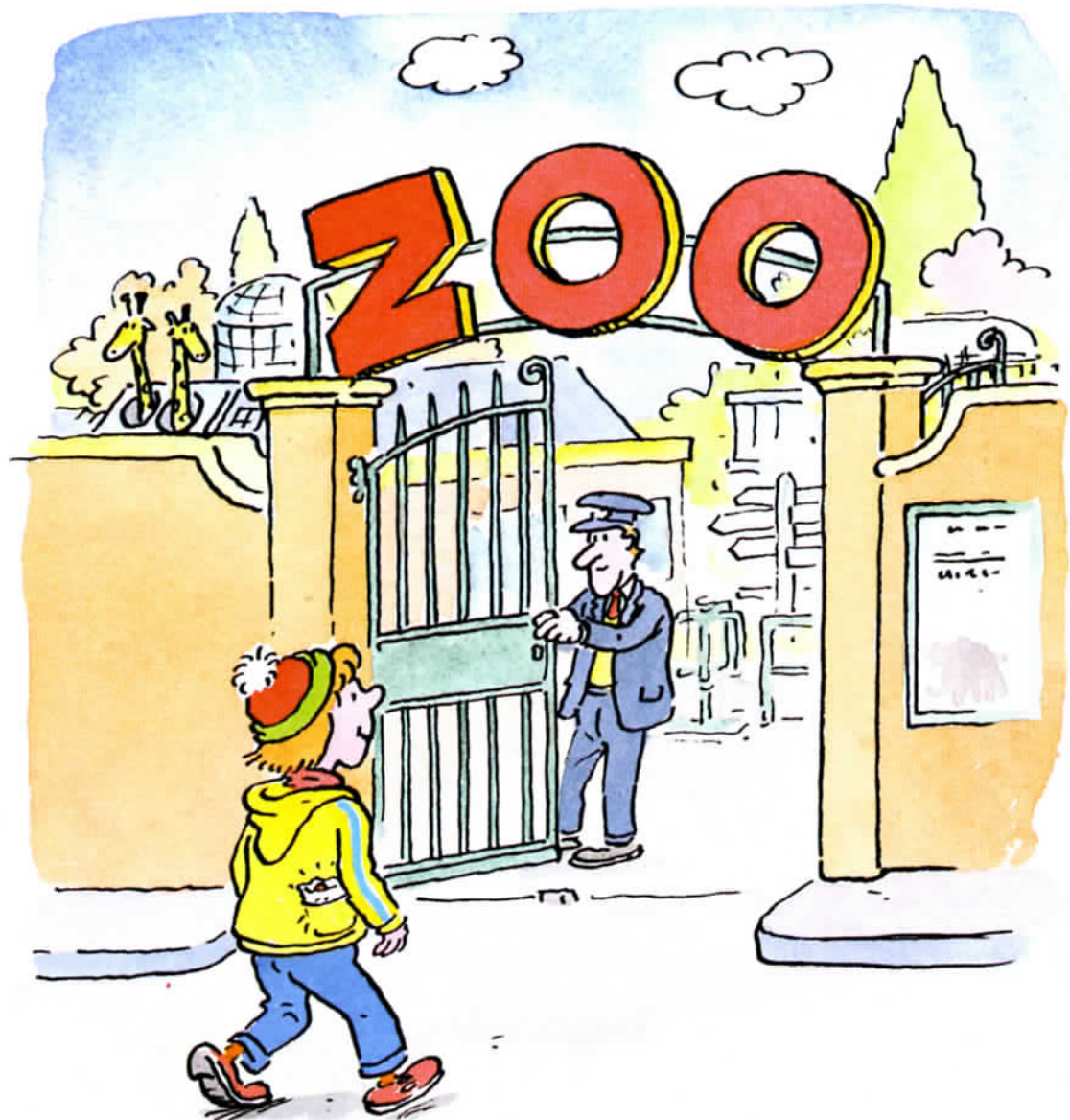

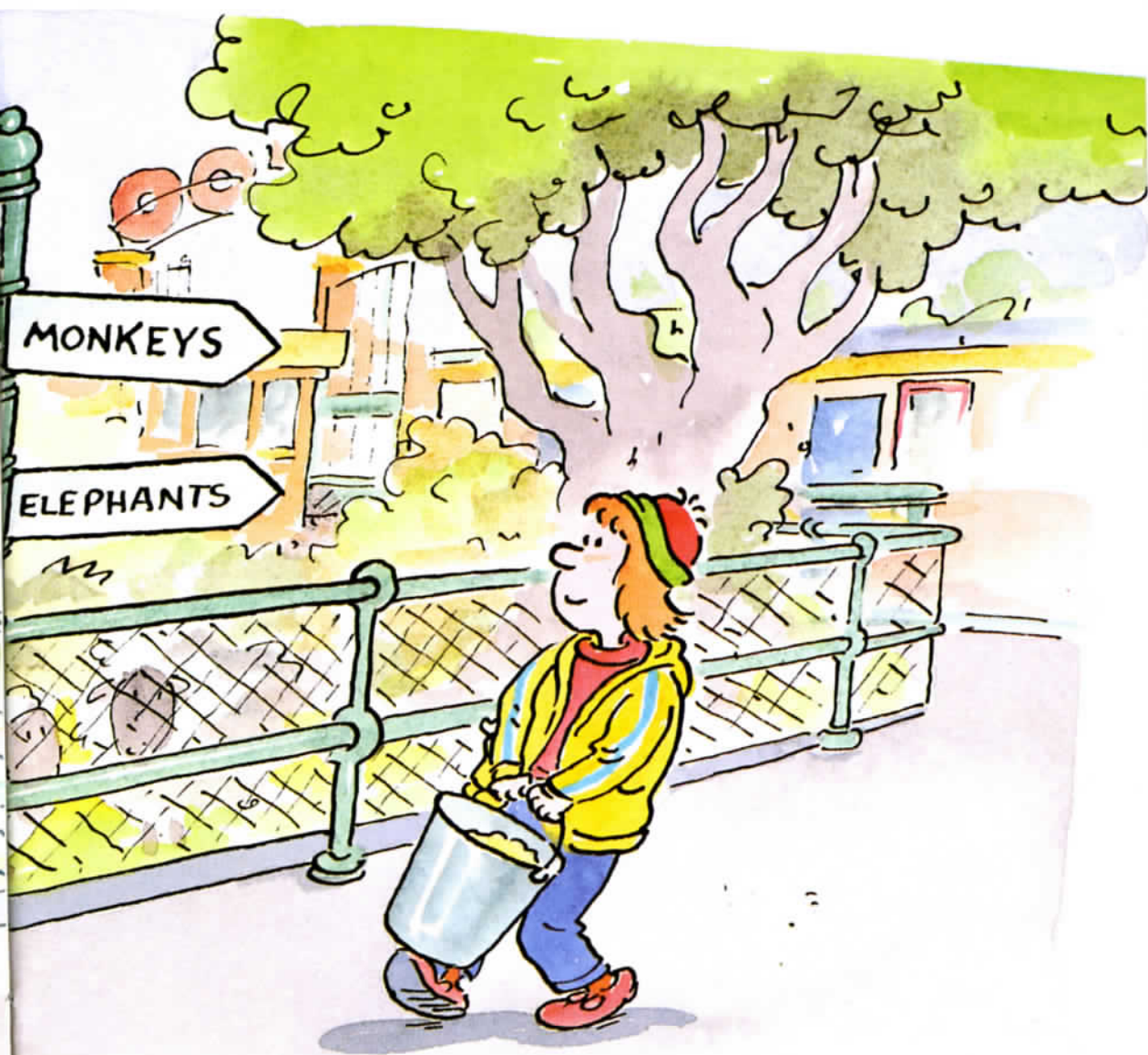




Pip went to the zoo.

Pip gave the elephants some water.





