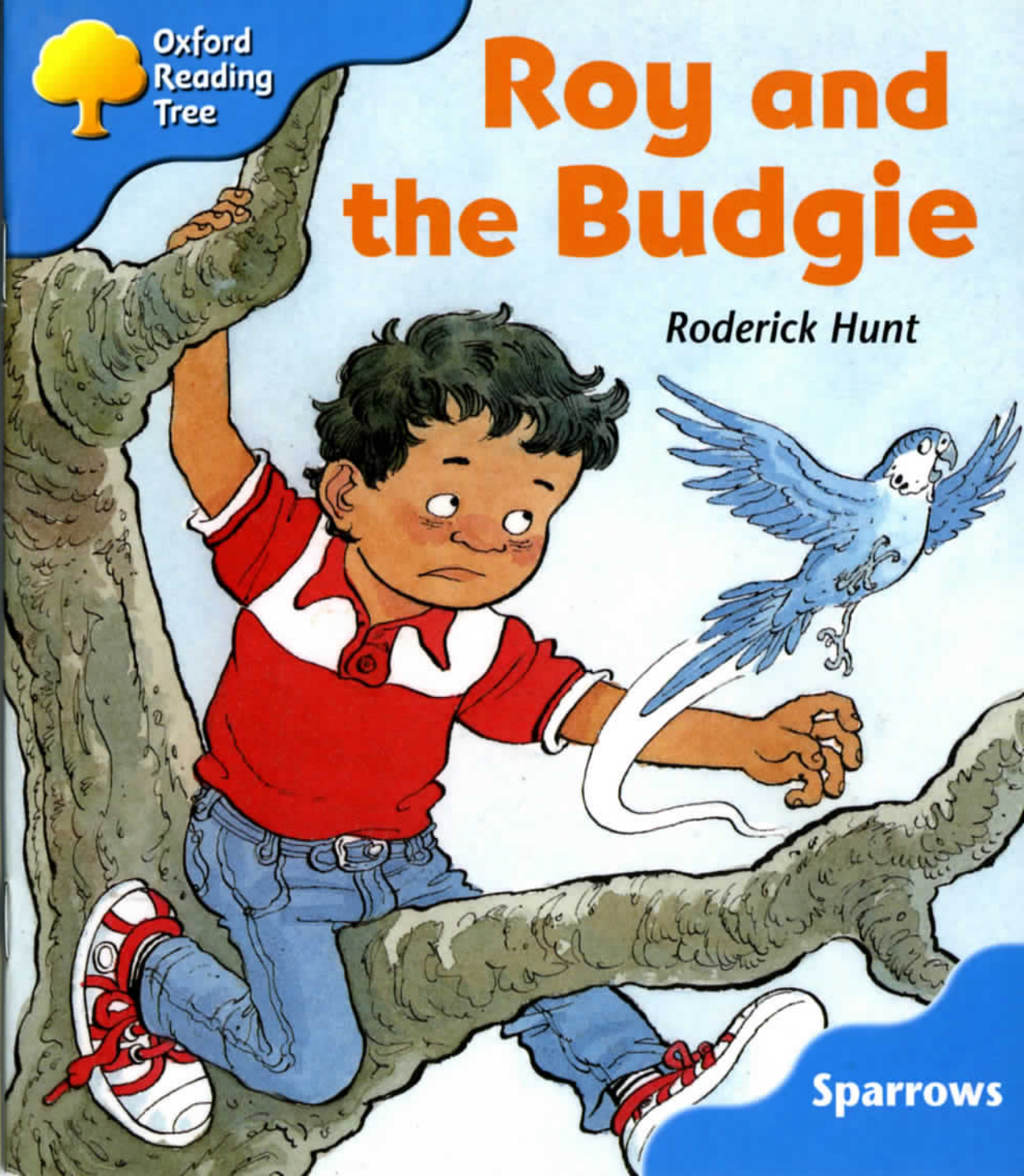

