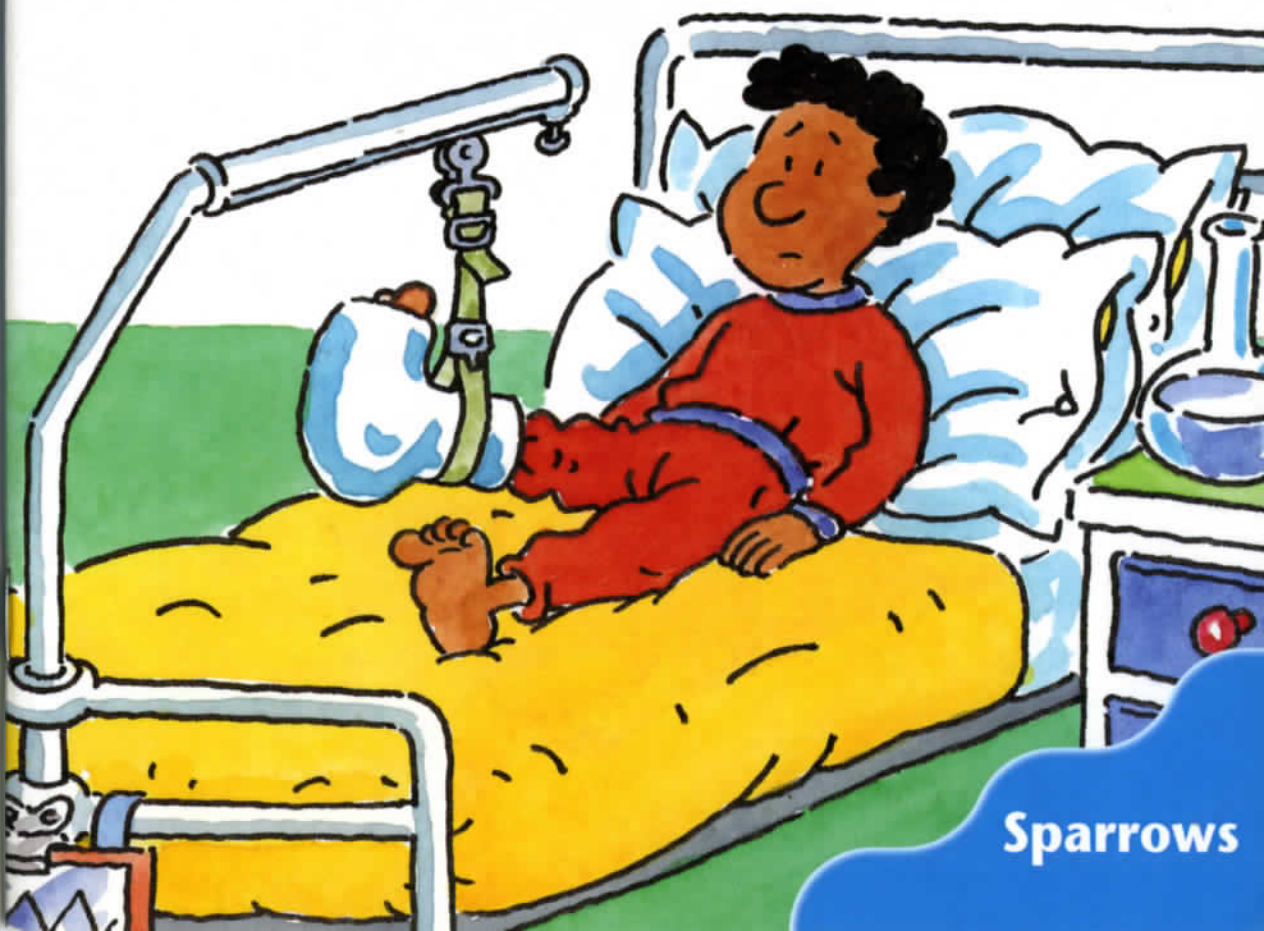

Midge was frightened. He didn't want to go to hospital.

