This is not only unfair—it undermines public trust in our legal institutions.

I urge you to:

1. **Dismiss the charges against Chavis Willis immediately.**
2. **Acknowledge the harm done to Granny's Helpful Hands** and ensure protections for minority-owned businesses facing similar circumstances.

3. **Recommit to fairness and equal application of the law**, regardless of race, political climate, or business size.

Justice should never be selective. Minnesota deserves a legal system that is transparent, accountable, and equitable for all.
