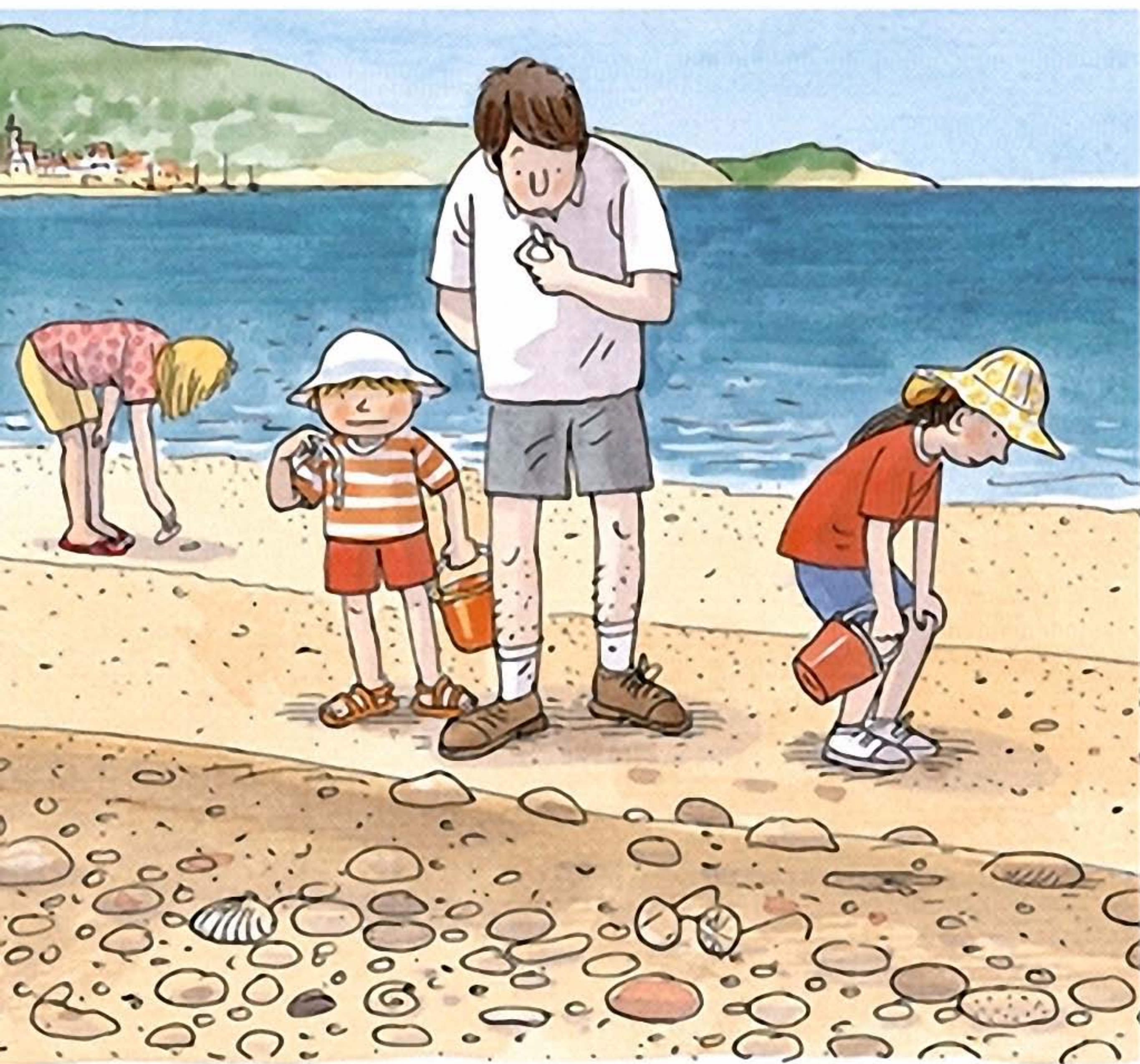
Biff put the crab back.





