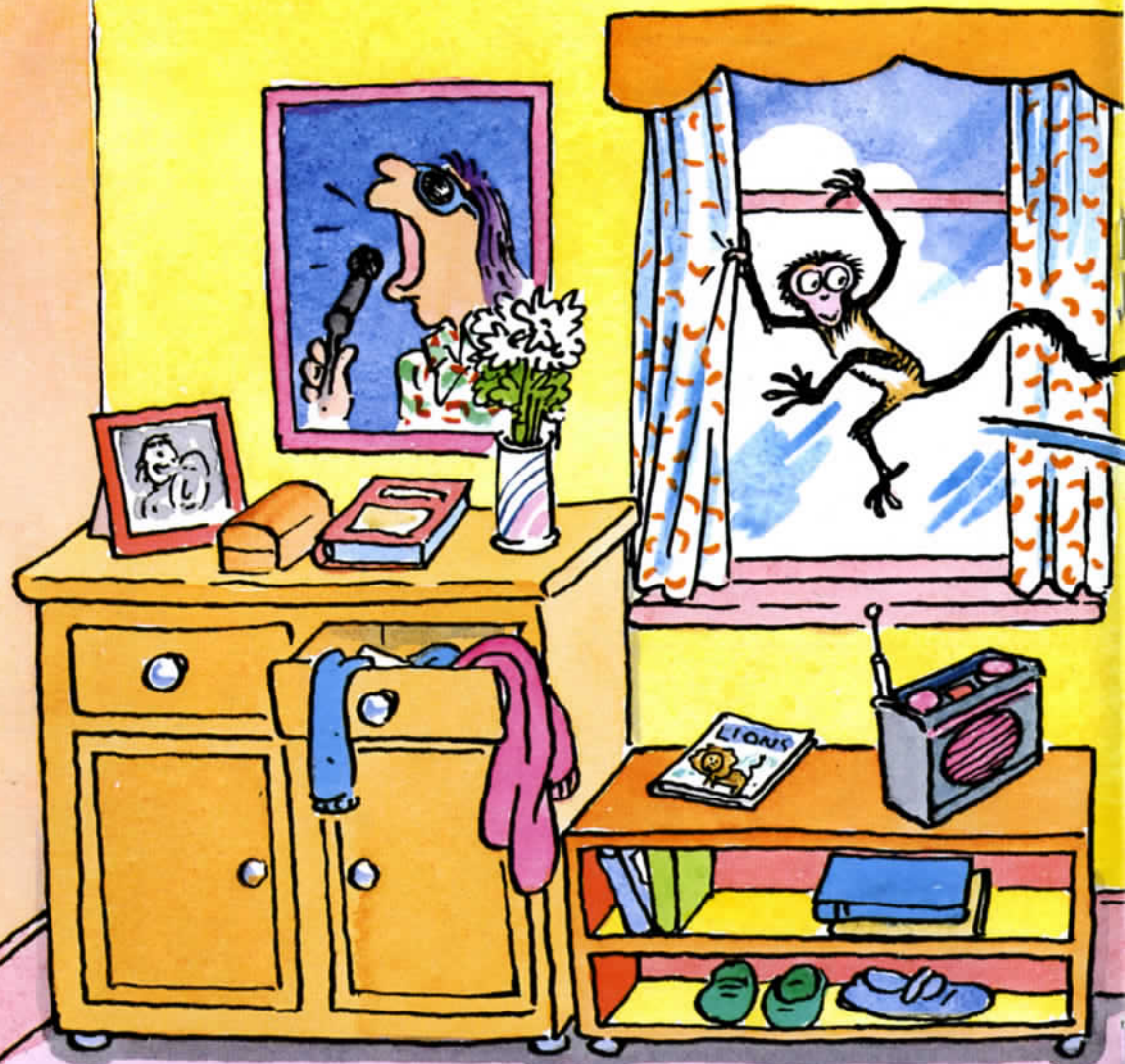

They took the monkey home.

