Teacher Grants

In the 2023-2024 school year, BLEF provided over \$21,000 in funding for teacher grants, allowing educators to bring creative and innovative learning opportunities into the classroom. These grants have supported projects ranging from new science lab equipment to art supplies, benefiting over XXX students.

Student Scholarships

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, BLEF awarded \$8,750 in scholarships to help graduating seniors pursue higher education. This funding has empowered students to attend colleges, universities, and vocational programs, giving them a head start on their future careers.

Stage Lighting for BLMS Auditorium

This year, BLEF contributed over \$25,000 toward the project, which was made possible by grants from the Idaho Commission on the Arts and F.M., Anne G., and Beverly B. Bistline Foundation as well as community donations. The new lighting system will significantly enhance student performances, community events, and productions hosted in the auditorium.

Success Stories

Funding Stage Lighting in BLSD Auditorium

The Bear Lake School District celebrated the <u>installation of a</u> <u>state-of-the-art stage lighting system in its auditorium</u>, a key venue for student performances and community events. The project was made possible through the collaborative efforts of the Bear Lake Education Foundation and the community, including a grant from the Idaho Commission on the Arts and over \$16,000 raised locally. Executive Director Shannon Marx highlighted the project's success as a testament to community teamwork, emphasizing how the new lighting would enhance the quality of school and community performances.



Awarding Scholarships to Further Education

In May 2024, <u>BLEF awarded five scholarships</u> during an assembly at Bear Lake High School, recognizing exceptional students for their academic achievements, community involvement, and commitment to higher education. This year's recipients—Hallie Bruce, Toby Flake, Cassidy Higley, Kenna Robinson, and Alexis Wuthrich—are pursuing degrees in fields like Education, Counseling, Psychology, and Physical Education. The scholarships, aimed at supporting students with a passion for teaching and education-related careers, reflect BLEF's ongoing dedication to fostering future educators. BLEF's scholarships are made possible through community support, donations, and grants, helping students achieve their academic and career goals.



Partnering with Corporate Sponsors

Nutrien contributed \$2,000 to Bear Lake High School's <u>Agricultural Science Department</u>, supporting their hands-on farming education programs. This donation helps cover the costs of essential supplies for the Science of Plant Growth and Development class, enabling students to engage in practical, sustainable farming practices. Success Stories

Fundraising Through Pickleball

Bear Lake Education Foundation (BLEF) hosted a successful pickleball tournament at Bear Lake Middle School, raising over \$2,300 for scholarships for Bear Lake High School seniors. This event, featuring players of all levels and a silent auction for pickleball paddles, underscores BLEF's dedication to supporting education and enhancing community engagement. BLEF, which has been improving local schools for over 30 years, used the tournament to further its mission of building a community of lifelong learners and supporting educational initiatives.



Advancing Education Through STEM

BLEF worked to secure a \$5,000 grant from the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation to support a new STEM program at Bear Lake Middle School. This program, which focuses on teaching 3D modeling, animation, and programming through game design, aims to engage students with familiar technology and enhance their skills in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. BLEF's ongoing partnership with the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation highlights their commitment to advancing educational opportunities and supporting innovative learning initiatives in the community.
