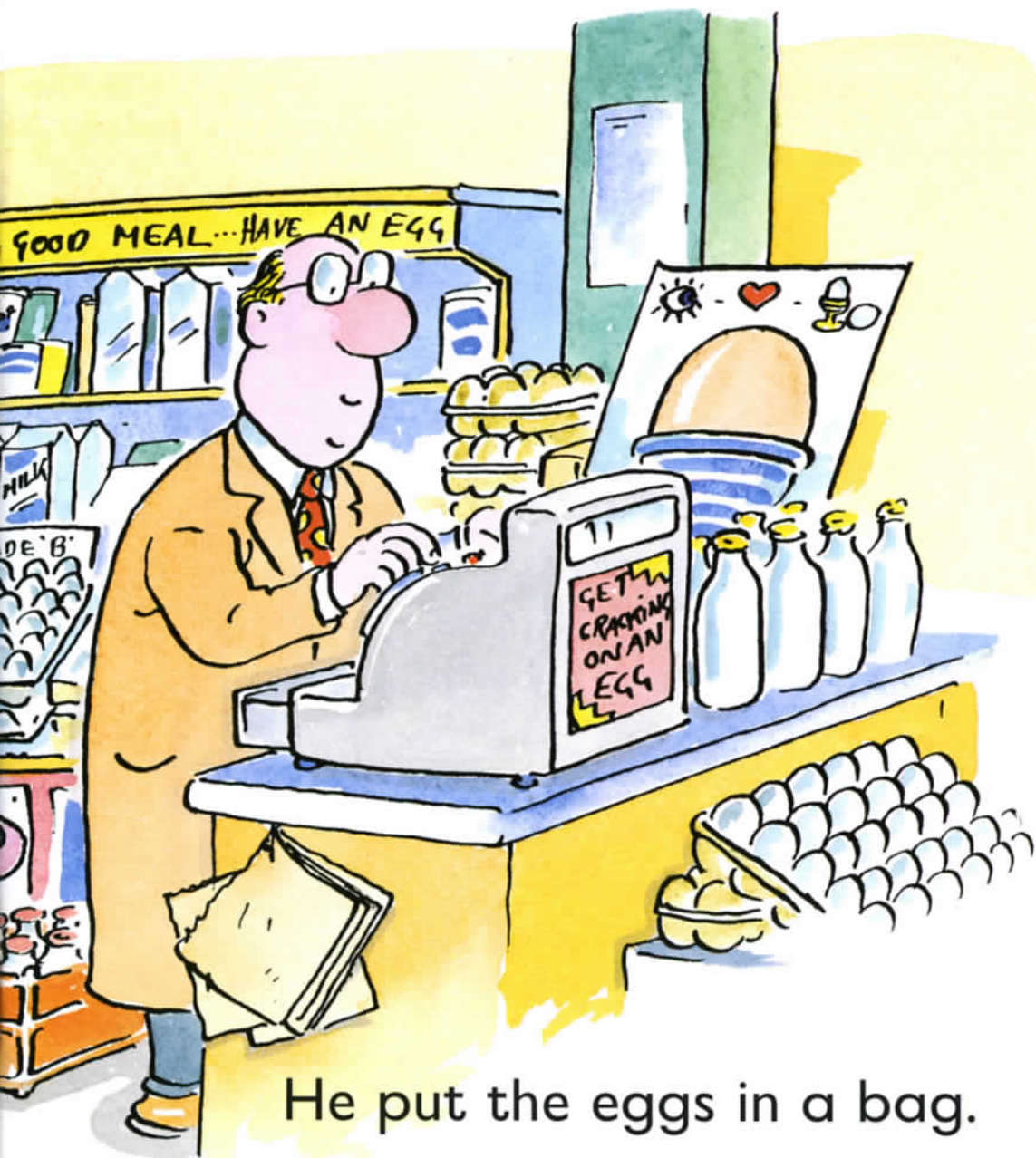

said his friends.