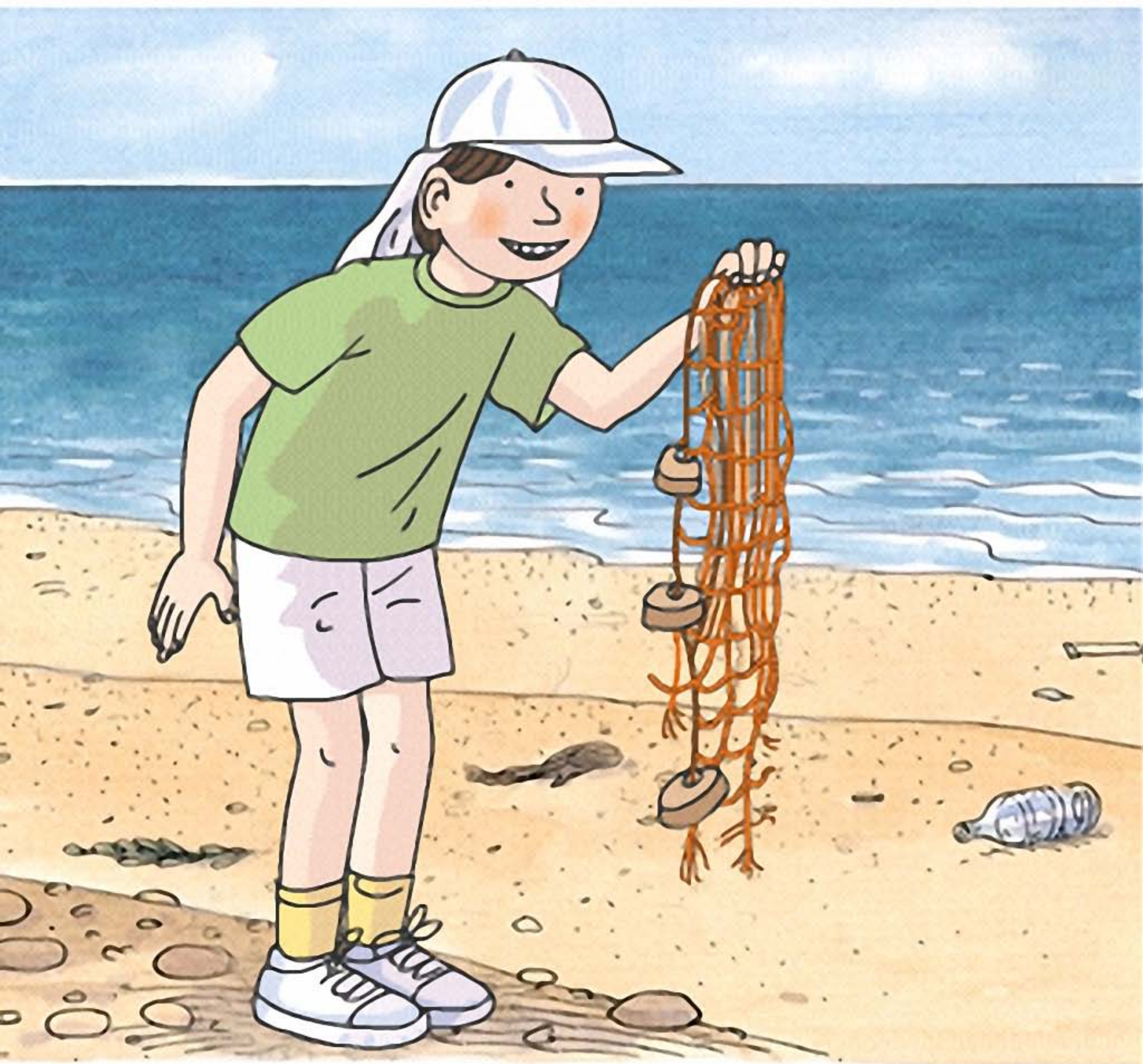
“Let's look on the sand,”  
said Dad.





