

Senior Community Service Project Funds Request Guidelines

Overview:

The Bear Lake Education Foundation (BLEF) supports Bear Lake High School Seniors by providing grants for innovative and enriching community projects. These grants aim to support innovative learning, promote enrichment opportunities, and engage the community.

1. Project Approval:

 The project must be approved by the Coordinator and Principal before being presented to the foundation for funding.

2. Focus on Community:

- The project should have a lasting impact on the community or school.
- The project must identify and address a need in the community or an underserved population, as outlined in the Senior Project Outline.
- Students must detail the proposed solution and its feasibility; outline necessary resources, costs, and funding sources; and describe the expected community impact.

3. Appropriate Use of Funds:

 The requested funding should not be for needs that should be met by other sources, such as school building/grounds maintenance or city/community general maintenance.

4. Funding Allocation:

 The foundation has allocated \$1000 for senior projects for the school year. Grants are generally restricted to a maximum of \$100 per student. Larger grants are reviewed and occasionally approved.

5. Securing Additional Funds:

 Students should demonstrate the ability to secure additional funds to complete their project. Additional funding may be available through BLEF.

6. First Come, First Served:

 Grants will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis after approval by the BLEF board, until the funding limit is reached.

By adhering to these guidelines and demonstrating a commitment to community improvement, students can secure the necessary funding and support to successfully complete their Senior Projects.

We encourage applicants to contribute to the Bear Lake Education Foundation and join us in our mission to build a thriving educational community in the Bear Lake School District.
