

Practicing Your Skills in safeMedicate

Each of the learning modules (i.e., FNS Essential Skills, FNS Bodyweight & Body Surface Area Calculations, FNS Injectable Medicines Therapy, and Word Problem Skills) has a chapter offering learners the opportunity to test themselves on the materials in that module.

Select a module's Practice Your Skills from the chapter options from the menu in the upper-left.



The Practice Your Skills page appears with your assessment options.


- 1. Choose the type of assessment you want to take.
 - **Authentic Diagnostic Assessments** provide onscreen prompts for setting up the equation before advancing to the medication administration page.
 - **Authentic Assessments** provide only the means to administer the medication.
- 2. Choose whether you want your feedback after every question or after completing the assessment.
- 3. Choose an **Area of Practice** (i.e., Adult, Child, Mental Health, or Midwifery & Neonate).
- 4. Choose the module section/chapter you want to practice.
- 5. Pick the complexity level. Each complexity level has 3 questions.

Click the **Start Assessment** button to begin the practice assessment. Once you've completed the assessment, you must click the **Save & Exit** button to record your results.

Your faculty may utilize **safeMedicate**'s Practice Your Skills to prepare you for your examinations. Be sure to complete the corresponding module's learning environment before undertaking a practice assessment.

Once you've completed a practice assessment, the results are available in the Practice Assessment History located in your User Record opened by clicking the My Record tab at the top of your screen.

Click the appropriate module's plus (+) sign to expand the section to see the assessment history on the right. Selecting the assessment's name opens a page with the results of each question. Clicking the View icon on the right opens the question so you can review your answer as well as the correct answer.



The record of the assessment can be printed or saved as a PDF by clicking the Print icon. Your entire record, showing all activity on your account can be printed by clicking the Print Record button on your User Record.
