

## Your Gift Touching Lives

In a time like no other, our Yavapai County communities are inspiring, resilient, and generous. As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact our Dignity Health, Yavapai Regional Medical Center (YRMC) staff and facilities, we are humbled by the support you have shown our caregivers and patients.

When we look back on these times, we'll cherish these gifts as the most important our organization has ever received.

Thanks to people like you, in the past nine months the YRMC Foundation has provided more than \$250,000 to help our Medical Center. The following are a few examples of how your generosity has touched the lives of so many during this crisis.

#### **YRMC Vaccination Center**

On January 21, 2021, YRMC opened Yavapai County's first public Vaccination Center. Located in the former Sears store at the Prescott Gateway Mall, the Center is staffed by 20 healthcare professionals and volunteers who administer up to 500 vaccines daily. Thanks to your support, the YRMC Foundation is able to underwrite the Center location's rental fee of \$5,000 per month. The Foundation initially helped coordinate the delivery of



meals and snacks for Vaccination Center personnel. It's anticipated the Vaccination Center will be in operation for four to eight months.

#### **Emergency Oxygen System Upgrade**

For weeks, YRMC staff was caring for well over 100 COVID-19 inpatients daily and operating at more than 120 percent capacity. We are all aware of the demand this placed on our facilities and the dire need for supplies and equipment. And then there is always the unexpected. At YRMC's West Campus, the demand for oxygen was nearly exceeding our system's capacity to deliver. Fortunately, YRMC's experienced

Engineering staff quickly diagnosed and resolved the issue. "We never could have anticipated such an acute situation. No patients were ever at risk, but we were leaving nothing to chance," said YRMC's Chief Operating Officer, Keith Nichols. "Thanks to your support,

emergency funding from the YRMC Foundation's COVID-19 Response Fund was immediately available to cover this unforeseen expense of nearly \$70,000."

#### Patient and Staff Safety – First, Last and Always

From the outset of the COVID-19 pandemic, two items were in high demand at YRMC and healthcare institutions nationwide: Powered Air Purification Respirators (PAPRs), pictured here, and rapid decontamination systems that utilize UV light to protect against deadly pathogens.



The YRMC Foundation helped fund the purchase of 20 respirators and six decontamination units. The PAPR uses a blower to pass contaminated air through a HEPA filter, which removes contaminants and supplies purified air to a facepiece. Respirators are essential equipment for many, including physicians, nurses, nursing assistants, respiratory therapists as well as environmental services, nutrition services, and emergency department staff.

The rapid decontamination units are used throughout our hospitals to quickly (in a single 30-second cycle) disinfect items such as medical instruments, tablets, keyboards, cellphones and handheld communication devices, as well as TV remote controls, desk phones and wallmounted medical equipment.

#### Elsy Moon and Sasha Naasz

Sasha Naasz, owner of The Movement Studio in Prescott Valley and member Elsy Moon, recognize the importance of giving back to help those in their community. When she and her husband Ben opened the family-friendly dance studio in 2012, Sasha and Elsy immediately launched an effort to raise funds for breast cancer awareness. Elsy had a particularly meaningful connection to this cause, having lost her mother, Angelica, to breast cancer in 1999.

Their initial effort became an annual tradition, benefiting the Susan G. Komen Foundation and the American Cancer Society. Soon they began to ask themselves, "How can we do more for our local community?"

Through another YRMC event, Elsy was introduced to the YRMC Foundation and worked with Sasha to create their first fundraiser for the Breast Care Center at YRMC in 2018. While she acknowledges the importance of working for a cure, Elsy knows firsthand the powerful impact that local support for services like transportation to appointments, grocery assistance and wigs can make for patients struggling to manage breast cancer treatments.

Elsy explained these supports helped her mother, a proud and strong woman who was reluctant to seek help. She also was concerned about burdening her daughter, who was working and raising a young family of her own.

Sasha's bubbly energy is perfect for motivating her members to participate in fundraising events, while Elsy works behind the scenes to encourage sponsorships and raffle prize donations from local businesses. In the three vears the Movement Studio has hosted fundraising events for the Breast Care Center, the dance studio has more than doubled its donation each year. In fact, their \$2,020 challenge goal in 2020 despite occupancy limitations and harsh weather - ultimately yielded far more. As Elsy says, "Our studio supports each other, and we are here for each other."

#### Toni Franklin

When the COVID-19 pandemic began to take hold in March 2020, Toni Franklin woke one morning with a fever and extreme fatigue. With virus testing kits scarce at that time, her physician recommended she guarantine and watch for other symptoms. Within days, Toni's condition worsened. She was rushed to the YRMC Emergency Department with low oxygen levels and pneumonia in both lungs. Toni's attending

physician was very concerned about her progression and treated her with the assumption of COVID-19 (her test came back positive 48 hours later). She was transferred to the ICU, finally responding after several days of oxygen treatment.

Toni was overwhelmed with emotion during her hospitalization. Her husband was unable to visit due to restrictions and he wondered, "Will I ever see my wife again?" She was so thankful for the care received from the YRMC team, recalling

## IRA Continues to Gain Popularity as a Giving Tool

There are a number of ways to donate to Dignity Health, Yavapai Regional Medical Center (YRMC). Options include cash, appreciated securities (stocks, bonds, mutual funds), real estate and other non-financial assets (should be readily marketable), as well as estate bequests, gift annuities, and charitable trusts.

One popular method is a direct gift from an Individual Retirement Account (IRA) or similar retirement plan to a charity. This method is open to donors of at least age 70-1/2 (age determined as of the date of the gift), with a maximum \$100,000 reduction in Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) per calendar year.

The way it works is fairly simple: Contact your IRA custodian and tell them you want to make a gift from your IRA to YRMC. The custodian will send you a form



to formalize this in writing, then will send a check directly to YRMC. If you wish, this gift can be considered part of your annual minimum IRA distribution. You can either be acknowledged on the gift or remain anonymous. Besides benefiting a chosen charity, since the IRA withdrawal used for the gift is not included in the donor's AGI, it does not affect your itemized deductions eligibility or increase the chances of being impacted by the Medicare (Obamacare) penalty.

As always, we suggest that people considering a donation to any charity discuss it first with their tax advisor to make sure they will qualify and that this is the best way to proceed.

At any one time there are typically 20-30 construction and renovation projects in progress at Dignity Health, YRMC. As you can imagine, projects vary in size, scope, complexity and cost. For example, current projects at our West Campus in Prescott include an Emergency Department renovation, a Clinical Lab expansion, Energy Center steam lines replacement and a Cardiovascular Intensive Care Unit remodel. Projects underway at the East Campus in Prescott Valley include the Clinical Lab expansion, Energy Center emergency generator installation, diagnostic imaging equipment installation and Mobile Imaging Facility construction.

Of course, the most visible project is the construction of the three-story 100,000-square-foot Outpatient Services Building at the West Campus. Started in May of last year, construction continues

on schedule with a phased move-in date set for October 2021. Upon completion, the facility will house YRMC's cardiac rehabilitation program, infusion therapy services, The James Family Physical Rehabilitation Center, the Pendleton Center for Health and Wellness, physician offices, a demonstration kitchen, conference facilities and a café.