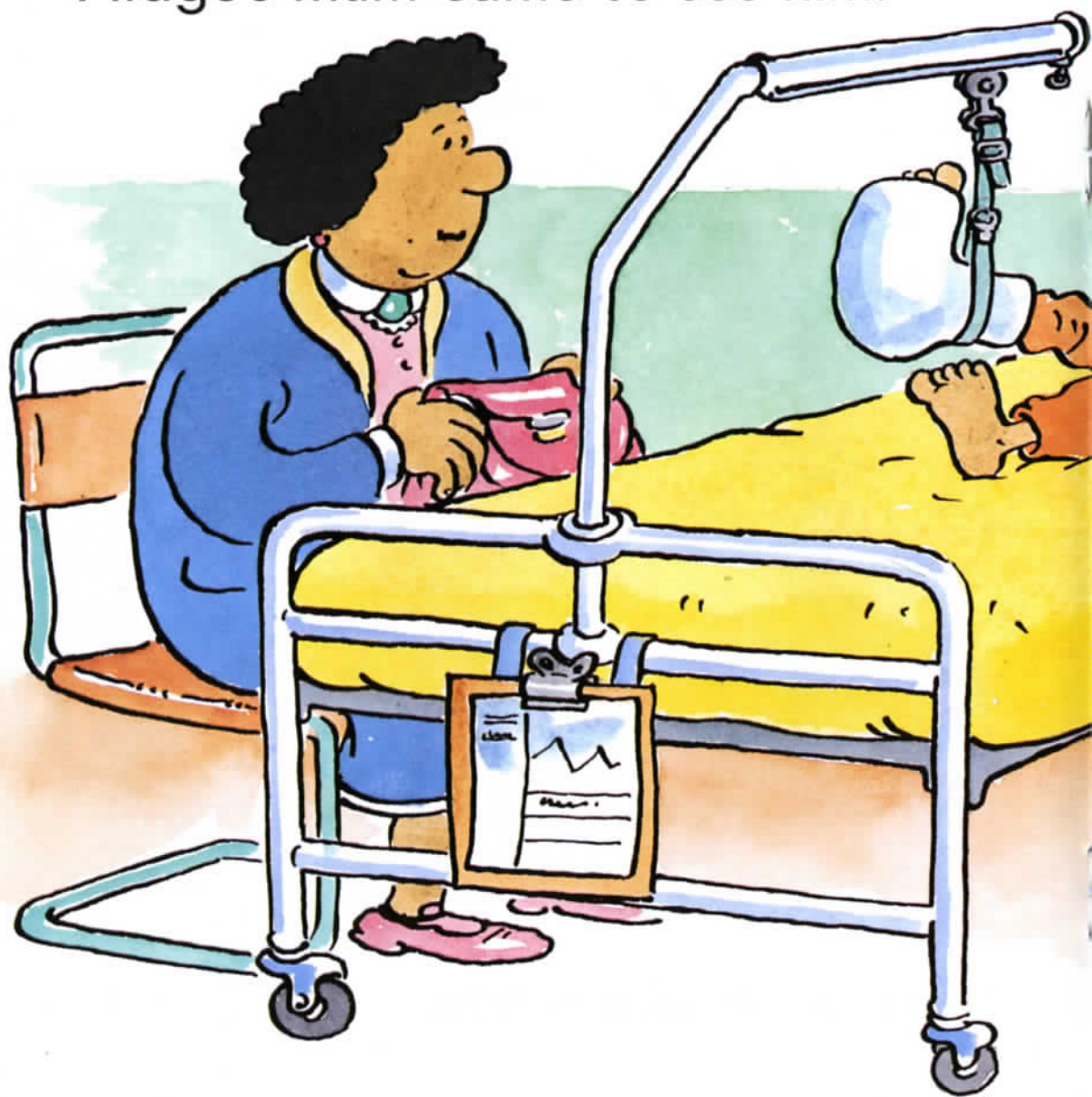
A doctor looked at Midge's foot.

