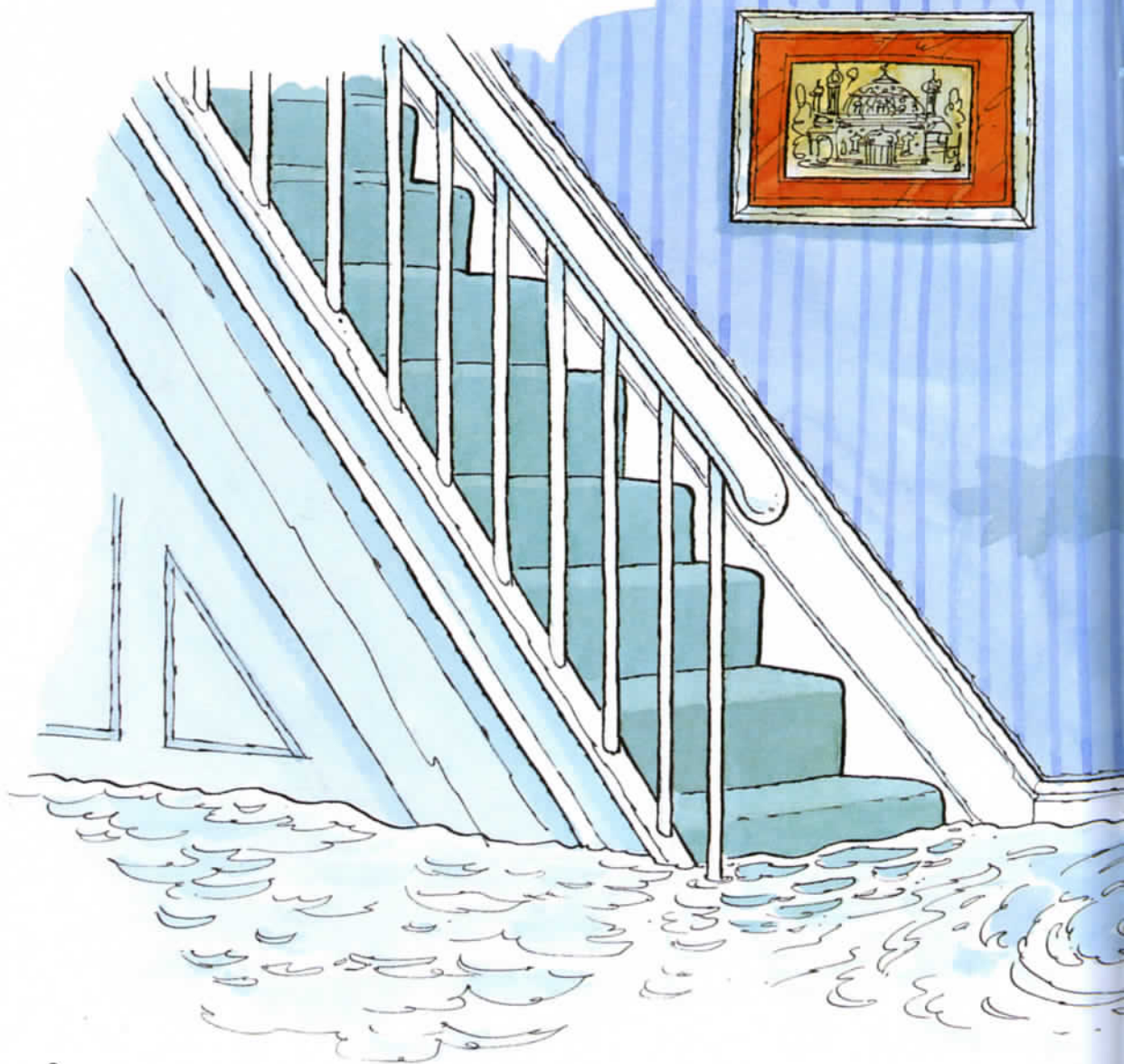


Sparrows

Everything was wet.

