



BROADSTAIRS AND ST PETERS BOWLS CLUB

GENERAL REGULATIONS AND MODE OF ATTIRE

In accordance with the Club Constitution Section 3 General Regulations And Conditions (para 2.1), and following feedback from numerous members, the Management Committee have agreed the following modes of attire for clarity for all members.

All members are expected to always comply and with immediate effect. Appropriate footwear must always be worn .

Social bowling/roll ups at the club

Casual attire can be worn.

Bowls, Beer and Bingo sessions, opening day match, A v B and Men v Women

Casual attire can be worn.

Internal Club Competitions up to finals stage or competition days e.g mixed triples & mixed pairs

Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only , and official Club shirt or white top (not necessarily club shirt)

Internal Club competitions finals and competition days e.g mixed triples and mixed pairs

Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only, and and official Club shirt

Broadstairs and St Peters Tournament

If an entry is made under the name of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, and in the case of pairs, triples or fours, all members of the team are members of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, then the official B&STP club shirt must be worn. Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only

If some of the team is made up of players who are not members of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, then plain white shirts can be worn by our club members, if they wish.

Pink Ladies

Pink tops

Friendly matches against other clubs

Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only, official B&STP club shirt.

League matches against other clubs

Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only, official B&STP club shirt.

County, regional or national competitions

If an entry is made to a county, regional or national competition under the name of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, then the official B&STP club shirt must be worn. Colour of trousers, shorts or skirts as determined by the event organiser, or Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only

External competitions run by other clubs or leagues

If an entry is made under the name of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, and in the case of pairs, triples or fours, all members of the team are members of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, then the official B&STP club shirt must be worn. Navy trousers, shorts, skirts from suppliers - Jack and Bowls or Aceit only

If some of the team is made up of players who are not members of Broadstairs and St Peters Bowls Club, then white shirts can be worn by our members, if they wish.

Exemptions for Extreme Weather conditions

In the event of extreme heat, the Club Captains (for club matches), or the organisers of in-house Games or Competition Organisers can approve that white shirts can be worn as an alternative to the club shirt.

If at external competitions, there is extreme weather then white shirts can be worn as an alternative.
