



What's this story about?


The family is having a picnic by a stream. Kipper drops his teddy in the water and everyone tries to save it. In the end Dad saves the day!

Talk together

Look at the cover and talk about what the children might be doing on the bridge. Ask, "Why do you think Kipper looks so worried?"

Read the story


- W = Word recognition G = Language comprehension
- Look at the pictures. Read the story together.
- Pages 4 and 5, encourage the child to sound out the letter sounds in 'dropped' and 'sticks'.
- Page 5, ask, "Why couldn't Kipper see?"
- Page 16, did the child notice the two words in 'frogman'?
- Ask, "Was the water deep or shallow? Why did Dad call himself a frogman? What is a frogman?"




Mum and Dad sat on the rug.

Kipper couldn't see.




Kipper climbed up.

Mum couldn't get Teddy.




"I want Teddy," said Kipper.

What happened next?

To help the child remember the order in which things happen.

- Open the book at any page and ask, "What happened next?"
- After the child has responded, find out if they are right by turning the page.
- Swap roles.

Other ideas


You can use these ideas straight away, or on another day.


- Choose a word from the story, e.g. 'couldn't'. Ask children to find the word in the book.
