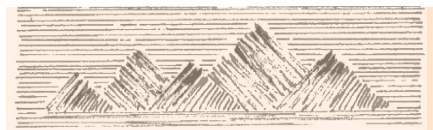

The Powerlifter, Sonoma Valley 2014 “Four Barrels”

- Blend:* 75% cabernet sauvignon and 25% syrah
- Sources:* The cabernet sauvignon came from the Cross Creek Vineyard in the Moon Mountain District of Sonoma County and the Syrah came from the cool southwest corner of Sonoma Valley.
- Alcohol:* 14.2%
- Fermentation:* Fermented in open top bins, hand punched down twice daily. Full malolactic fermentation for all varietals was completed in 59 gallon oak barrels.
- Barrel Aging:* Aged in two to six year old 59 gallon French oak barrels for 30 months, then bottle aged for six months prior to release.
- Residual Sugar:* .01% (not perceptible)
- Production:* 99 cases
- Winemaker:* Betsy Spann

Winemakers Notes:

This is our richest and most powerful wine and shows how the muscle and power of cabernet sauvignon can blend beautifully with and gain complexity from the more elegant syrah. We named it after my divergence from winemaking, the sport of powerlifting, which requires both strength and finesse to be successful. Pair this with richly flavored dishes.