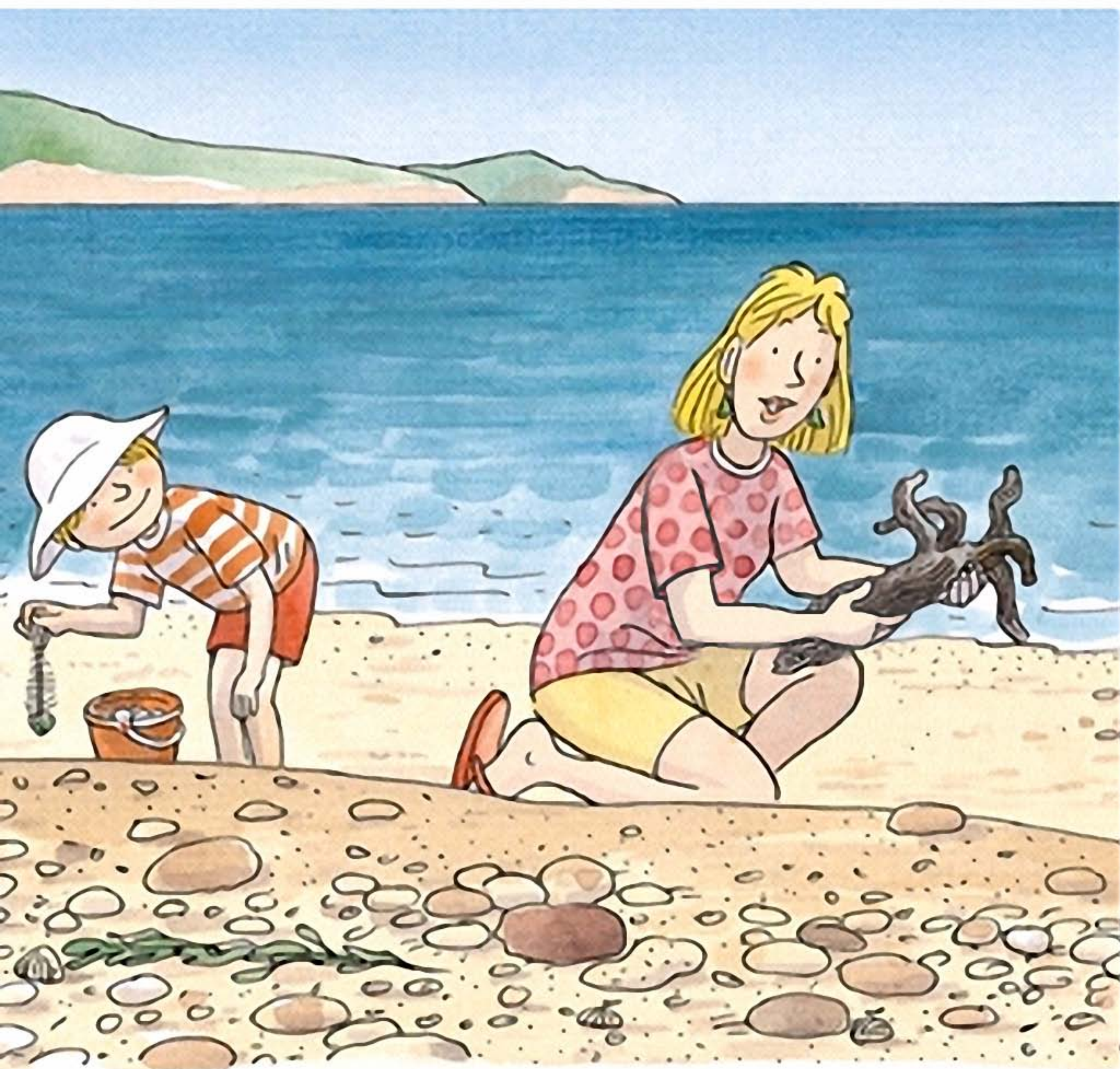
“Come and see this,”  
said Chip.