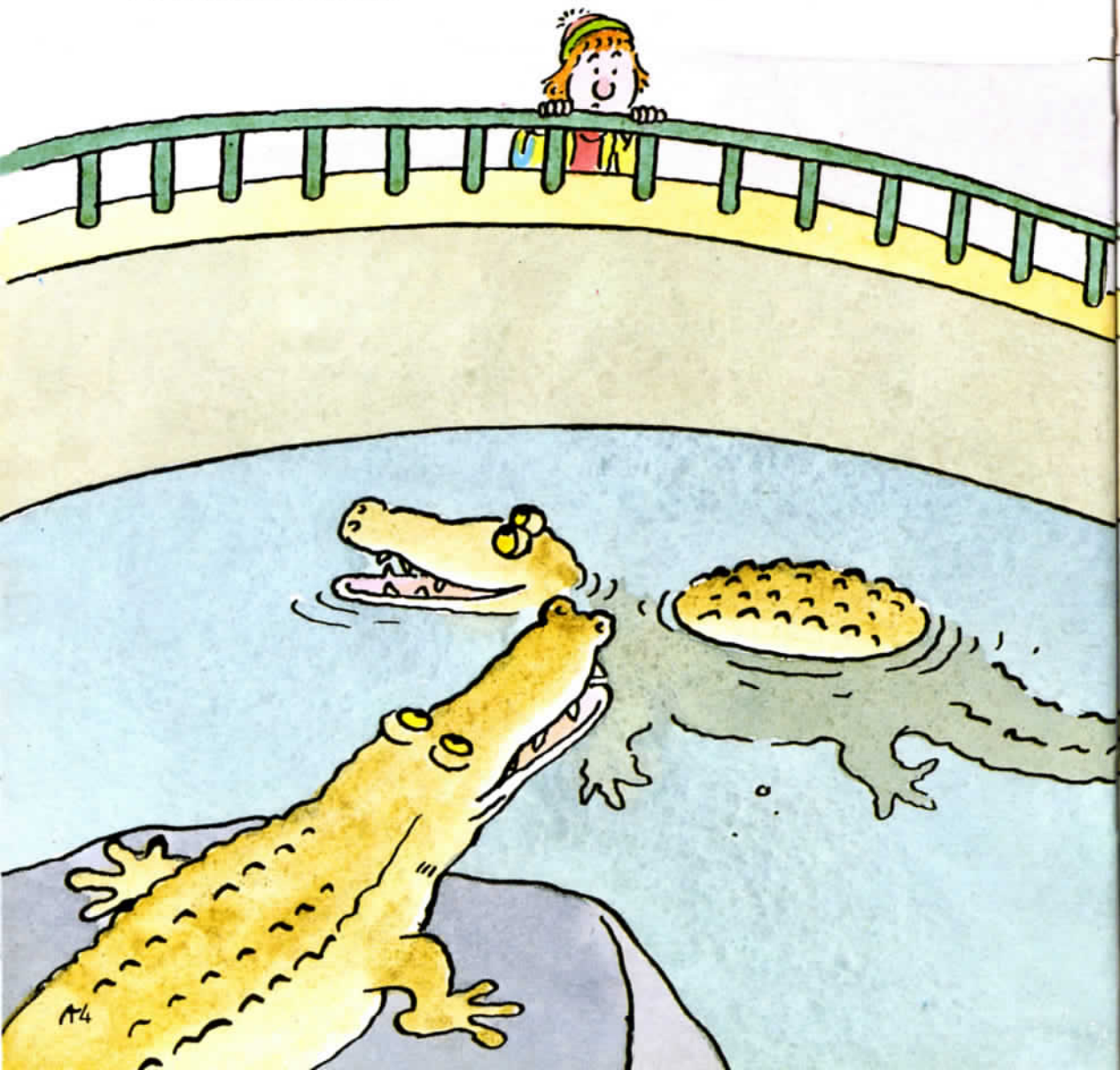
The elephant took Pip's sweets.

