* Stony Brook University Football is hosting its 4th Three Village Day on September 29, 2018. Tailgating starts at Seawolves Town at 3pm, football game starts at 6pm. All of the 3 Village Elementary Schools will be joining together and hosting a community tailgating party at Seawolves Town. Snacks and drinks will be provided by the PTAs and families should bring any other food or drink they would like to share with the community. From years past there are bounce houses and several games where the kids can win prizes. There are several community businesses with give-aways and food samples. It's always been a lot of fun for the kids.

* 3 Village PTAs are participating in Reflections again this year. The theme is Heroes Around Me. Details will be coming home soon.

* Claudia Reinhard reported that the TVTA is hoping to get a date on the calendar for another Sport-Night to raise money for their community scholarships.

* SEPTA – whose meeting happens to be tonight also, is hosting a Movie Day on 12/1/18 at PJ Cinemas. It will be a "sensory film" and place where kids don't have to stay in their seats, they can walk around, lights will be turned up a bit and sound will be turned down. It's a great opportunity for parents to meet each other.

* Mrs. Pedesich reported that all classrooms in the district are now climate controlled along with the auditoriums in all elementary schools.

* The district is putting together a committee to evaluate Homework policy with the goal of coming up with new guidelines. Kevin Scanlon will head this committee. There was also mention of a Recess Committee and the cabinet was supportive of it. Per Mrs. Pedesich, there were changes made last year through SBM to utilize the inner courtyards to enhance recess.

* Safety Meeting was held at Murphy on 9/13/18. All were encouraged to attend.

* 3 Village Stem Camp – was praised and the district has bigger plans for the summer of 2019.

* The district is working to reduce the size of Math classes at the secondary level.

* Substitute Teachers Needed in every area. If you or someone you know is interested, please have them contact HR. You can apply online.

* Kevin Scanlon reported that the district is considering trade school options and are currently looking into a Culinary program. A program like this would be for the 11th and 12th graders.

* The district's Business Department is looking to build relationships with local businesses so that high schoolers would have the opportunity to earn 2 credits for work-based learning.

* Science: there is now a TA in each elementary science lab to enrich science education.

* Jeff Carlson reported that there is a new monitoring system throughout the district and visitor passes will look different.

* 11 district employees took an EMT class arranged by the district so that in the case of an emergency, they can help until an ambulance arrives. The district will continue to offer and encourage any interested staff to take the course.

* Stop Bleeding training which was given to staff last year will be offered to kids in the High School.

* WS Mount now has a generator that would keep the school up and running if there were a power outage.