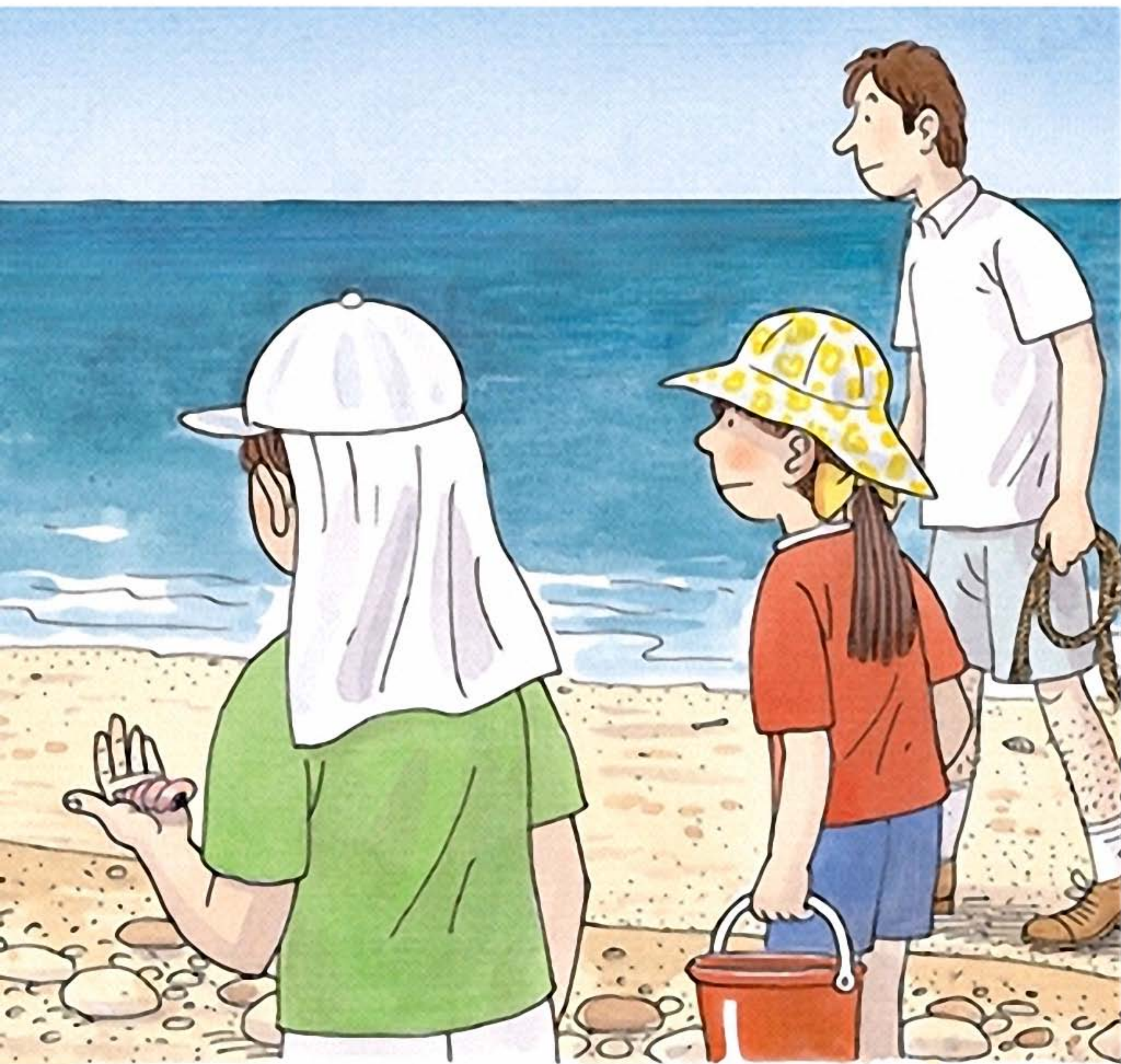
He had a net.

She had a bit of wood.





