Vendor Information & Regulations

- 1. THERE IS NOT A RAIN DATE FOR THIS EVENT. Should rain or other inclement weather occur, we will consider moving this event indoors. Should the festival be cancelled or shortened due to inclement weather, hazardous conditions, and/or other vendor fees will not be returned. Other marketing opportunities will be provided. Vendor registration is non-transferrable.
- 2. Not for profit organizations providing information only may apply for a free space. Via the proclamation on the Vendor Agreement, not for profit organizations supporting Family Lyfe and Jersey Gay Pride. Free spaces are limited so they are first come, first served basis.
- 3. Vendors are responsible for bringing their own table, chair(s), and tent. If you need to table and/or chair(s) there is a nominal non-refundable fee required which covers one 8' table and two chairs. Orders must be placed at least 30-days prior to September 11, 2021.
- 4. Food vendors must be approved before submitting an application. Please email snjgaypride@gmail.com ATTENTION: OUTJerseyFEST Food Vendor.
- 5. Tents larger than 10x20 must be approved before the festival. Tents 10x20 or smaller are pre-approved.
- 6. The sale of merchandise containing the official Jersey Gay Pride, Family Lyfe logo or any Jersey Gay Pride paraphernalia is prohibited.
- 7. Vendor and security volunteers will be available throughout the festival to answer questions or help with emergencies.
- 8. All trash must be removed from the premises. Please place all trash in the proper receptacles provided. Vendors who do not remove trash will be charged a \$200 fee. Invoices will be sent my email and/or USPS.
- 9. If you have any specific requests or questions, please note them on the application or email our vendor coordinator at snjgaypride@gmail.com; Attention OUTFEST Vending Dept.
- 10. Please add snjgaypride@gmail.com to your email address book.
- 11. Family Lyfe, A Nonprofit Organization and/or its affiliate will not be responsible for any loss or damage to merchandise and/or displays.
- 12. Registration and rental fees are non-refundable and transferrable.



Regulations

- 1. Vendors must check-in with the vendor coordinator at the entrance to the festival (location to be advised). The vendor check-in will be open approximately 10:00 a.m. The festival site is open to the public at 12:00 p.m. Unloading of vehicles must be completed and vehicles removed from the festival site by 11:30 a.m. failure to clear the festival grounds of all non-authorized vehicles will result in the forfeiture of your placement and no refund will be permitted.
- 2. There will be music and entertainment all day. Radios, megaphones, and loudspeakers may not be allowed. Participants MUST confirm usage with the vendor coordinator.
- 3. Food vendors must meet all health and sanitary codes and be in compliance with all local, state, and federal regulations in regard to the handling and serving of food. Family Lyfe, Jersey Gay Pride Committee 2021, and its affiliates relinquish all responsibilities and liabilities concerning food handling to the vendor owner. Please be prepared to provide any requested documents affirming the aforementioned.
- 4. Vendors shall obtain at vendor's own expense, insurance of property against fire, theft, vandalism, or destruction by any cause, naming Family Lyfe and Jersey Gay Pride Committee 2021 as an additional insured.
- 5. We ask that your site be left in the same manner that it was when you arrived at the festival. Your site will be inspected.
- 6. The festival runs until approximately 4:00 p.m. All vendors must vacate upon request.
- 7. Vendors must be in compliance with all local, state, federal, and venue rules and regulations and provide tangible proof including insurance per item number four.
