1. How should the soap be applied?
2. What room in house should the punishment take place?

1. The soap should be applied with some type of applicator. So, I agree with whoever said that earlier. Washcloth, toothbrush, etc..

2. Either a bathroom, kitchen or bedroom. If there are kids in the house, in a private area... (If followed by sex).

3. The dress doesn't matter, unless it's part of foreplay. Then the punishee should be dressed submissive.

4. If the reason the person is being punished is due to causing a scene in front of someone, then the punishment should be done in front of that same someone.

5. Good question. When there is no doubt that the punishee is going to taste the soap for hours to come. As a reminder of there punishment.

6. In public, where you don't want to draw attention, a small bar that fits easily in the mouth, like the travel bars you can buy at Wal-Mart. If private, the first room that you come to, that has soap in it, liquid or bar. (Unless you have a special soap for this punishment.) The quickest so there are no second thoughts.

7. how long should the punishment last. no less than 5 minutes, and if the offense is repeated, continue the soaping until the offense stops.

My question has to do with tools and techniques. One way is to put the bar of soap in the mouth, but other techniques might be to use a washcloth, sponge, or toothbrush. How does each of these methods rate on your "turns me on" meter. Do you have a preference? Is there a method that has no interest for you? I would be interested in the reasons behind your preferences too.

Now that I think of it, I'd like to open the question to everyone, no matter if you find yourself on the giving or the receiving end. What method do you prefer and why? Are there other methods that I have not thought of?

VINCE'S ESSAY ON SOAP DISCIPLINE TECHNIQUES:

Oral behavior problems like sassing, swearing and smoking are the reason why bathrooms have sinks, and why there should always be plenty of bar soap handy. Imagine you are on a search and destroy mission. You're looking for every swearword, rude remark, cigarette or other drug that's been on his lips or tongue. And you're not stopping until you've gotten that mouth squeaky clean!

Have your boy undress in front of you in the bathroom. Then make him kneel before the sink, with his legs spread apart. His chest should be touching, and his errant mouth easily accessible for your task. Fill the sink with a forceful flow of hot water, and drop in the soap. (Avoid Ivory soap, which is wholly inadequate, having neither a strong fragrance nor rich lather. Instead, we recommend Lever 2000, particularly for novices, with its lemony flavor and thick suds. More hardened delinquents may require Irish Spring and/or Coast, which are the nastiest tasting, and burn the most.)

Proceed deliberately and slowly, always in control. Reach into the water for the soap and roll it in the folds of a thick wet washcloth. Remember to take your time, as the anticipation will do your boy a world of good. Make him watch from a very close distance as you work the soap and washcloth into masses of suds. Raise the washcloth piled with lather to his face so that he may inhale the fragrant clean scent. Hold the cake of soap in the washcloth and trace it around his lips slowly, then squeeze his nose. And watch as he trembles with anticipation.

Introduce the soapsuds with enticing controlled deliberateness. Soon the rich lather will be flooding his mouth, but not until you know he is ready. The more you delay the dreaded moment when the soap penetrates his lips, the more he will want to get to that point. When you are ready, part his lips, and press the washcloth inside with a full load of lather. It won't take too much effort to feel his jaw slacken.

Once you have your washcloth inside his mouth, move it at varying tempos through the entire space. Refresh the washcloth from time to time in the sink, keeping it hot, wet and foamy. Rather than attempting to do the entire job at once, pause between applications, allow him to catch his breath. The longer you can keep him from holding his breath and panicking, the longer you can continue his discipline.

Assure him there is more to come. Hold him securely. Apply more suds to the outside of his face, keeping his nostrils thoroughly inundated with it, between the invasive scrubbing of his mouth.

Don't worry about him accidentally swallowing some soapsuds; a gulp or two won't hurt him. But be considerate of his feelings! That burning in his throat greatly enhances his suffering, and it's also going to prolong the aftereffects of the soaping. Encourage him to repeat an apology or pledge of obedience. Get him to feel the sensation of lather filling his mouth as he attempts to speak. Make sure he is very responsive, speaking up clearly and enthusiastically. A less-than-perfect pledge, or hesitation during reciting that pledge, ought to mean that he has to be rinsed out completely, and start a new application of soap.

He may need to learn just how unpleasant this is, before he can perform for you in the way you would prefer. This is a situation which may call for you to use the bar of soap directly to paint his tongue, piercing his parted lips with a firm in and out method.