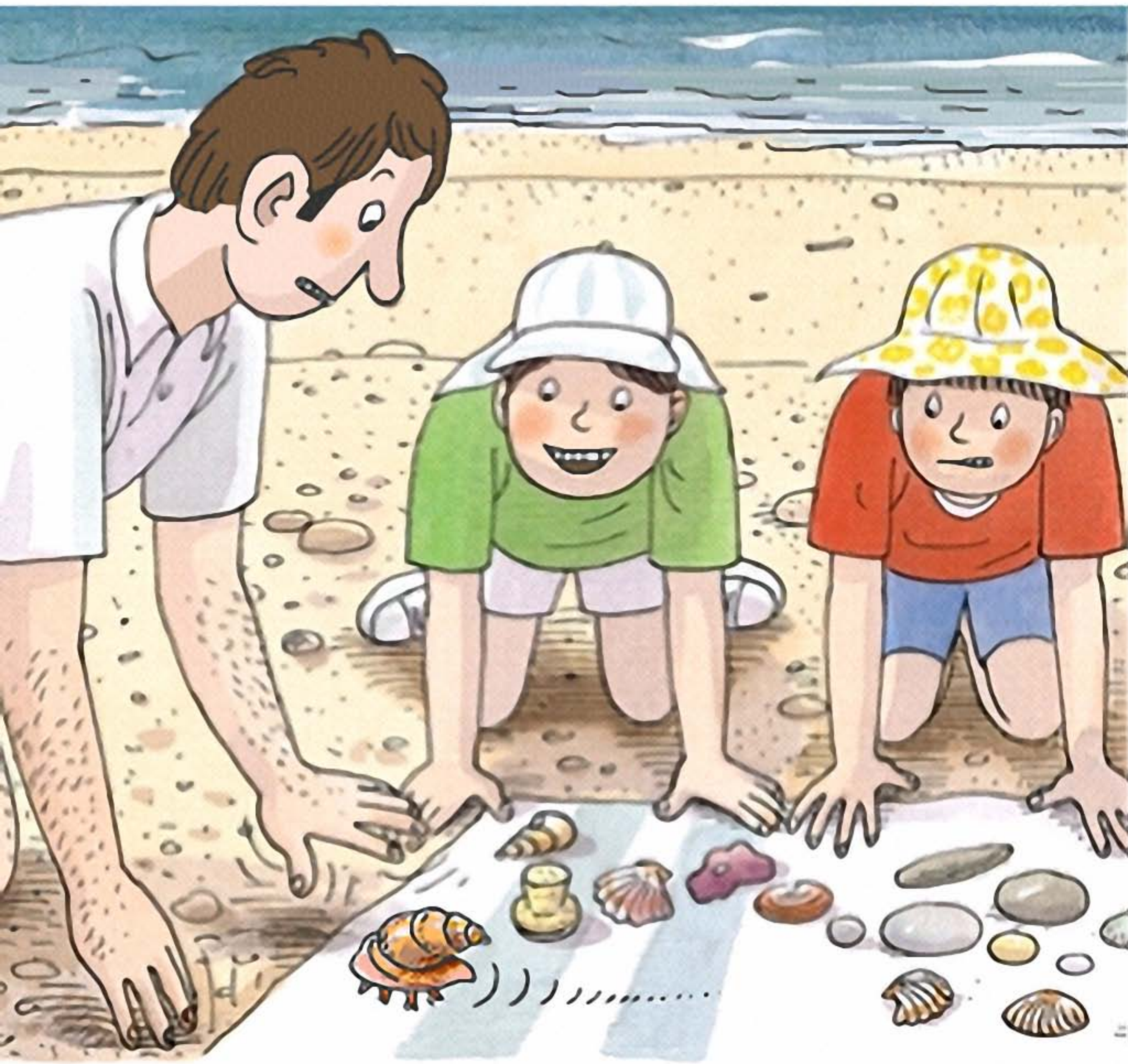
“Look at this shell,”

“This is the best of all.”