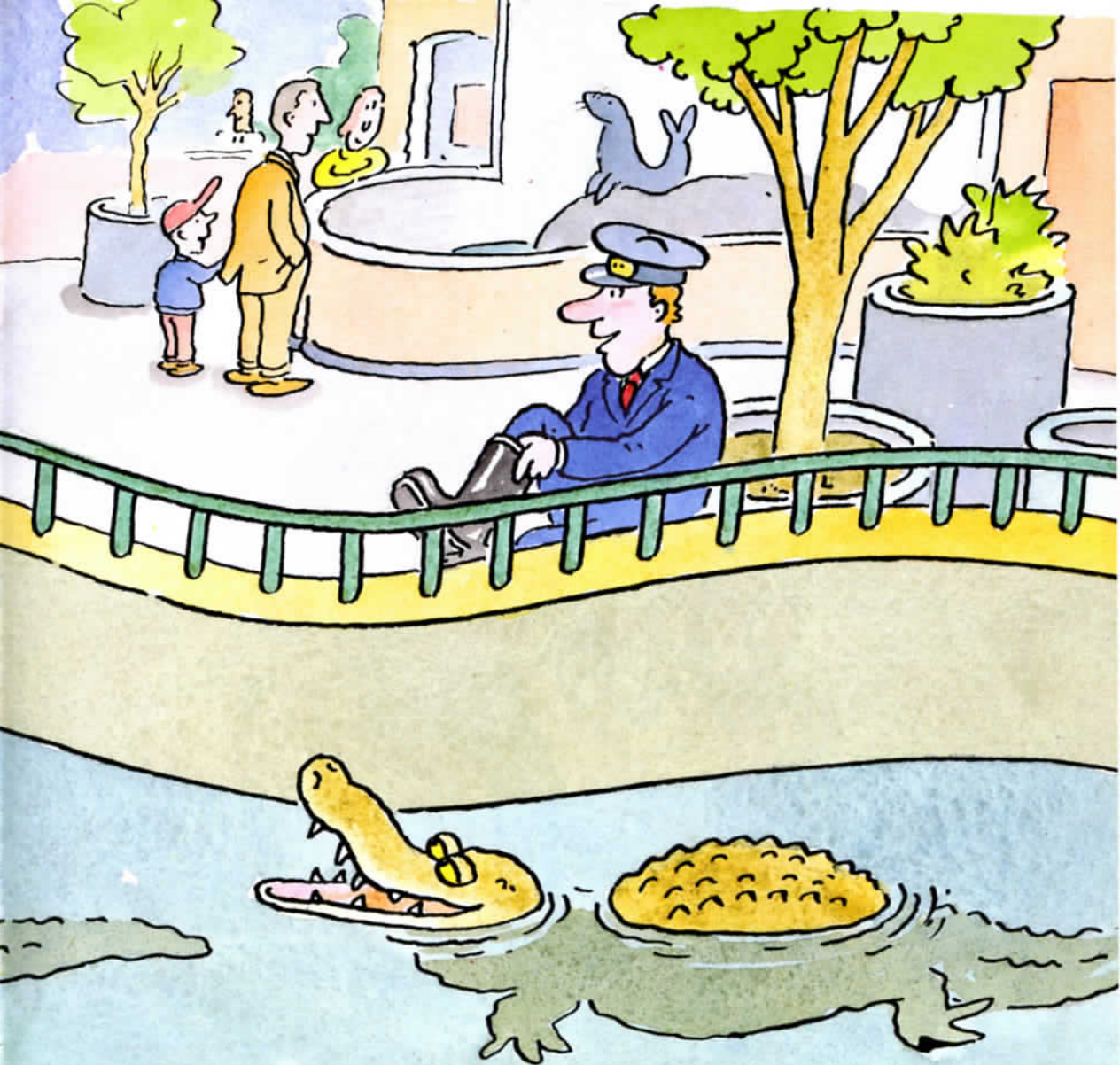




Pip gave the parrots some fruit.

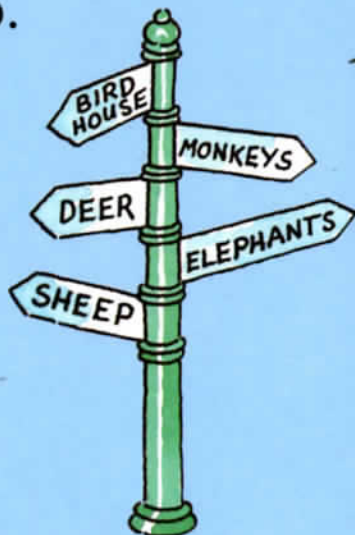