Inevitably, his attitude will begin to show a noticeable improvement at this point, if it hasn't already! Let him know he can expect to be tasting the soap for 2 or 3 days, and don't be surprised if the boy is clearing his throat a lot afterwards. It is unlikely that he will require any other corrective measures during this"

I'm Michelle, I'm forty something and I've received (non-erotic!) Domestic discipline from my partner for many years now. I've been mouth soaped on occasions and the brand of soap used is "Cussons Imperial Leather." This has always been part of a compound punishment with other features to it.

I've never had a soapy washcloth used to wash out my mouth. It was always the bar of soap itself. When my mother used to do it to me, she would usually have me in front of the bathroom sink while she lathered the bar of soap up good under the hot water. Then as she brought the bar of soap up to my mouth, instinct made me hold my mouth tightly closed.

She would grab me by the back of the neck and she would start lathering up the outside of my mouth good with the bar of soap until a bubbly lather was all around my mouth. The minute the thick soap bubbles started to get into the nostrils of my nose a little, I couldn't breathe through my nose, and I would have to open my mouth. At that point she would shove that bar of soap in and out of my mouth until my mouth was foaming with lather. I swear this was all a little game with her that was just a warm-up to the mouthsoaping itself.

I've always had a personal preference toward Camay and other perfumed soaps (Tone, Olay). Ivory is OK, but not a favorite. I don't like deodorant soaps like Dial, but I don't mind Irish Spring or Coast. A lot of it has to do with the scent, I think. If you really want to punish someone severely, use liquid soap (Ivory, Softsoap) spread liberally on a washcloth or bath sponge. It will create mounds of lather and is very caustic on the tongue and mouth.

If you let the forum decide, you need to resolve yourself to except their decision, and their experience. As, experience is a dear school...

Trek3:

Ivory, Pure & Natural, and Tone are all pretty safe in my opinion. Where people have reportedly gotten into trouble are with the heavily perfumed or deodorant soaps, although I've personally never had significant problems in this area. It's not a matter of "safe" or "dangerous" as far as the type of soap (although liquid soaps are more concentrated and can be more caustic). It's a function of time and action -- you don't want to be made to have the soap in your mouth for more than 5 or 10 minutes, and you don't want to swallow much soap (definitely not liquid soap) if you want to avoid severe mouth irritation or nausea/vomiting. The only time I've had problems is when I've broken these rules. Don't let the stories in this forum fool you -- you can't sit down and eat a bar of soap or drink a glass of dish detergent without consequences. But a good, quick but thorough mouth soaping with your favorite bar of hand soap can be erotic, safe, and satisfying.

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I agree with Little Eddie. Stay away from the deodorant soaps and the perfumed soaps. Swallow as little as possible, as any soap, liquid or bar will irritate the mouth throat and stomach.

As for which is safest, probably the one that you find that you can get the most out of for what you are doing. Ivory is a safe bet, Tone is also good. You can tell from Eddie's choices that he does have experience in this area.

As for some of the stories here, he is correct, there are some fictional ones, where if you tried to sit down and eat a bar of soap, your stomach would be highly upset, your mouth and throat would be soar for several days. The lips and tongue would swell up and you would hardly be able to talk for several days... Just be careful not to try something that you aren't ready for.

Some ten years ago Jergens distributed a bar called La Palina Castile. It was a pure coconut soap and was one of the best bars for washing bodies or mouths I ever used. Has anyone come across this soap lately?

The closest I've come to it since is a bar called "Best Kosher Soap" and is not distributed by Rokeach. This soap has incredible suds.

For sudsing action I use DOVE (soak it first in a cup of scalding hot water for about 15 min.) on any smart mouths I have to resort to the soap punishment (when spanking doesn't work). The lather action especially as you move it in and out is impressive. Also while the soapee is holding the bar in his mouth he creates his own suds with his saliva that foam out all over his lips and filthy mouth.

EXCELLENT mouth cleaning bar! But for very bad boys who curse or really have a dirty mouth SHIELD, LIFEBOUY or COAST (tastes terrible) seems to do the trick. I know a lot of dominants use IVORY but lately when I mouth soap a guy for the first time the last two bad boys were allergic to it. Their lips swelled up so I think they are making Ivory different since I had used Ivory in the past on newbies with out any reaction.

As being one where my wife has washed my mouth out. I usually don't get pushed to orgasm at that time. And usually her soapings are mild, as to what I think I probably deserve. Again, she doesn't think soap is a good punishment for me. (She says I enjoy it too much?)