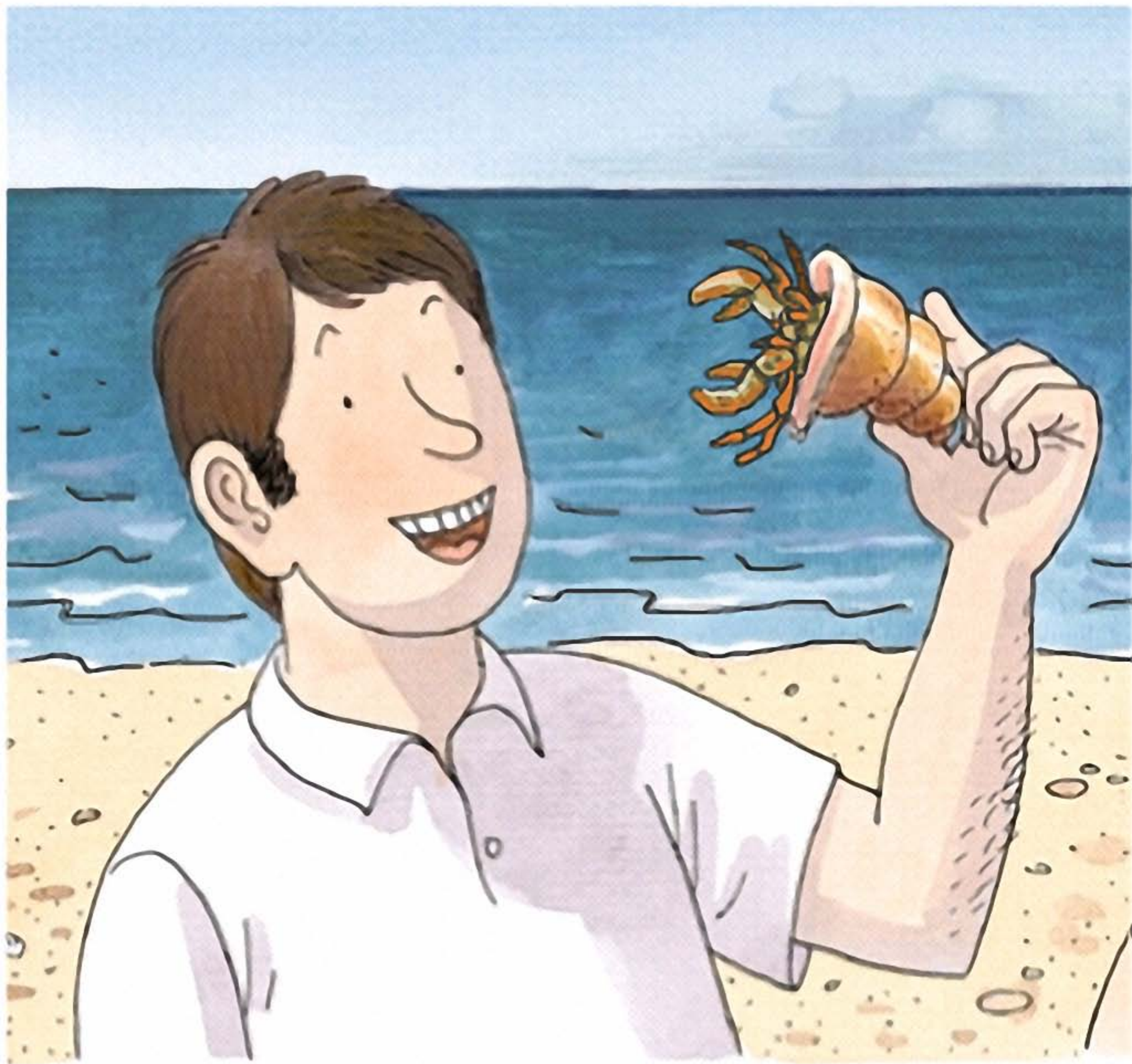
The shell had legs.