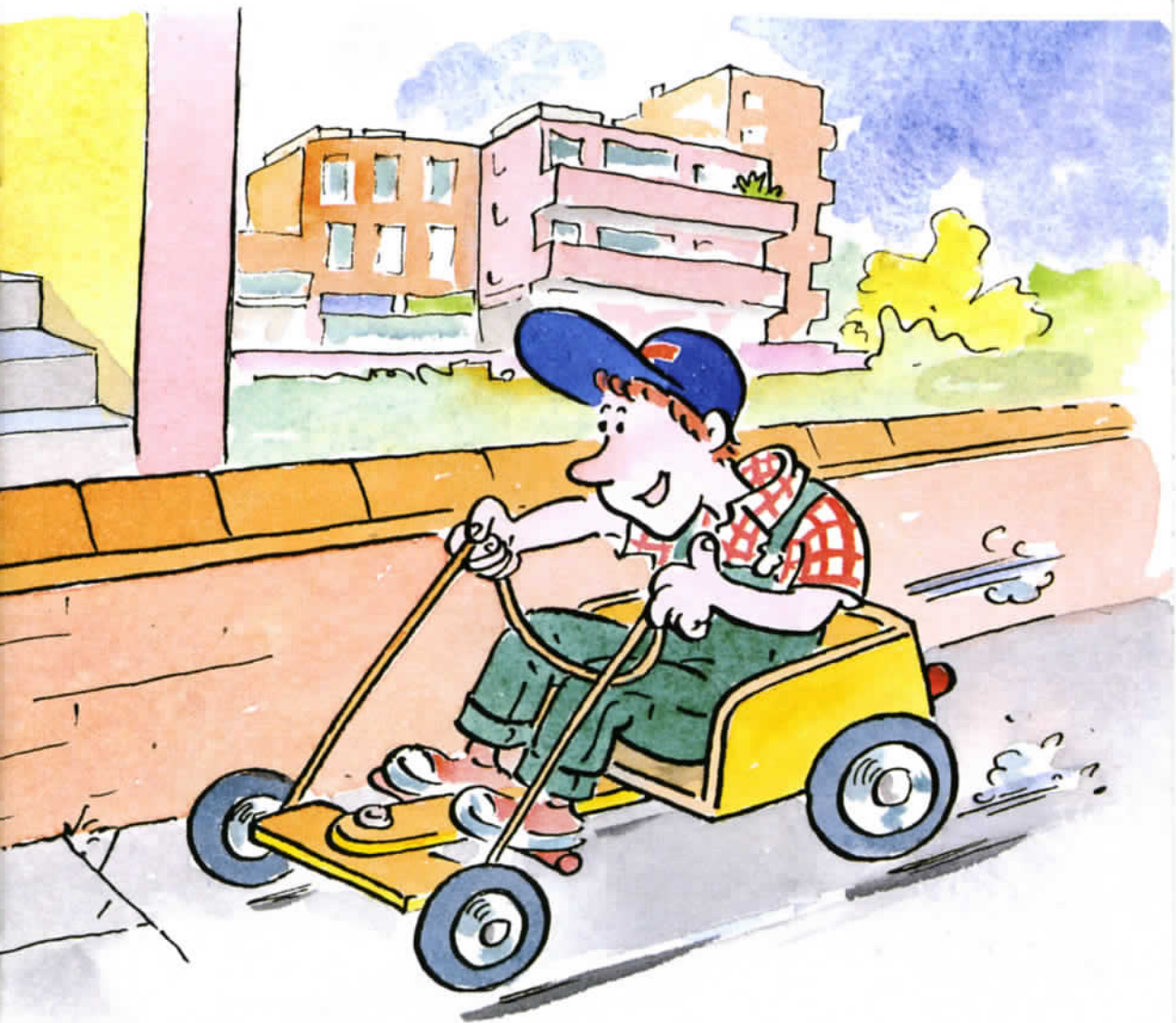




“I can’t,” said Midge. “My Mum wants these eggs.”