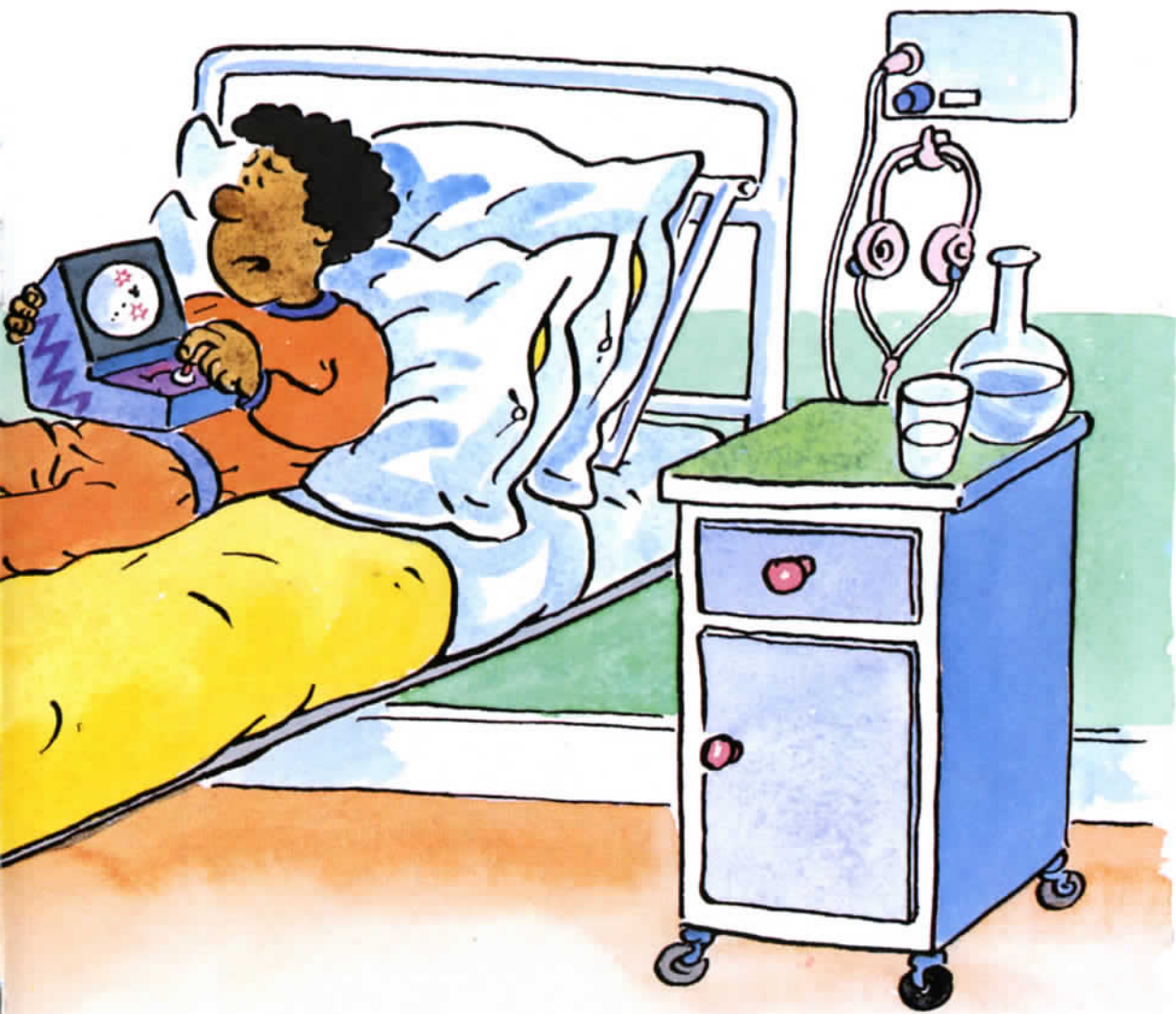




A doctor gave Midge a sweet.

Midge's mum came to see him.