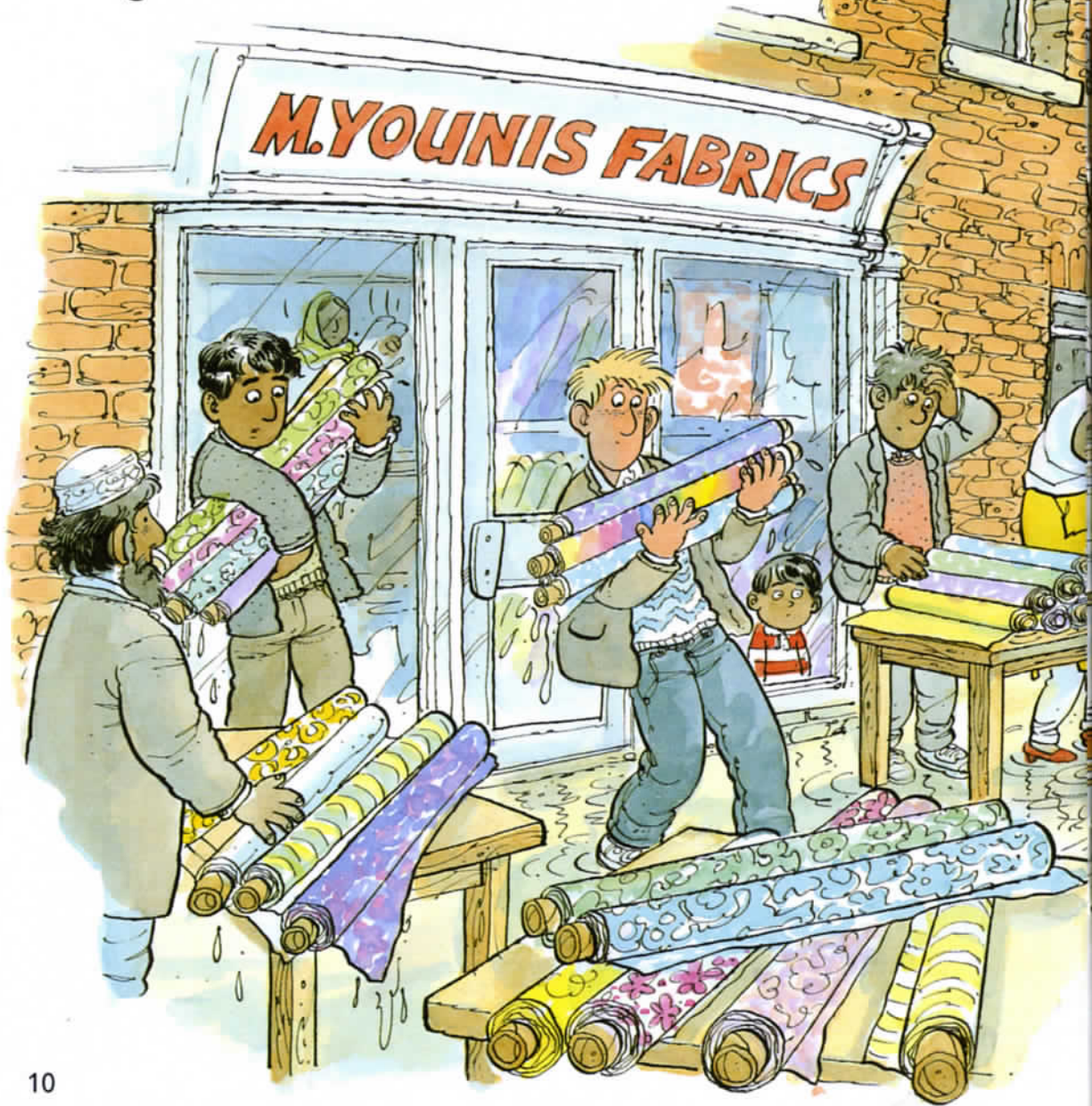
“What a mess!” said Yasmin.





