What is Accelerate ASU?

Accelerate ASU is a program that gives high school students the opportunity to take **college-level courses from Arizona State University**—ranked #1 in innovation by *U.S. News & World Report*—while still in high school.

How does Out of Box Learning fit in?

Out of Box Learning has partnered with ASU to make these courses **accessible, flexible, and affordable** to students participating in our customized education programs, helping them earn **up to 60 college credits** in a supportive environment.

What are the benefits for my student?

- **Earn College Credit:** Courses count toward degrees and are widely transferable.
- **Affordable:** No upfront tuition; students only pay if they choose to transcript a passed course.
- **Rigorous Learning:** Courses are developed by ASU's expert faculty and facilitated by Out of Box's experts.
- **Dual Credit-** get high school and college credit
- **No Transcript Risk:** opt in for the college course to appear on the college transcript.
- **High Success Rates:** The cohort-based model helps students thrive—even if they've never taken a college course before.

What subjects or credits are available?

Students can work toward credits in core areas such as:

- English (e.g., English 101)
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Electives

What is the enrollment process like?

- No college application is required.
- Students sign up through a **simple online form**.