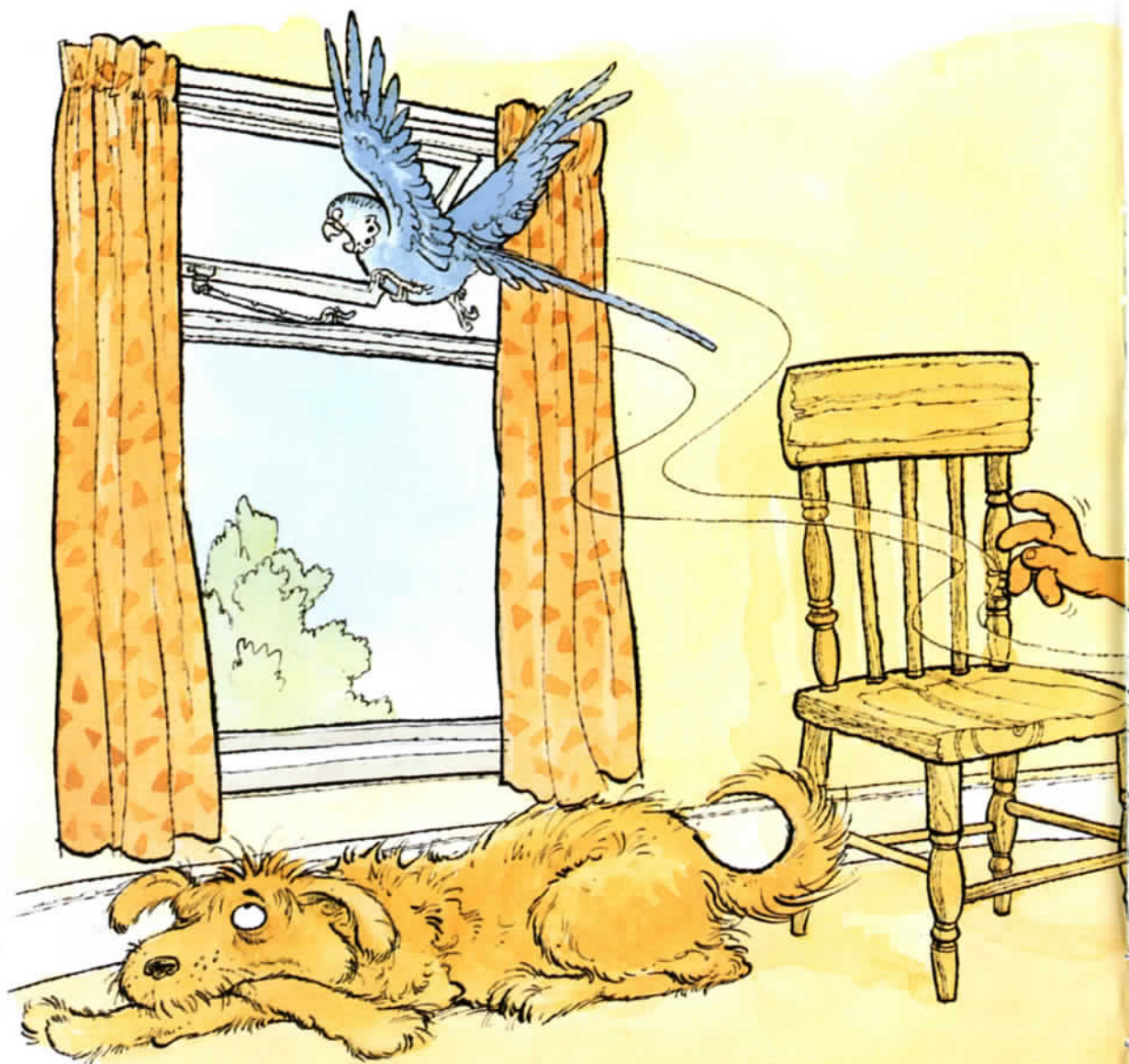

Joey.