The cloth was wet.

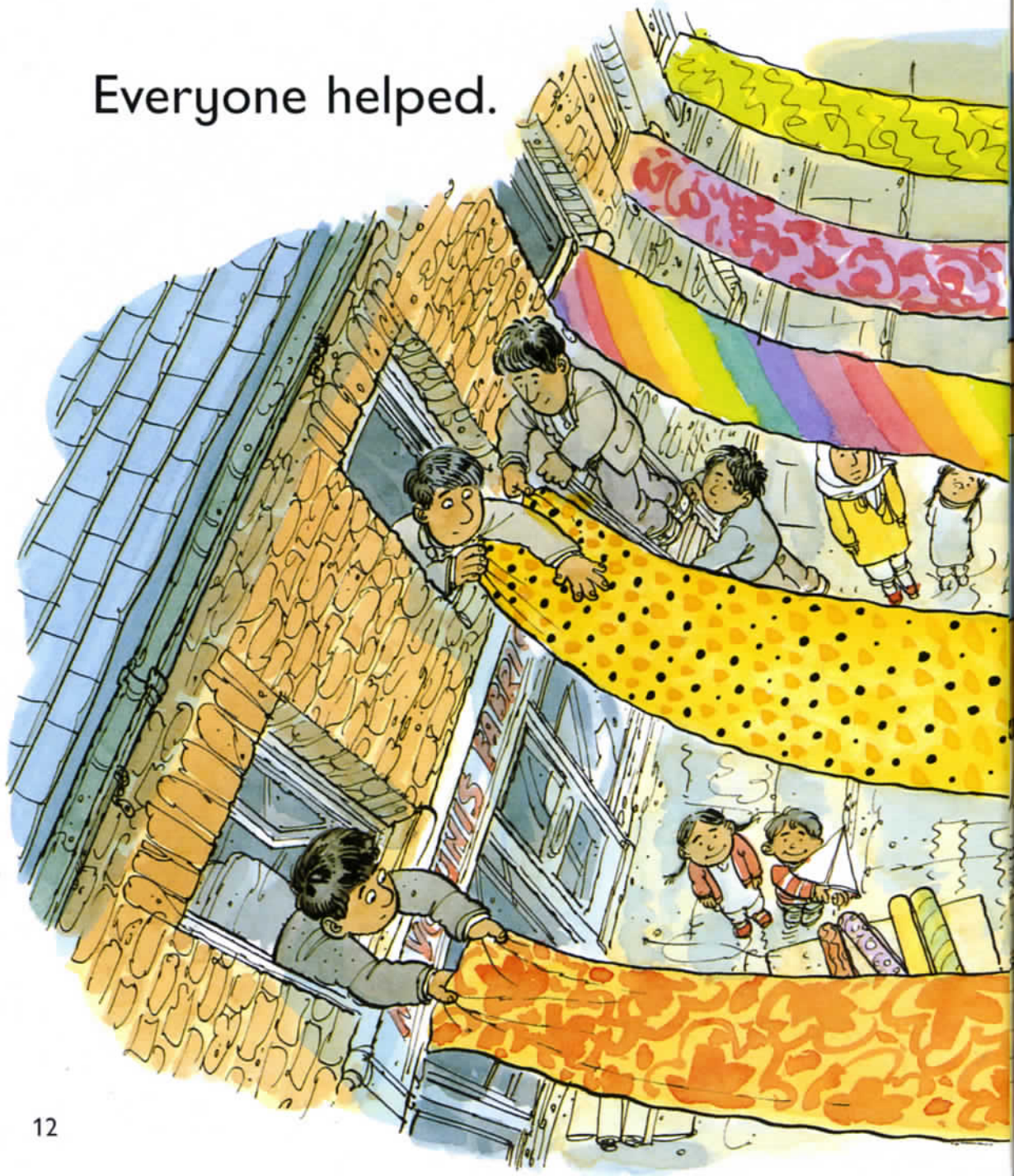
They took the cloth outside.

