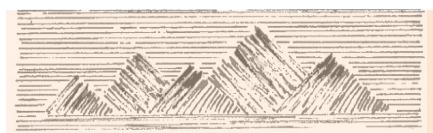


Spann Vineyards



Zinfandel, Sonoma Valley 2013

- Blend:* 78% zinfandel and 22% syrah
- Source:* The zinfandel came from the Zeller Vineyard on the Sonoma Valley floor while the syrah is from the Fieldsa Vineyard on the west side of Sonoma Valley.
- Alcohol:* 14.8%
- Fermentation:* Fermented in open top bins, hand punched down twice daily. Full malolactic fermentation for all varietals was completed in 59 gallon oak barrels.
- Barrel Aging:* The three lots were aged separately in “neutral” 59 gallon French oak barrels for 18 months, then bottle aged for three months prior to release.
- pH:* 3.85
- Total Acidity:* 5.6
- Residual Sugar:* .01% (not perceptible)
- Production:* 112 cases
- Winemaker:* Betsy Spann

Winemakers Notes:

Perfectly ripened cool-climate zinfandel grapes give this wine a beautiful raspberry and blackberry aroma and taste while syrah adds deep color, black plum flavors and enriches the mouth-feel.