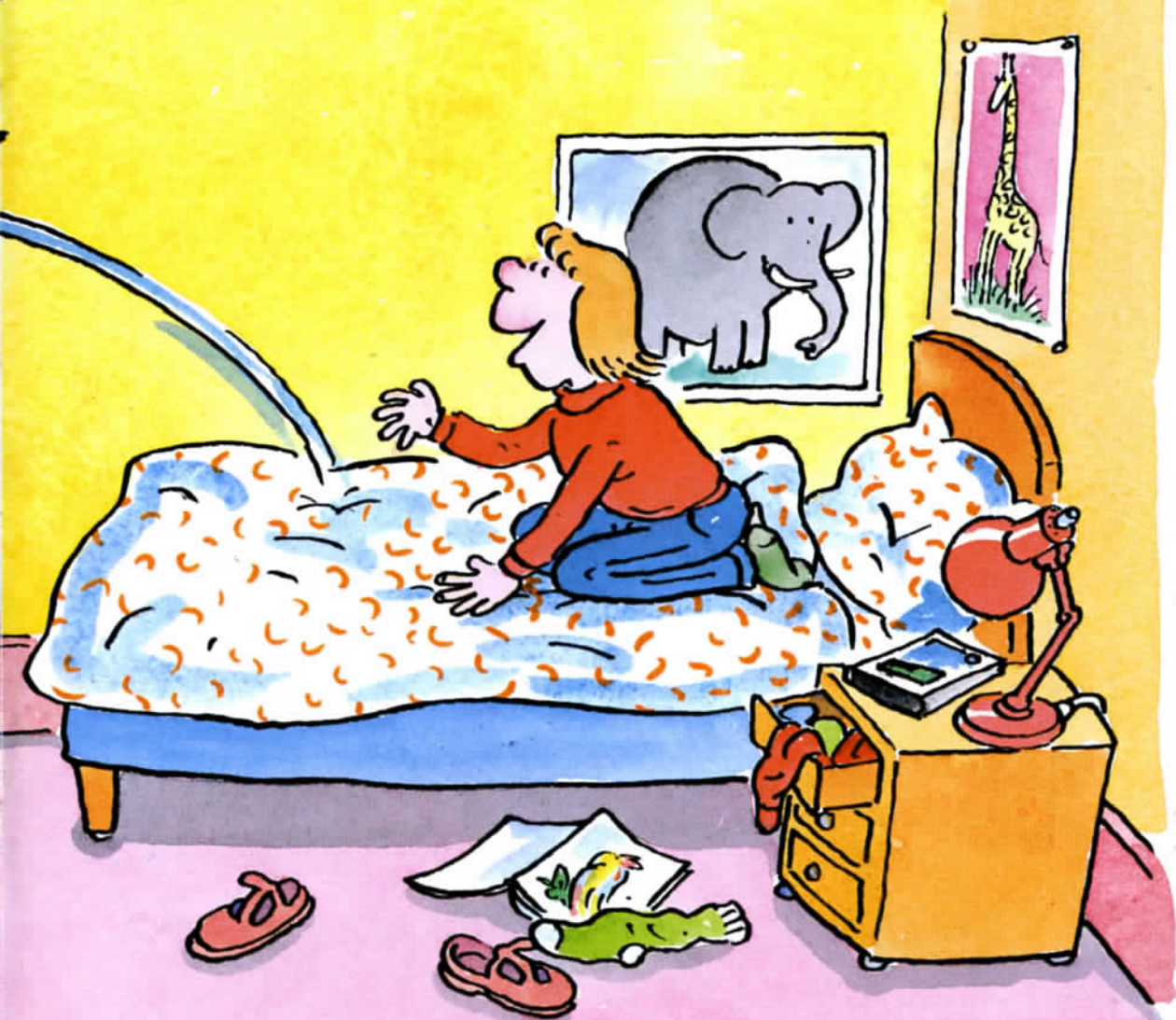