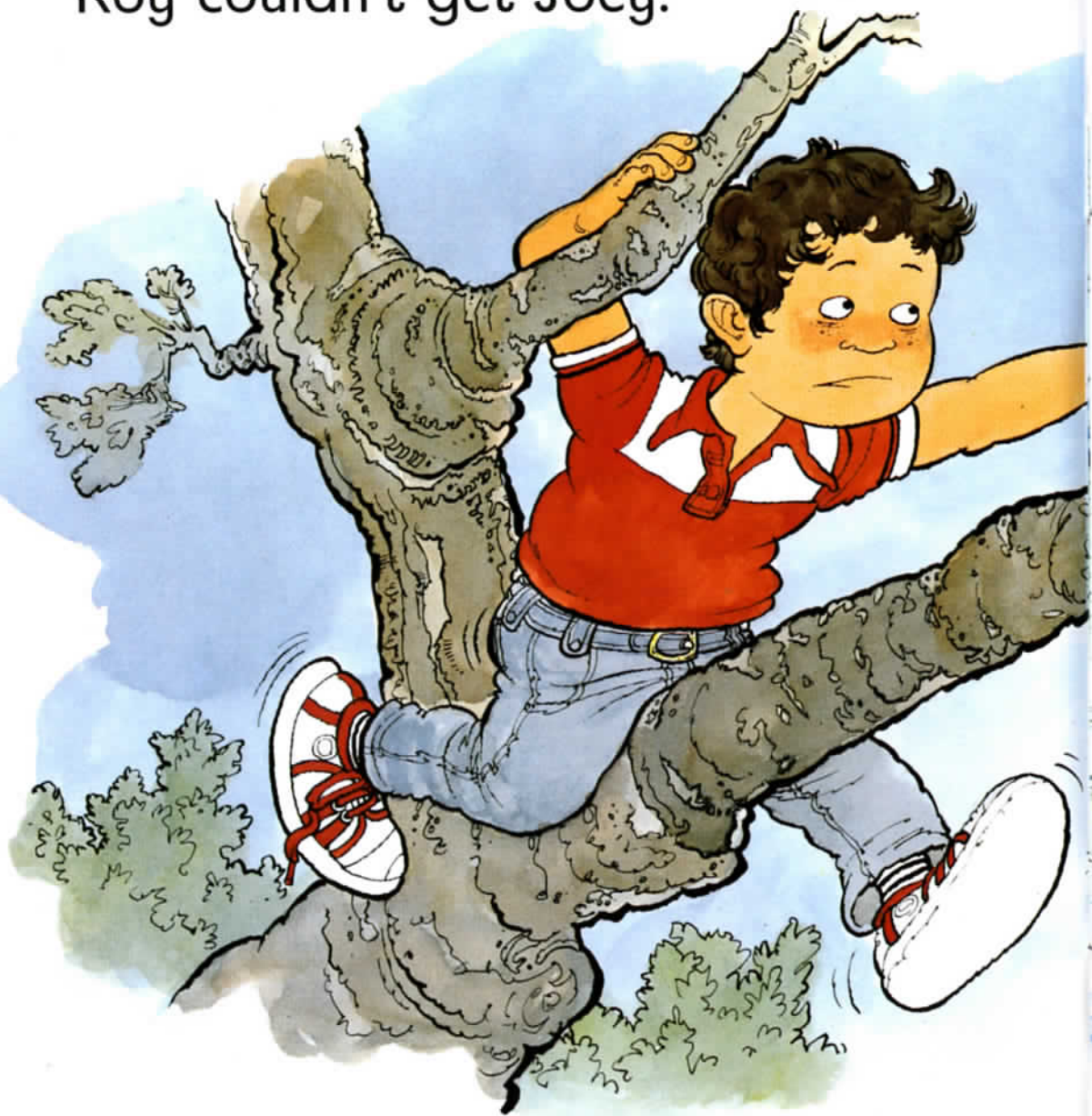


Joey flew outside.

“Oh no!” said Roy.



