As we are rapidly approaching the end of the 2026 bowling season, with only the Broadstairs 80th Open Tournament (7th -18th September) and the President v Captain (26th August) games left to play, here are Augusts results.

Friendlies

1/08/26. Aylsham and Snowdown 95-96 B&SPBC 18-14, 21-16, 9-17, 12-17, 15-16, 20-16, An extremely close game with only a point separating the teams.

8/8/26. Victoria Park v B&SPBC 12-14, 18-10, 23-10, 22-16, 28-4, 20-18, a resounding win by the home side winning on 5 of the 6 rinks with only Linda Agnew (skip) Steve Cox (2) and Steve Wilson (lead) gaining a win.
