What's this story about?

Talk together

Talk about times when it has snowed. Discuss the things you can do in the snow. Talk about the cover. Ask, "What are the children doing?"


Read the story


- **W** = Word recognition **G** = Language comprehension
- Read the title on the cover and show how you can find 'snow' and 'man' in the word 'snowman'.
- Page 3, notice Wilf's dad. Ask, "What do you think he is saying to the children?"
- Page 5, show that 'snowball' is made from two words, 'snow' and 'ball'.
- Page 9, ask, "What do you think the trick will be?"
- Page 14, "What do you think will happen next?"




It was snowing.
"Hooray," said the children.


They saw Wilf and Wilma.






Wilf was sweeping the snow.

The children made a giant snowman.











He saw the snowman.

- Look at Kipper's hands on page 7. Look back to find out what happened to his gloves.