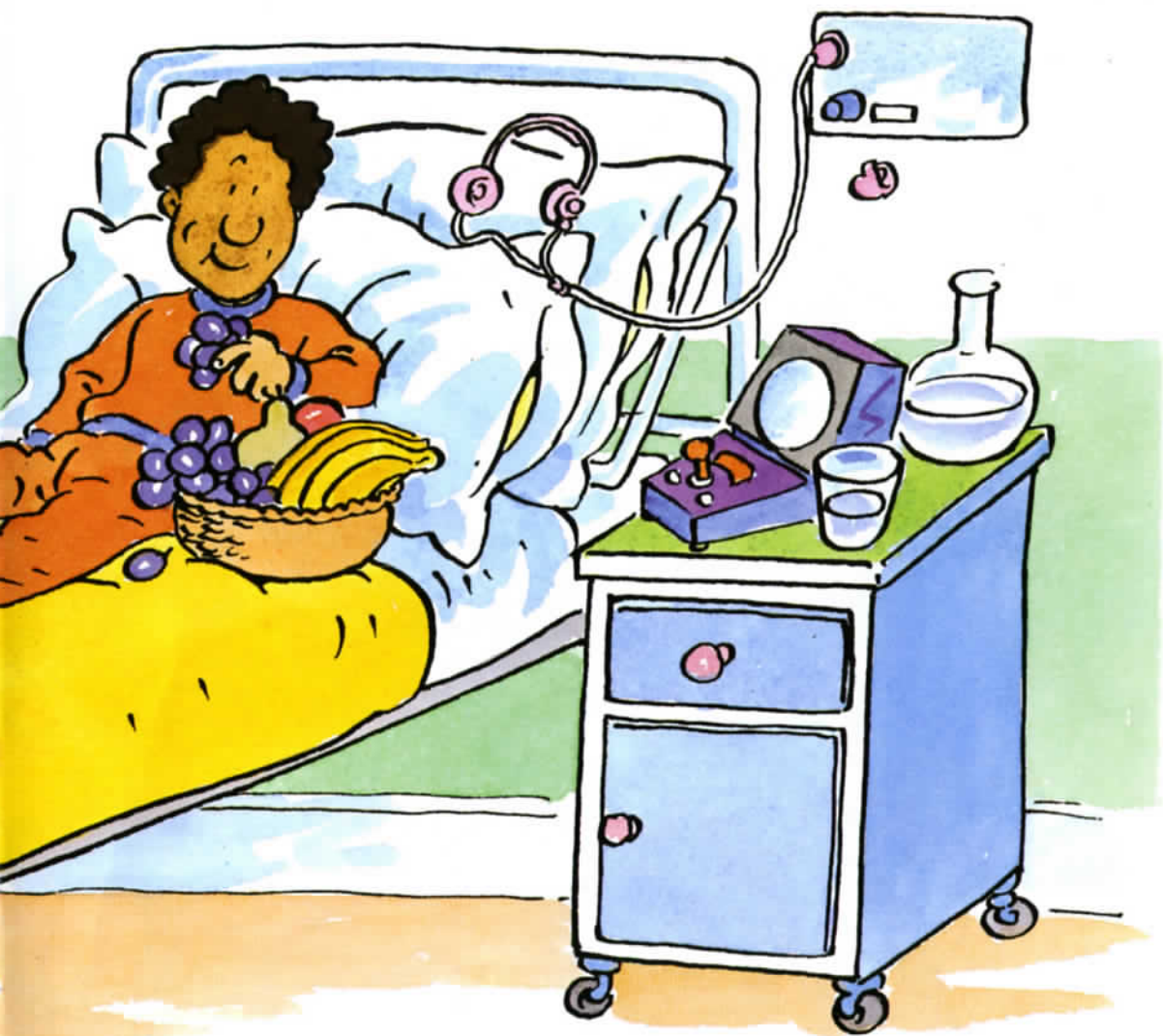




She gave him a toy.

said Midge.







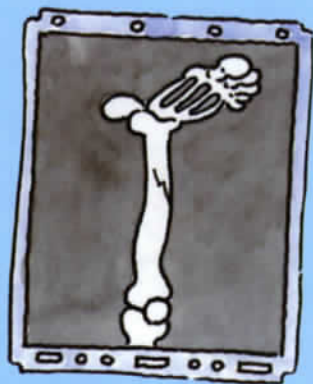