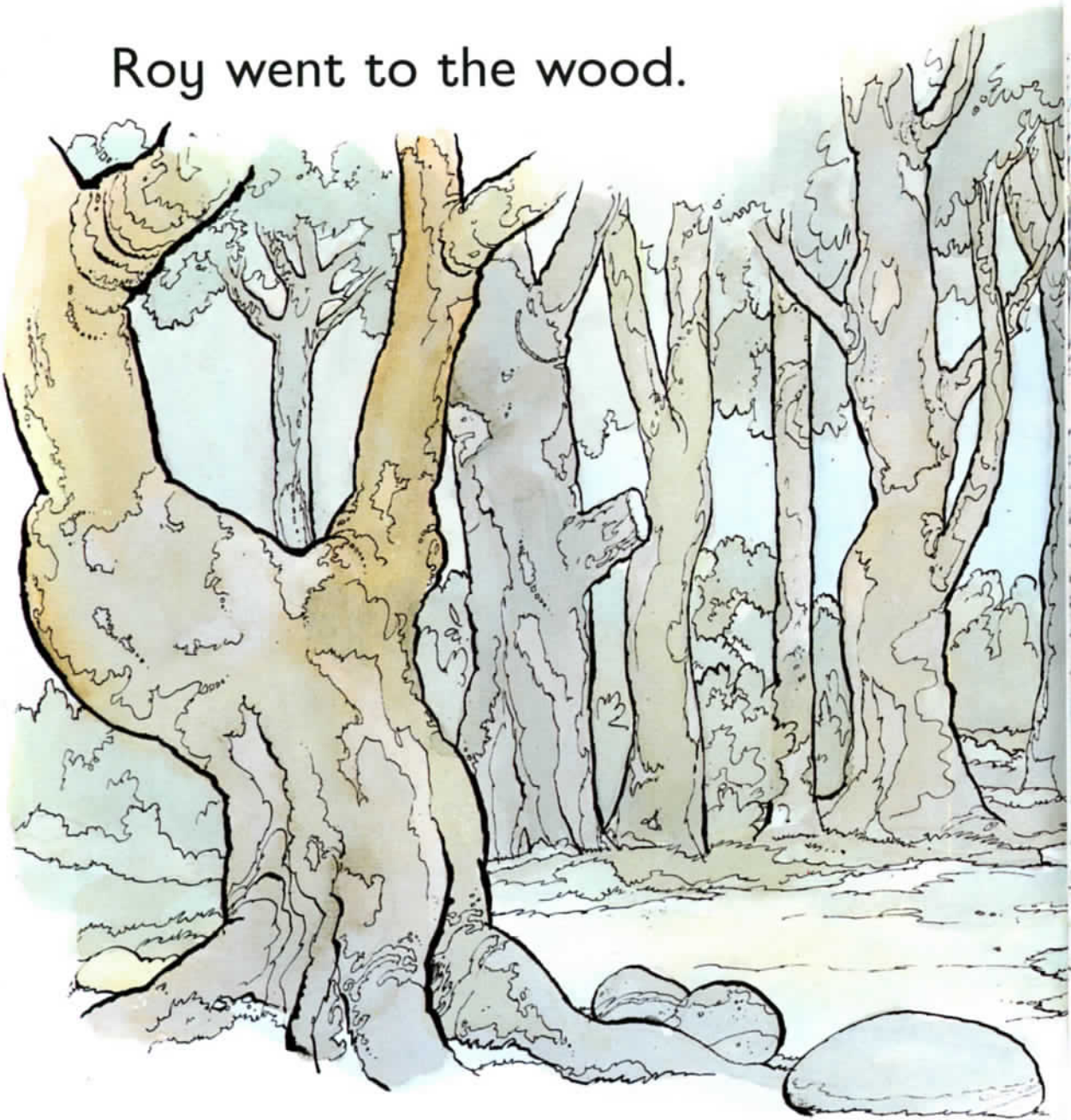
Roy couldn't get Joey.