Midge saw his friend. The friend had a go-kart.

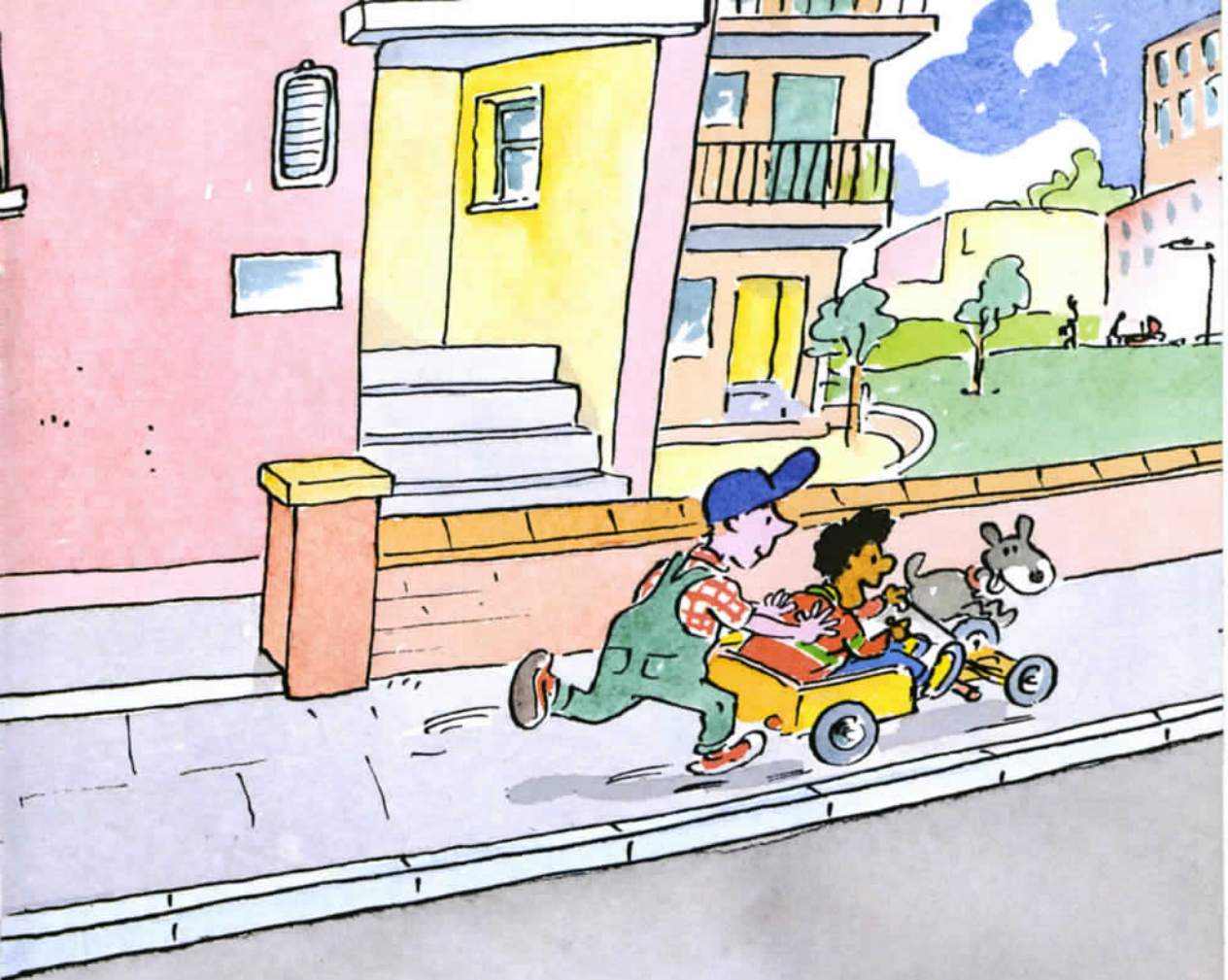




Midge wanted a go.