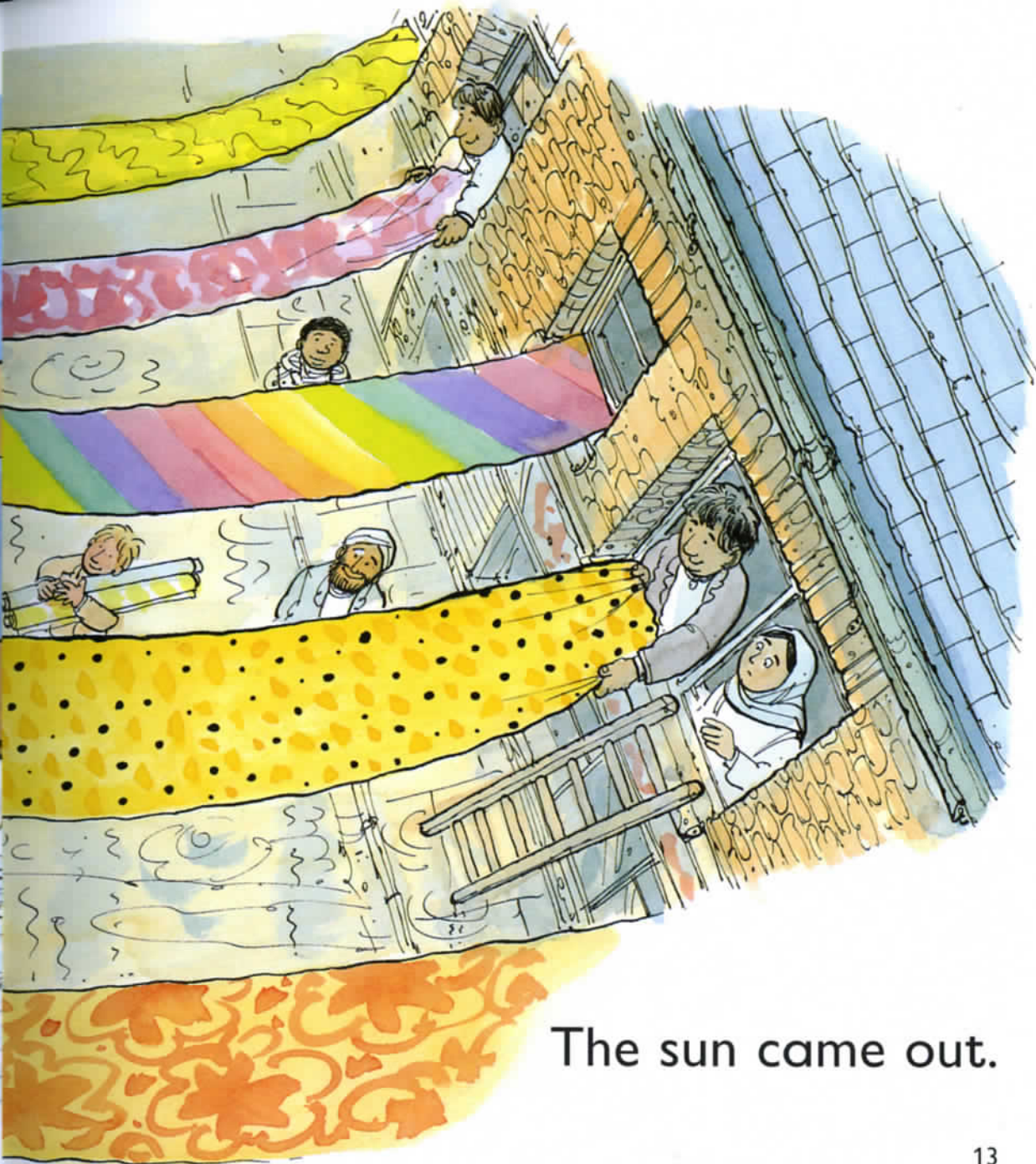




“Hang it up to dry,” said Yasmin.