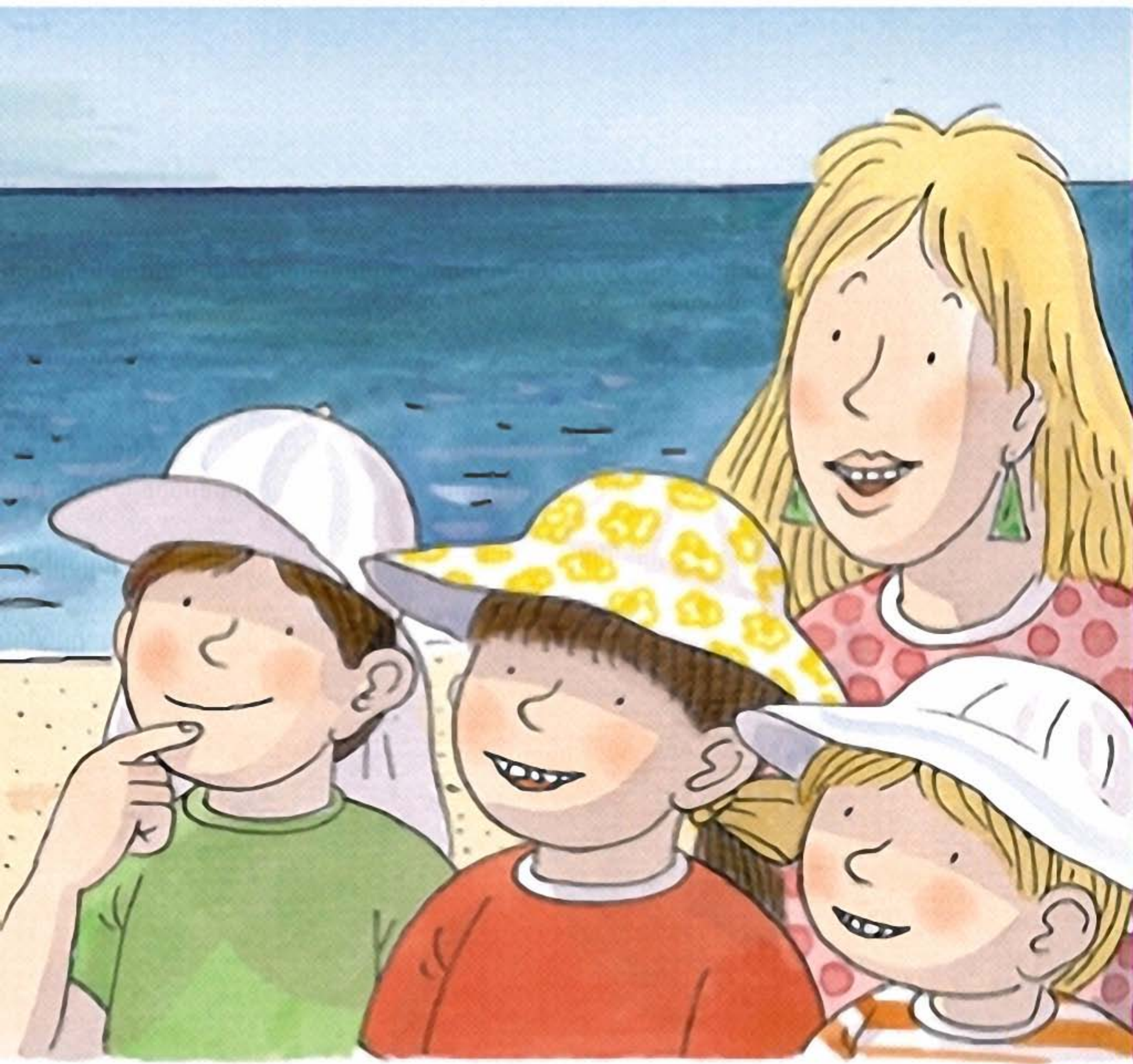
“Oh no!” said Kipper.