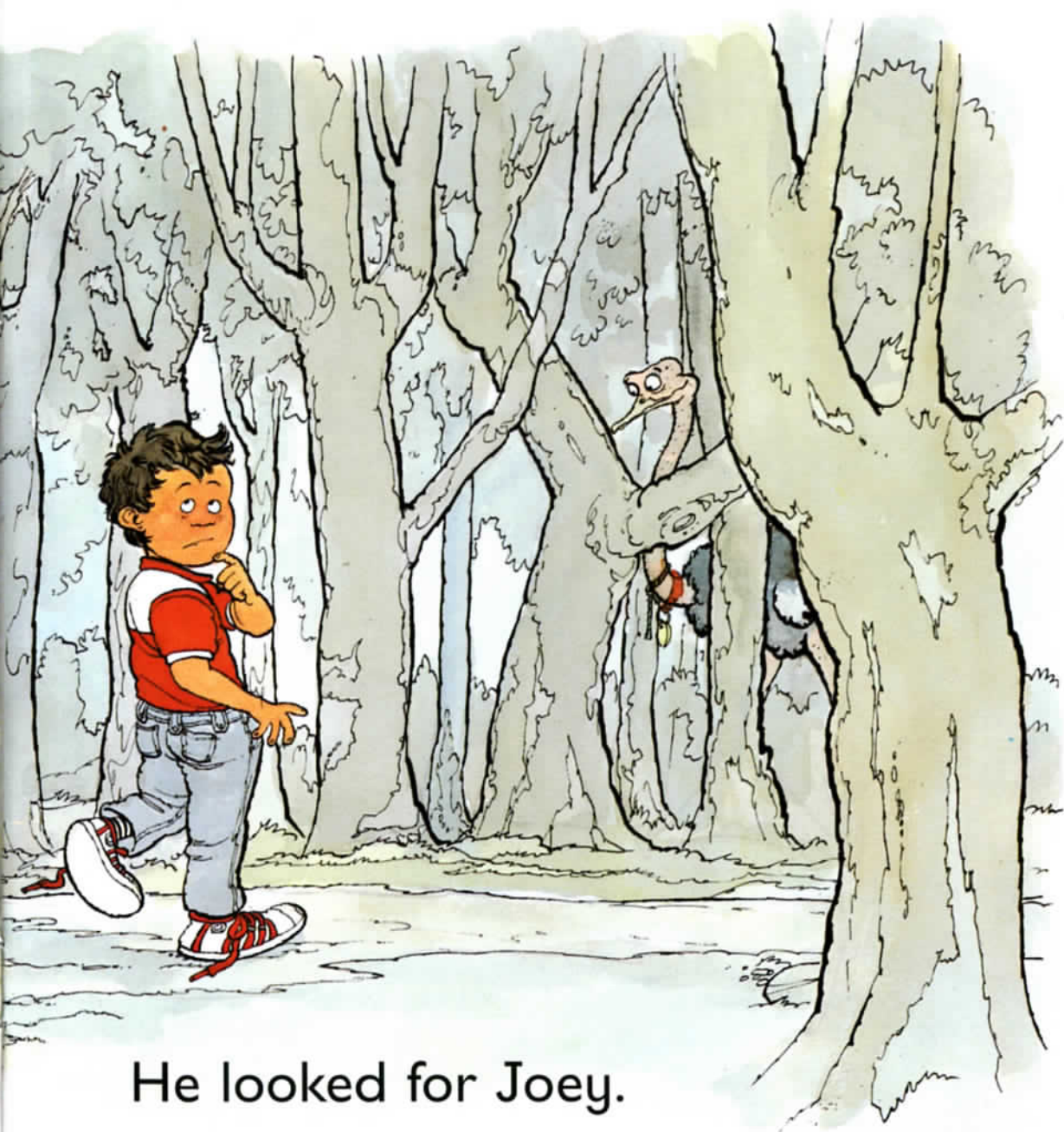




Joey flew away.