Everyone helped.

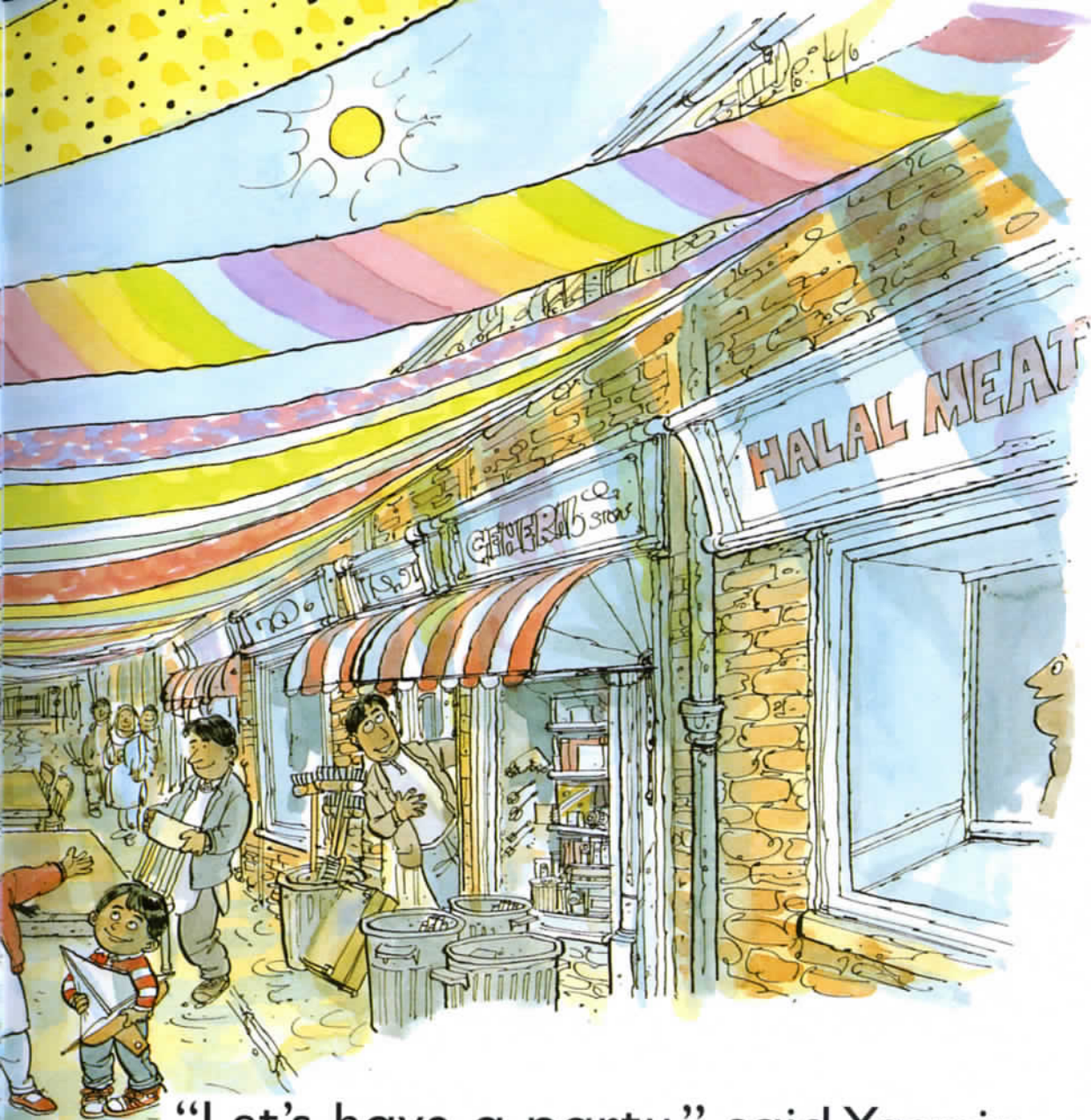




The sun came out.