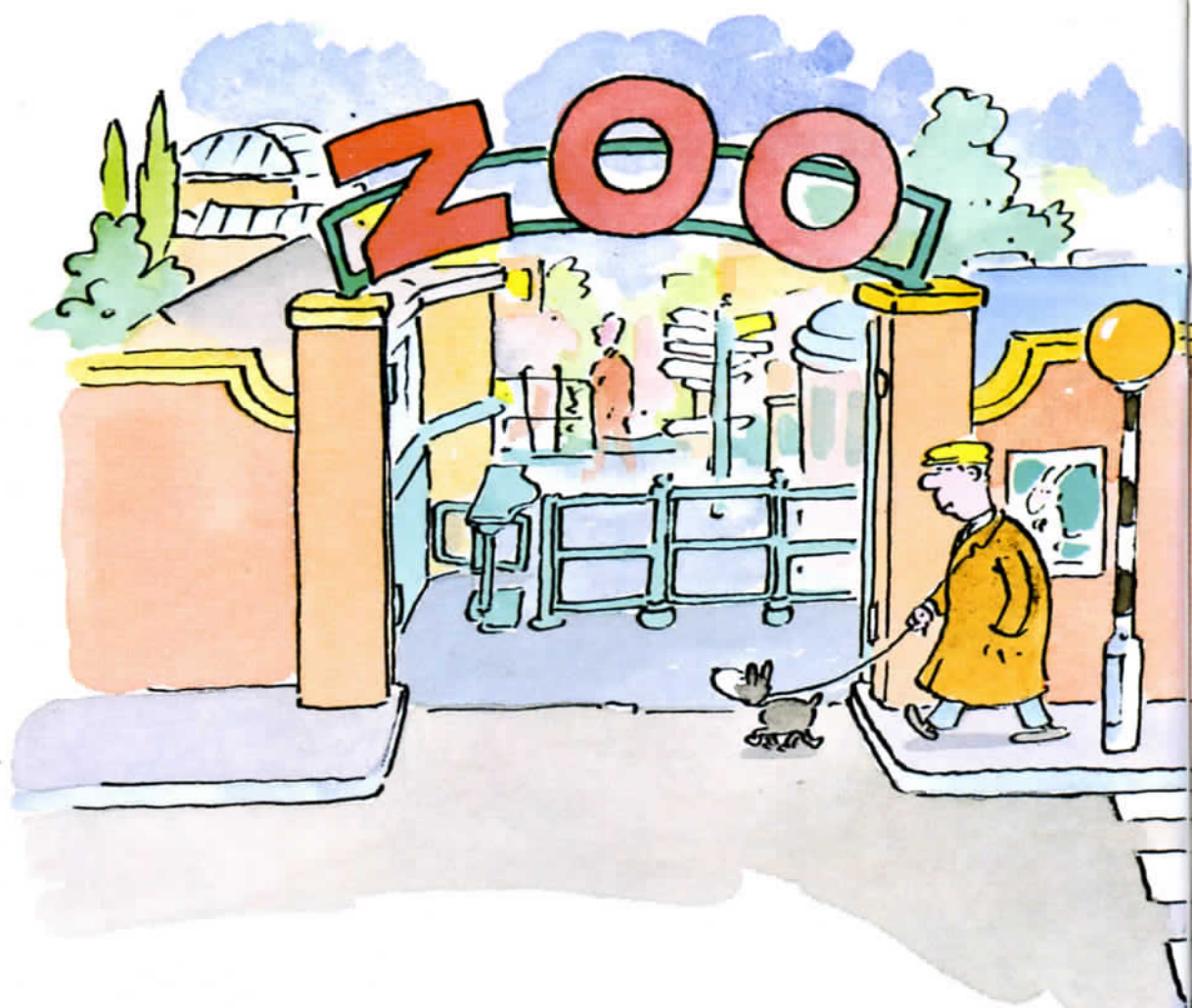