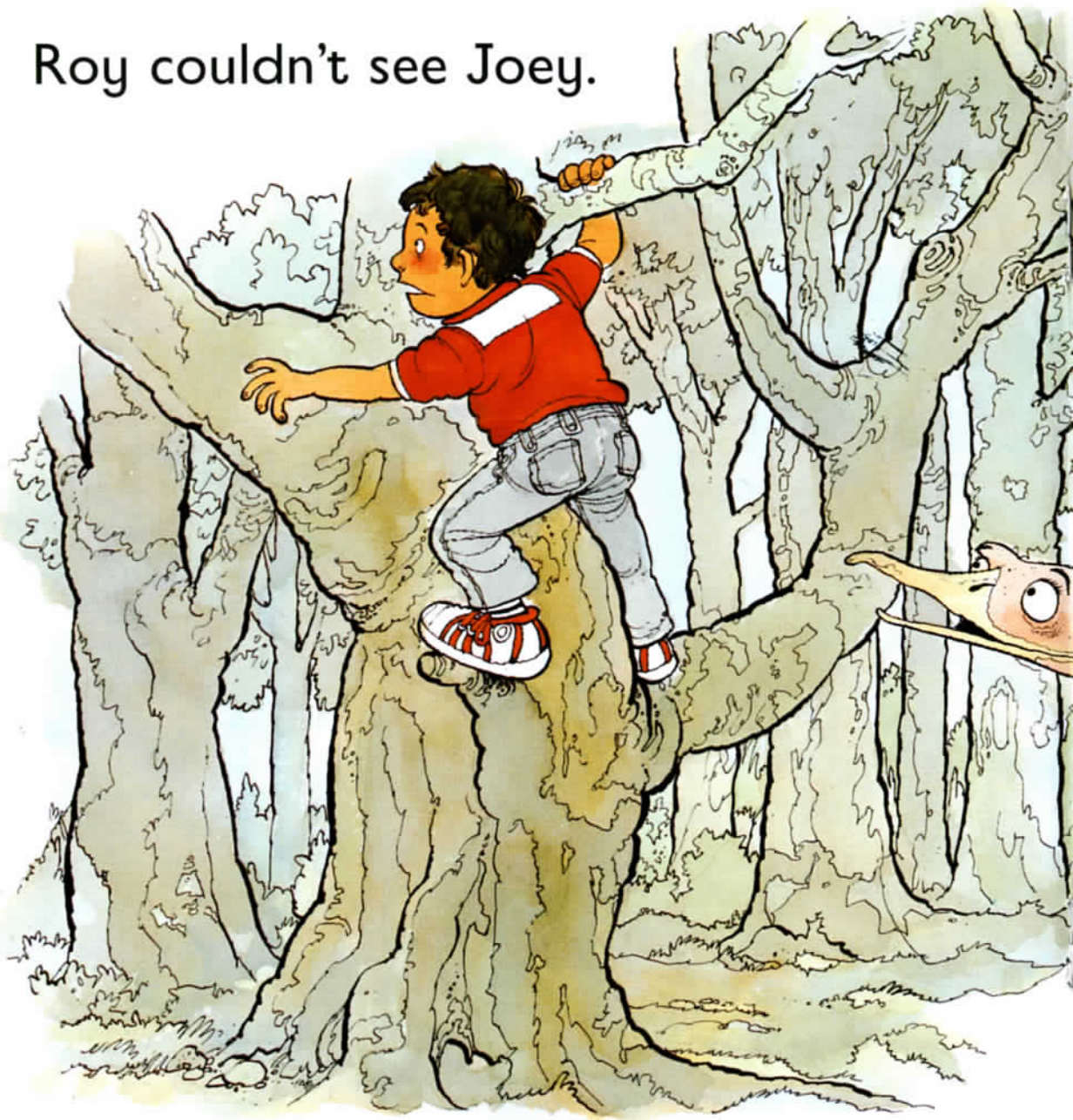
Roy went to the wood.

Roy couldn't see Joey.





