

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS IN THE FOLLOWING  
SUBDIVISION IN NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY

RIVERS BEND ESTATES SUBDIVISION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Northumberland County, Virginia, pursuant to and under the authority conferred by Section 3.1-796.93 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, as follows:

That all dogs kept, housed, penned or otherwise, whose dwelling place is regularly or periodically within the confines of the following subdivision within Northumberland County, Virginia, are hereby prohibited from running at large:

Rivers Bend Estates Subdivision

For the purpose of this ordinance a dog shall be deemed to run at large while roaming, running or self-hunting off the property of its owner or custodian and not under its owner's or custodian's immediate control; provided, however, that no dog whose normal dwelling place is outside said subdivision, nor any dog engaged in lawful hunting beyond said confines that shall thereafter stray within, shall be deemed to run at large, provided that the owner or custodian shall place such dog under his immediate control within a reasonable time after knowledge thereof.

Any person who, in violation of this ordinance, permits his dog to run at large shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00.