On the other hand, the times where she does soap me, playing, and I do reach orgasm, I almost immediately try to get rid of whatever soap is in my mouth, and want to rinse immediately.

So, in reality, there is some excitement to the soaping. It is enough to bring about orgasm under the right circumstances, yet, when used as a decisive discipline, by someone who knows how you react, it can be both, erotic and dis-tasteful. (pardon the expression). But, I keep asking for it, nonetheless.

As IvoryGal stated, it does allow us to cleanse our own feelings, as if once it is done, and the mouthwashing is over, we can begin anew... until we need or want a soaping again... after all, I will intentionally slip up and say the right thing at the wrong time, in order to bring on punishment...

The wife has informed her sister and her husband of the soaping/mouthwashings that I get, and they can't wait for us to visit around Thanksgiving... gee... wonder why? "SoapyOne"

As my environment hasn't and won't offer the opportunity of having my mouthwashed out, all I've had is my imagination. My fantasies can and have pushed me to the point of orgasm. But.....I've been ?safe? as in my imagination the reality of actually experiencing it is not there.

On one hand it brings a lot of pleasure, but on the other, I also feel unfulfilled as it is only imaginary and not real. I have to agree with SoapyOne though in that the few times I've done it myself, upon orgasm, the excitement is gone. While I am easy on myself in reality, 98% of the time it is imaginary, and in in my imaginary world, the intensity and duration are severe.

My disciplinarian is expert at knowing at what point mouthsoaping becomes a punishment and with slow deliberation pushes beyond that point, taking pleasure in my pleasure and my punishment, watching me become more and more excited and slowly making the punishment more and more difficult and intense, seeing how much punishment I can take without reaching orgasm, knowing every moment that I want to be punished and that I want more until.....I finally reach orgasm. And then there's next time.

My question this time is rather pointed...towards Kai and crstone22.

Kai - you state that perhaps you'll toss it into the idea pile for your "Daddy". If you get into this, you'll get very aroused and more, and if your "Daddy" is slow and thorough, it will not only take

a while, but you'll (pardon my pun) have a mouth full. I would be interested in your experience if you choose this.

CRStone22 - you wrote that you were looking for bondage and punishment, indicating that more than one soaping and one person would be ok. If you don't mind my asking, what are you hoping for? Are you hoping to receive a long and intense punishment (more than one soaping, more than one person soaping, and from strangers too). Where is the level of trust if you are bound by strangers? With the strangers not knowing your comfort level, what will you communicate to them? Will you set limits before the session (and trust that they will abide by them?) or just thrill in the moment?

For reference, just writing this stuff excites me as I try to imagine myself in your place.

I agree with you that a big part of the attraction is being in a position where you can release control to someone else for a time. At least, that is a big part of it for me. The thing that I can not figure out is this. If I am looking for a situation where I can release control, then why not within the context of a pampering or pleasant scenario? Why is it a punishment scenario that I am attracted to. That is the question that I can not answer. If anyone could direct me to some reading material that could shed light on this subject, I'd really appreciate it. "Rods71"

I think you've in a way touched on a reason that this is as erotic for me as it is. Part of enjoying sexual pleasure is trusting the other person, submitting to them and allowing yourself to be completely at ease. Most "vanilla" couples don't have a situation where they have to trust the other person completely.

Think about it. If you can trust someone enough to tie you up, spank you, wash your mouth out or what have you, you can trust them to be sincere in there affections, or that they won't hurt you emotionally.

I think that losing control of physical situations and trusting you mate to not hurt you carries over nicely to the emotional side of things allowing you to enjoy pleasurable situations better. Just my two cents.

As far as reading material on fetishes I read some texts in college that dealt with them. (I was a pshyc major for two semesters) But none of them cast a positive light on them. For the most part the popular opinion it that we're all crazy. I just see ourselves as normal people with uncommon desires. I can't stand the taste it makes me gag. does that make all beer drinkers weird? no, there just different from me, and that is what make life an adventure. So live your adventure. Enjoy it.

The answers we are looking for I believe are inside ourselves. Look inside, think about what part of the experience you enjoy the most. I bet it's different for all of us. If anyone has thought to share on this or know of more positive writings on the subject of fetishes. I'd love to hear from you.

Mouthwashing for Kids Punishment:

Several people have posted that their first first mouth washing experience was from their parents. I just wanted to ask the group if you use mouthwashing as punishment on your kids, or if you recommend it to parents with children.