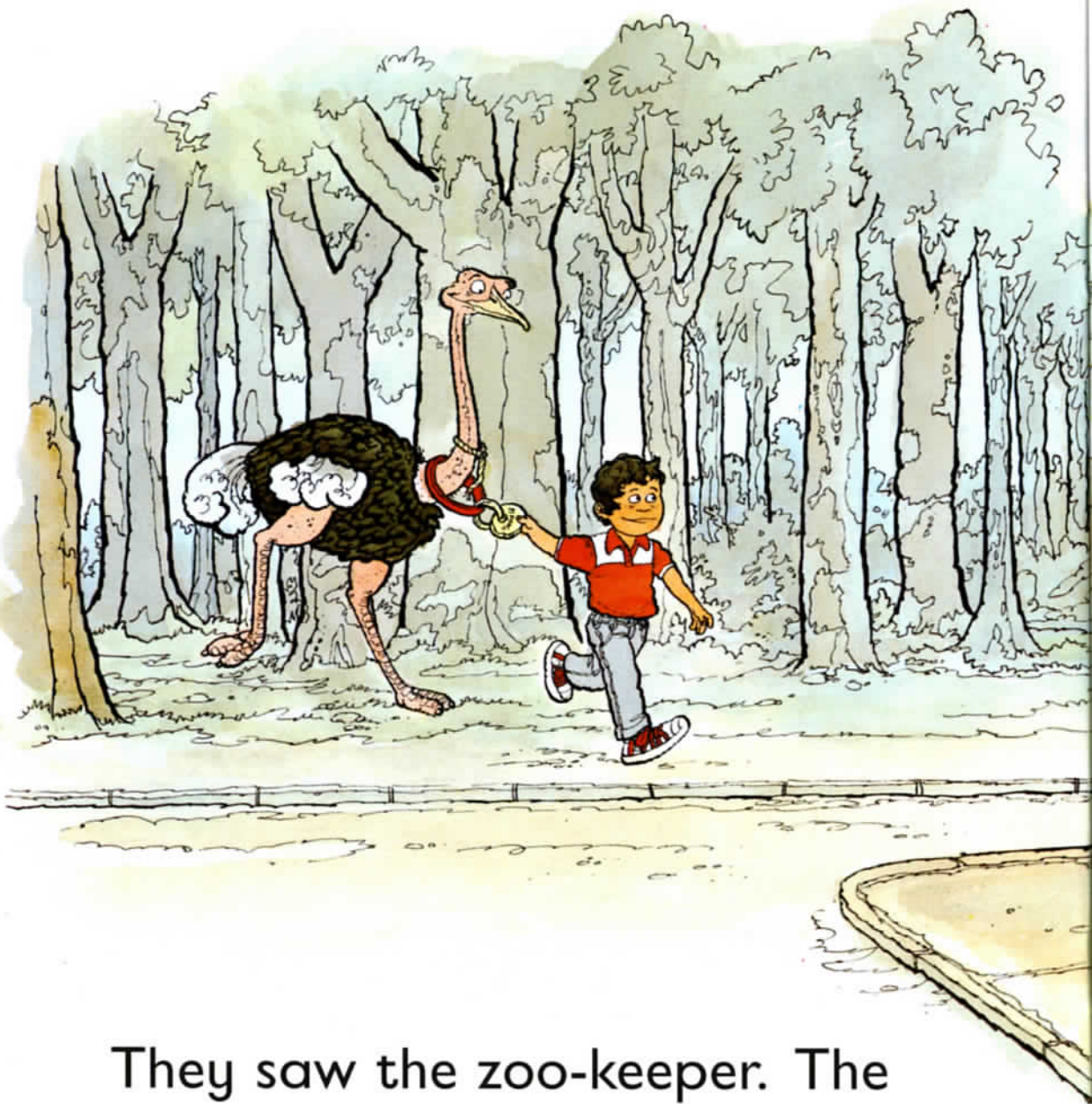
An ostrich was in the wood.
